He called Shri Abhinandan and his family who have been serving the nation, a shining example in the service of the nation as he asked the younger generation to draw inspiration from him. Addressing the gathering after laying foundation stone for the construction of Kaushal Bhawan, here yesterday, Shri Naidu stressed up on the need to work as team India to build a stronger India, a more developed India, an India that was capable of defending itself against hostile forces and disruptive designs. The world and especially South East Asia has numerous problems like poverty, illiteracy, unemployment and low employable skills. We should wage a war against these, he added. ## Committee constituted by MoEF & CC deliberates on ICRZ Notification Chief Secretary raises fundamental issues regarding Isles coastal areas

Port Blair, Mar. 03

The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) had requested for comments of A & N Administration on ICRZ Notification in June 2018. A & N Administration submitted its detailed comments to the Ministry after taking into account the views of all stakeholders, PRIs and general public. MoEF & CC referred the comments of the Administration to the committee headed by Dr. Shailesh R Nayak, Director, National Institute of Advance Studies (NIAS),

Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bengaluru. The meeting of Committee was held on March 1, 2019 at Bengaluru, which was attended by Chief Secretary, A & N Administration and PCCF, CRZ, A & N Forest. The Chief Secretary put forth following arguments for modification of the draft CRZ Notification.

\* Chief Secretary flagged a fundamental issue with regards to various law/guidelines/ notification applying on the coastal areas of the islands. He referred to Forest Conservation Act, Wildlife Conservation Act and

Biosphere & Wildlife Sanctuaries notification which are applicable over and above CRZ notification in the same jurisdiction of coastal areas.

\* The application of numerous notifications/guidelines creates multiple issues of compliance, confusion and fixation of responsibilities in the case of violation. Therefore, Chief Secretary requested that the CRZ notification being one of the most modern legal framework in the coastal areas should be the only law applicable in the coastal areas. The other notifications/ acts/

guidelines should not be applicable in the coastal areas.

\* Chief Secretary submitted that Andaman and Nicobar Islands are two technically & geomorphologically different sets of Islands. Therefore, ICRZ Notification should have separate approach towards two groups of islands.

\* He further submitted that undulating terrain and the advance stage of development of Andaman group of Islands should be considered before finalizing the notification. He suggested that in the Andaman group of islands,

**Bajrang Punia wins gold in Bulgaria, dedicates medal to Abhinandan Varthaman**

New Delhi, Mar 3  
India's star wrestler Bajrang Punia has won the gold medal at the Dan Kolov-Nikola Petrov tournament in Ruse, Bulgaria and dedicated the victory to Indian Air Force (IAF) Wing Commander Abhinandan Varthaman.  
Punia, a World Championship silver medalist, overpowered Jordan Oliver of USA 12-3 in the 65kg freestyle final to begin the season on a resounding note in the Bulgarian city. The Indian also secured the maximum ranking points from the tournament.  
"I want to dedicate my gold to Wing Commander Abhinandan Varthaman. He has inspired me. I want to meet him one day and also shake hands with him," Punia tweeted after his victory. The IAF pilot Varthaman returned to India from captivity in Pakistan on Friday night after a suspenseful wait lasting hours, which is being seen as



a major step towards defusing a near-war situation triggered by India's retaliation following the Pulwama terror attack on February 14.  
Punia, who bagged the top prize at the Commonwealth Games and the Asian Games last year, has won four gold medals and one silver in the last five tournaments.  
This was Punia's 10th medal in as many international tournaments since failing to finish at the podium in the 2017 World Championships in Paris. Earlier, Pooja Dhanda claimed the gold in 59 kg while Sakshi

Malik won silver in 65 kg women's freestyle. In the men's freestyle events, Sandeep Tomar had to be content with a silver in 61kg.  
India may add to their gold tally as Vinesh Phogat is scheduled to play her final in the 53kg against China's Qianyu Pang of China. Vinesh beat World Championships silver medalist Sarah Hildebrandt in the semifinals on Saturday. This is Vinesh's first tournament since moving to 53kg from 50kg. Sarita Mor won a silver in women's 59kg though she lost to her compatriot Dhanda.

