

## Commemoration of First Flag Hoisting by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare & Lt. Governor, A&N Islands hoisted National Flag amidst patriotic fervour



Port Blair, Dec 30

To mark the 76th anniversary of the First Flag Hoisting for the first time on the Indian Soil at Port Blair by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, a State Level function was organized by the A&N Administration at Flag Point, Port Blair today morning in which the Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey and Admiral D.K.Joshi PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands

Development Agency hoisted the National Flag.

It was on this day i.e December 30, 1943, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose had hoisted the National Tri-Colour Flag, declaring the Islands, the first Indian Territory to be freed from the British rule.

### Urban India declared Open defecation free

New Delhi, Dec 30  
Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban has achieved its target of creating Urban India Open Defecation Free.

Urban areas of 35 states and Union Territories have become ODF. In all, 4,320 cities out of 4,372 have

declared themselves ODF, of which 4,167 cities have been certified through third-party verification. This has been achieved by the construction of nearly 65.81 lakh individual household toilets against Mission target of 59 lakhs and 5.89 lakh seats of

public toilets against Mission target of 5.08 lakh seats.

Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry has launched the ODF and ODF protocols, with a focus on sustaining ODF outcomes and achieving holistic

### Centre plans to convert 75 hospitals into medical colleges

Bhubaneswar, Dec 30

The Union Health Minister Dr. Harsh Vardhan has said the Centre is planning to convert 75 hospitals in aspirational districts across the country into medical colleges in a phased manner. He said, a target has been set to convert 49 hospitals, including six in Odisha, into medical colleges within the next five years. Speaking on the sidelines of the function at AIIMS

in Bhubaneswar recently, the Union Health Minister said Centre has included 10 districts of Odisha in the list of aspirational districts. Stating that the Centre has planned to set up 1 lakh 50 thousand health and wellness centres across the country under the Ayushman Bharat scheme, Dr Vardhan said that 25 thousand such units have already been established.

### Financial Assistance to farmers under RKVY by Deptt. of Agriculture

Port Blair, Dec. 30

Under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), financial assistance on various approved/recommended components are being provided to the farmers of these Islands by the Agriculture Department, for doubling their income. The 'Construction of Threshing Floor-cum-Drying Yard' is promoted by providing of maximum admissible subsidy/assistance @ 33.33% of total

approved cost to support building of infrastructure for post-harvest management through solar drying.

Since 2011-12, a total of 316 farmers of these Islands have been benefitted so far under this scheme with total subsidy to the tune of Rs 1, 59, 69,264/- and Rs. 159.69 lakhs have been released to them. During the current financial year 2019-20, an amount of Rs.25,36,696/- has already been

## India is proud of both Mary Kom, Nikhat Zareen: Sports Minister

New Delhi, Dec 30  
Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports Shri Kiren Rijiju on Monday said that boxing sensation Mary Kom is a 'legend' and Nikhat Zareen has the potential to follow her footsteps. The Sports Minister's comments came after six-time world champion Kom refused to shake hands with Zareen following her 9-1 win over Zareen in the final of the 51kg weight category of the Women's Boxing Olympic trials at the Indira Gandhi Stadium in New Delhi on Saturday. Taking to his official Twitter handle, Shri Rijiju said that too much of issues are created on this matter, adding both of them are amazing boxers and that India is proud of them.



"Too much of issues are created on this! Mary Kom is a legend who has achieved what no other boxer has ever achieved in the World Amateur Boxing. Nikhat Zareen is an amazing boxer who has the potential to follow the footsteps of Mary Kom. India is proud of both of them. Period," he wrote. Mary, who is the only women boxer to have clinched eight

World Championship medals, has now made it to the Indian team for 2020 Tokyo Olympic qualifiers. Besides her, Sakshi Chaudhary (57kg), Simranjit Kaur (60 kg), Lovlina Borgohain (69 kg) and Pooja Rani (75 kg) are the other boxers to have qualified for the Asia/Oceania Olympic qualifiers, which is slated to take place in China in February next year.

## Udayan Mane sets new PGTI record; bags TATA Steel Tour C' ship title

Jamshedpur, Dec 30  
In Golf, Udayan Mane produced a flawless seven-under 65 on the final day to claim a thrilling one-shot win at the season-ending TATA Steel Tour Championship in Jamshedpur today. Mane's 67-66-64-65 determined final round effort saw him establish a new PGTI record for the lowest tournament total as he closed the week with a jaw-dropping 26-under-262 at the Galmuri Golf Course. It was Mane's eighth professional title

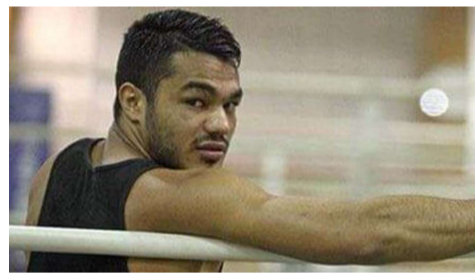


and his second win on the PGTI this season. SSP Chawrasia had settled for second place with another outstanding total score of 25-

under-263. Aman Raj (71) the third-round leader, ended the week in tied third place at 23-under-265 along with Delhi's Chiragh Kumar (67).

