

## India's largest scientific event Prime Minister to inaugurate 107<sup>th</sup> Indian Science Congress today

New Delhi, Jan 2

India's largest annual gathering of scientific luminaries from countries across the world, the '107th Indian Science Congress', will be held from January 3 to 7, 2020 at University of Agricultural Sciences (UASB), GKVK Campus, Bangalore, Karnataka focusing on 'Science & Technology: Rural Development'.

The Science Congress will be inaugurated by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on January 3. The Congress is a major focal point for scientists, researchers and academicians interested in various aspects of Science



discoveries and technologies. The five-day long event aims to bring together Science fraternity across the world to discuss scientific innovation and research. The Nobel Laureates who will be participating

include German Physicist, Prof. Stefan Hell who is one of the Directors of the Max Planck Institute for Biophysical Chemistry in Göttingen, Germany. He received the Nobel Prize in Chemistry in 2014 'for the development of super-

resolved fluorescence microscopy' and Prof. Ada E. Yonath from Israel. She is a protein crystallographer who was awarded the 2009 Nobel Prize for Chemistry.

India to play T20s against Sri Lanka

New Delhi, Jan 2 After recently dominating West Indies in the limited-overs fixtures, the Virat Kohli-led Indian team will look to continue their winning momentum when they play their first series after New Year against Sri Lanka. The two sides are slated to play a short series, comprising three T20s, beginning from January 5 at Barsapara Stadium in Guwahati, Assam.

The Men in Blue will head into the series against Sri Lanka after their back-to-back 2-1 series wins against Bangladesh and the West Indies. The Lasith Malinga-led Sri Lanka, on the other hand, are coming from a 3-0 T20 series whitewash of Pakistan before slumping to a defeat against Australia by the same margin. While India have decided to go with an unchanged squad that won series against West Indies in December 2019, Sri Lanka have recalled experienced all-rounder Angelo Mathews for the upcoming series. Mirabai Chanu ranked eighth in latest Olympic qualification rankings

New Delhi, Jan 2 On course to seal a berth for the Tokyo Games, former world champion Mirabai Chanu maintained her eighth spot in the Olympic qualifiers ranking list released by the International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) on Thursday. In the race for Olympic qualification, the 25-year-old, who competes in the 49kg category, has gathered 2966.6406 ranking points till now. To qualify for Tokyo, a weightlifter must compete in at least one event in each of the three periods of six months (spread over November 2018



to April 2020), at least six events overall and in at least one gold and silver level event. "The ranking points are based on the number of events a lifter participates in and Mirabai has missed a few competitions, including the World Championship in 2018, due to her back injury," National coach Vijay Sharma said. "But being eighth now is not a problem as after the final rankings list is made in April and the best results will be taken into account," he added.