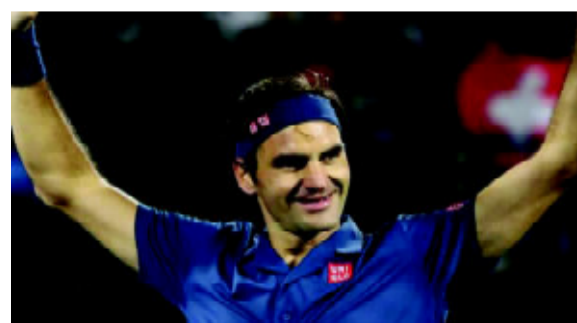

**Roger Federer wins his 100th career title in Dubai**

Dubai, Mar 3  
Roger Federer claimed the 100th ATP title of his career by beating 20-year-old Greek Stefanos Tsitsipas 6-4, 6-4 in the final of the Dubai Duty Free Tennis Championships on Saturday. The 20-time Grand Slam champion became the second man in the Open Era to win 100 titles, after American Jimmy Connors who won 109. Swiss Federer also avenged his shock defeat by Tsitsipas in the Australian Open fourth round in January and will climb to number four in the rankings on Monday.  
"I'm delighted. It's great to win my eighth here in Dubai and in combination with my 100th singles title," Federer said.



"Tough conditions and tough opponents. To win in Marseille (last Sunday) and then come here was difficult for Stefanos." Federer, who had been stuck on 99 titles since triumphing at his hometown tournament in Basel in October, broke Tsitsipas in the first game of the match and saved two break points at 5-4 to claim the first set in 36 minutes.

Tsitsipas, who will break into the top 10 for the first time, held firm up to 4-4 in the second set before the 37-year-old Federer switched gear to seal the decisive break and close out the victory.  
"I don't know if Stefanos was born when I won my first title," Federer joked following a tribute video that included his first title in Milan in 2001.

**Acapulco International: Nick Kyrgios thumps Alexander Zverev to clinch title**

Acapulco, Mar 3  
Australian Nick Kyrgios stunned German second seed Alexander Zverev 6-3 6-4 to win the Acapulco International in Mexico on Saturday for his fifth career ATP title. The temperamental Aussie, whose scintillating run to the final included wins over multiple grand slam winners Stan Wawrinka and Rafa Nadal, played free and focused from the outset and frustrated Zverev with a steady diet of drop shots. Former world number 13 Kyrgios, who has fallen to 72 in the rankings, converted three of his break point opportunities and sealed the win on his first championship



point with a massive serve that was too much for world number three Zverev to handle. Kyrgios struck first and emphatically when he broke Zverev at love in the fourth game of the opening set and consolidated the break to go ahead 4-1, triggering a frustrated Zverev to smash his

racquet beyond repair on the hard court.  
The 23-year-old Australian opened the second set with a break but then looked like he may start to crack when he found himself staring down a break point in the next game and double-faulted, allowing Zverev to draw level at 1-1.

**Ethiopian Birhanu Legese wins rain-sodden Tokyo marathon**

Tokyo, Mar 3  
Ethiopian Birhanu Legese cruised to victory at the Tokyo marathon on Sunday, winning in a time of two hours, four minutes and 48 seconds in miserable conditions to claim his first major title. The 24-year-old was part of a small leading group for the first 30 kilometres before pulling away easily from runnerup Kenyan Bedan Karoki (2:06:48) and strolling to victory. Karoki's compatriot Dickson Chumba, twice a winner in Tokyo, was third. With rain lashing down for much of a frigid morning, it was never likely to be a fast race.  
Japan fancied their chances of a homegrown male victory for



the first time since 2010 but Suguru Osako, who set a new Japanese national record in October, struggled to stay with the leading group and pulled out with an injury 30 kilometres in.  
The 27-year-old, touted as Japan's best hope of delivering Olympic marathon gold when

Tokyo hosts the Games in 2020, was distraught as he limped from the route.  
Ethiopian Ruti Aga won the women's race in a time of 2:20:40, edging out compatriot Helen Tola by 21 seconds. Ethiopians have now won the women's marathon in Tokyo in six of the last eight editions.

No Development Zone (NDZ) for tourism should be 50 mtrs and for eco-tourism 20 mtrs. Similarly in Nicobar group of Islands NDZ (Tourism) can be 100 mtrs and NDZ (eco-tourism) 50 mtrs.  
\* The Islands with the area smaller with 10 Sq Km should be categorized under IIMPs (Integrated Islands Management Plans).  
\* Under IIMPs, none of the activities should be prohibited. All the activities should be regulated by Andaman Nicobar Coastal Zone Management Committee (ANCZMA) on case to case basis. Therefore, there is no requirement of having different zoning i.e. preservation/conservations in the IIMPs.  
All the above points were thoroughly deliberated upon by the Chairman and other committee members. There was a broad consensus in the committee on almost all the points. The Ministry was requested to process the case further as per the decisions taken in the meeting, a communication said.