## Vikas Krishan qualified for Asian Olympic qualifiers after boxing return

Bellary, Dec 30  
Vikas Krishan has made it to the Indian squad for the Asian Olympic qualifiers on his return to amateur boxing. The 27-year-old beat national medallist Duryodhan Singh Negi in the 69kg final of the men's trials that was held on Monday in Bellary, Karnataka by a unanimous verdict. The two-time Olympian recovered from a back injury after a short unbeaten stint in professional boxing in the run-up to the trials. He had earlier beaten Ashush Kulheria on Sunday. The Commonwealth Games medal winners Gaurav Solanki (57kg) and Naman Tanwar



(91kg) also made the squad after winning their respective final bouts. Asian silver medallist Ashish Kumar (75kg), veteran Satish Kumar (+91kg) and Sachin Kumar (81kg) also booked their places in the squad. Amit Panghal (52kg) and Manish Kaushik (63kg) are already part of the squad thanks to the silver and

bronze medals they won respectively and the 2019 men's World Boxing Championships. Men's squad: Amit Panghal (52kg), Gaurav Solanki (57kg), Manish Kaushik (63 kg), Vikas Krishan (69kg), Ashish Kumar (75kg), Sachin Kumar (81kg), Naman Tanwar (91kg), Satish Kumar (+91kg).

## No Pakistan players, 5 Indians to be part of Asia XI vs World XI: BCCI

New Delhi, Dec 30  
The BCCI has said that the possibility of India and Pakistan players playing together will not arise in the combined Asia XI team next year. Asia XI and World XI are scheduled to play two T20s in Bangladesh in March 2020. Speaking to IANS, BCCI Joint Secretary Jayesh George said the message is that there will be no Pakistan players invited for the match. "What we are aware of is that there will be no Pakistan

players in the Asia XI. That is what the message is, so, there is no question of both countries coming together or picking one over the other. Sourav Ganguly will decide the five India players who will be a part of the Asia XI," he said. "There will be Asia XI vs World XI game but it will be subject to ICC's approval," BCCI President Sourav Ganguly said after BCCI's annual general body meeting held in Mumbai earlier in December.

It had been reported earlier that the Bangladesh Cricket Board has sought the services of Virat Kohli, MS Dhoni, Rohit Sharma, Jasprit Bumrah and Hardik Pandya from the BCCI for the Asia XI team. "We are looking for the best players among the current lot, and because the games will have international status, everyone will be serious about it," BCB President Nazmul Hassan had said earlier in the year.

## Virat Kohli, Jasprit Bumrah included; MS Dhoni misses out in Wisden's T20I team of decade

New Delhi, Dec 30  
Indian skipper Virat Kohli and pacer Jasprit Bumrah are the only two players from the country who have been included in the 11-member Wisden's T20 International team of the decade. Surprisingly, wicketkeeper-batsman Mahindra Singh Dhoni and star opener Rohit Sharma have missed out on making it to the team, which is led by Australia's limited-overs skipper Aaron Finch. Kohli, who has amassed a total of 2,633 runs in 75 Twenty20 Internationals he has played for the Men in Blue so far, has been named at No.3 spot in the squad. "While Kohli's record in domestic T20 cricket is patchy, the same cannot be said of T20Is. Kohli's average of 53 was the best in the decade, and while his consistency compromises his strike-rate slightly, he is still able to score at a good rate, even if not exceptional," Wisden said about Kohli. Bumrah, on the other hand, has bagged 51 wickets in 41 T20Is since making his debut in the shortest format of the game against Australia in January 2016. "Despite only making his debut in 2016, Bumrah finds a spot in this team thanks to his defensive

brilliance. Bumrah's overall economy rate of 6.71 is the second best in the world among quick bowlers, behind Dale Steyn. This statistic is more impressive when you consider he did the majority of his bowling in the death overs, where his economy rate of 7.27 was the seventh best in the world, and comfortably the best by a quick bowler. Bumrah is likely bowl three overs at the death for this side," it said.

## ICC Test Rankings: Virat Kohli, Pat Cummins end 2019 on top

Dubai, Dec 30  
Indian skipper Virat Kohli and Australian cricketer Pat Cummins finished the year at the top positions in the International Cricket Council (ICC) Test Rankings for batsmen and bowlers, respectively released on Monday. With a total of 928 points, Kohli is comfortably standing at the numero-uno spot in the ICC Test rankings for batsmen, ahead of Australia's Steve Smith (911) and New Zealand skipper Kane Williamson (822). For the fourth time in a row, the Indian skipper finished with most international runs in a calendar year with a total of 2,455 runs across formats. The rankings also saw players from Australia and South Africa sizzle in the latest ICC Test Player Rankings after their respective second and first Test



match against New Zealand and England. Australia's Marnus Labuschagne has finished the year at a career-best fourth position while South Africa's wicketkeeper-batsman Quinton de Kock has moved into the top 10. Labuschagne, who was ranked 110th at the start of the year, has moved up one slot after scores of 63 and 19 in the Melbourne Test against New Zealand, which Australia won by 247 runs to go 2-0 up in the three-match series. De Kock's 'player of the match' effort of 95 and 34, which helped his team beat England by 107 runs at Centurion to go 1-0 up in the four-match series, sees him advance eight places and reach 10th position. Other batsmen to move up the rankings include New Zealand opener Tom Latham (up two places to 14th), Australia middle-order batsman Travis Head (up 15 places to a career-best 19th), England opener Rory Burns (up five places to a career-best 31st) and middle-order batsman Joe Denly (up 10 places to a career-best 36th).
