District Administration, SA takes swift action against fresh encroachments

District Administration appeals to residents of South Andaman to uphold lawful land-use practices & discourage illegal encroachments

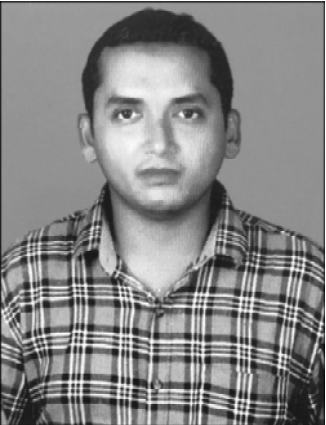
