38% of work for up-gradation of PHC Garacharma to District Hospital completed

The A&N Administration is committed towards providing better health care facilities to the Islanders by upgrading the existing health infrastructure facilities. To achieve this goal, the Administration has taken up different health infrastructure development project which includes up-gradation of PHC Garacharma to District Hospital, installation of Cardiac Cathlab, creation of a Trauma Centre at Dr. RP Hospital, up-gradation of CHC Diglipur to Sub District Hospital and strengthening of existing hospitals in different parts of the Islands.

As part of the health infrastructure creation, PHC

Garacharma is being upgraded to a full fledged District Hospital which will cover all the segments of South Andaman District and thereby benefiting a large number of people who are in need of healthcare facilities. The construction work of 155 bedded Garacharma hospital at a cost of Rs. 17.70 Crores having ground floor plus three storied (Ground +3) building have already started and about 38% of work of hospital has been completed and is expected to be completed by Feb.2022.

In order to provide all health facilities locally in the Islands itself, the Health Department is going to set up Cardiac Catherization Unit in A & N Islands, so that cases of cardiac disease can be handled at G.B. Pant Hospital itself. Installation of 'Cardiac Cath Lab'

is likely to be completed by April, 2021 at GB Pant Referral Hospital.

Apart from this, the Administrative approval and expenditure sanction has been accorded for 'Up-gradation of CHC Diglipur to Sub District Hospital' and work will be completed by December, 2022. A Trauma Centre at Dr. RP Hospital will also come up at Mayabunder and it is expected that this Centre will be established by March, 2021.

In addition, the existing Hospitals are also been strengthened so that all the required medical facilities are available to the Islanders.

No proposal to launch new pension policy for central civil pensioners: Minister

New Delhi, Feb. 3 (PIB)

The Government today said that there is at present no proposal/consideration to launch new pension policy for central civil pensioners. In a written reply to a question in the Lok Sabha, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge)

Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER), MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr. Jitendra Singh said that in order to improve the pension process to facilitate pensioners, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare had developed 'Bhavishya', a common software module for Ministries, which has now been functioning as a mandatory platform for processing Pension & related benefits of Central Civil Pensioners w.e.f 01.01.2017.

By keeping track of the progress as well as close monitoring of each pension case, it introduces transparency and accountability into the system thereby plugging delays. This (Contd. on last page)

Facilitating Mainland-Island bound passengers DSS schedules sailing of MV Nancowry for Visakhapatnam on Feb.8

In order to contain the outbreak of COVID-19 in these Islands, the Directorate of Shipping Services under the directives of A & N Administration had suspended operation of its vessels to Mainland Island since March, 2020 between Port Blair, Kolkata, Chennai & Vizag. However, during the pandemic

70,269 persons insured under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana in A&N Islands

Out of 10 claims received, 5 were settled disbursing an amount of Rs. 10 lakh to insured persons

Port Blair, Feb. 3

The Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) is a social security scheme started by the Ministry of Finance to provide insurance in case of disability or death. The premiums fixed are low in order to ensure that the policyholder is given the benefits at the earliest. It is an accident insurance scheme launched by the Govt. of India with an aim to bring the uninsured population under insurance cover. This accident insurance scheme offers a one-year

accidental death and disability cover, which can be renewed annually.

As per the data received from the Lead Bank Port Blair, altogether, 70,269 persons have been enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) in these Islands as on Jan 25,

2021. A total of 10 claims received under this insurance scheme, out of which, 5 claims were settled while one claim is pending and other four were rejected. Of the 5 claims settled, Rs. 10 lakh were disbursed to 5 insured persons (Rs. 2 lakh for each claim).

According to the salient feature of the scheme, it is available to people in the age group 18 to 70 years with a bank account who give their consent to join/enable auto-debit on or before 31st May for the coverage period 1st June to 31st May on an annual renewal basis. Aadhaar would be the primary Know Your Customer (KYC) for the bank account. The risk coverage under the scheme is Rs. 2 lakh for accidental (Contd. on last page)

ICC nominates Rishabh Pant & two others for Men's Player of the Month award

New Delhi, Feb. 3
India's wicketkeeper-batsman Rishabh Pant has been nominated for the ICC Men's Player of the Month award along with England skipper Joe Root and Ireland's Paul Stirling. The International Cricket Council announced the nominees for the inaugural Player of the Month Awards which will recognise and celebrate the best performances from both male and female cricketers across all forms of international cricket throughout the year.



The 23-year-old Pant played two Tests against Australia where he scored a 97 at Sydney to ensure a draw before an unbeaten 89 at Brisbane that led India to a historic series-clinching win. In January, Root played two Tests against Sri Lanka, where he scored a 228 and 186 and led his team to a 2-0 Test series victory. The third nominee in the category, Stirling played two ODIs against the UAE and three ODIs vs Afghanistan, where he scored three centuries. (Source:india.gov.in)

importance of immunity in fighting various ailments in general, and COVID-19, in particular. He appreciated this innovative effort to spread the awareness among Island population. Dr. Pooja delivered a lecture on role and significance of including fruits and spices in our daily diet. Further, she emphasized on growing own produce by the urban and peri-urban households for improving the accessibility and affordability of the produce to the city dwellers.

The participants were then taken to the Institute demonstration unit on urban horticulture wherein different immunity boosting plants suitable for growing in urban spaces including balconies, terraces and backyard were showcased. Technologies developed by the institute viz. cultivation of Burmese coriander in pro-trays (CIARI-Pro Dhaniya) and multiter cultivation models were also explained to them. Dr. Ajit Waman, co-organizer of the event, elaborated about the possibility of developing small scale businesses in such limited spaces for promoting urban horticulture sector in the Islands. Participants also visited the Horticultural Plants Propagation Unit of the institute wherein scientific methods for production of seeds and planting material of various fruits and spices were demonstrated, a press release from ICAR-CIARI said.

participants including small poultry entrepreneurs and progressive farmers attended the programme.

Dr. Jai Sunder, Pr. Scientist presented in detail about the disease, its transmission, clinical signs, its potential to human infection, bio - security measure to be followed in the current pandemic situation, dos and don'ts and action plan in case of outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza. Dr. Ramakrishna, SVO presented a visual media on avian influenza and informed that the cycle among poultry, pig and human contacts to be broken as it is danger in places where poultry and piggy are practiced together. As far as Andaman and Nicobar perspective, he said eggs and chicken can be transported from the non-infected states. Islands are isolated and control programmes have been implemented strictly by the Department of Animal Husbandry. He advised all the consumers, poultry keeper who handle poultry in day today life to go with mask and goggles to poultry shops. Dr. Sam Varghese, Veterinary Officer from the Department of Environment & Forests, presented a perspective on wild birds' role in avian influenza. He detailed on means of transmission and advised to inform the Forest Department, if any wild birds is found dead showing symptoms of bird flu, a press release from CIARI said.
