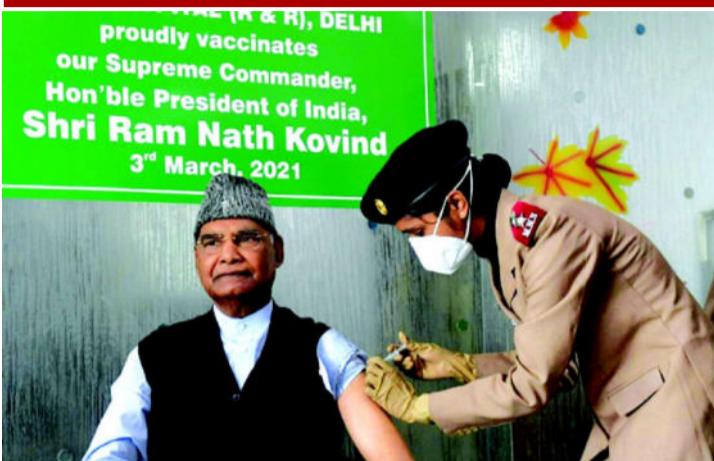

Model Science Centre inaugurated at GSS Arong

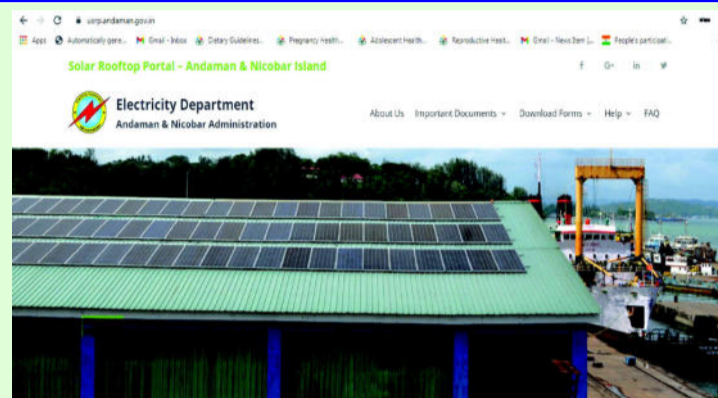

 The Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs, A&N Administration with an aim to augment the infrastructure arrangements of the Gram Panchayats for effective carrying out of door to door segregated collection of waste in accordance to the Rural Areas Solid Waste Management Bye Laws, 2019 has procured 29 battery operated e-Carts from the World Bank Incentive Fund received from the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Govt. of India.



Lakshay Singhal, IAS (P) also graced the occasion. The e-Carts procured under the scheme have separate compartments for collection of dry and wet waste and is also fitted with Hydraulic Tipping Facility for convenient unloading of waste. The e-Carts will

30% of the investment in Plant and machinery with an upper limit of Rs. 5.00 crore

• Central Interest Incentive (CII)

Interest Incentive @ 3% on working capital credit advanced by the Scheduled Banks or Central/State financial Institutions for first five years from the date of commencement of commercial production/operation.

• Central Comprehensive Insurance Incentive (CCII)

Reimbursement of 100% insurance premium on insurance of building and Plant & Machinery for maximum period of 5 years.

• Goods and Services Tax (GST) Reimbursement

58% of the Central tax paid and 29% of integrated tax paid for the period of 5 years.

• Income Tax (IT) Reimbursement

Central Share of income tax for first 5 years.

• Transport Incentive (TI)

> 20% of the cost of transportation for finished goods for Shipping from the port nearest to the location of the industrial unit to the mainland Port.

> 20% of the cost of transportation including the incentive currently provided by Railways or the Railway PSUs for movement of finished goods by rail from the railway station nearest to the mainland port to the railway station nearest to the location of the buyer.

Unless otherwise specified, all new industrial units and existing industrial units undertaking substantial expansion in manufacturing and service sectors located in the Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be eligible for incentives under the scheme.

The Industrial units who are willing to avail benefits under LANIDS-2018, will have to register themselves prior to being eligible for any benefit under the scheme. The last date for registration is 31.03.2021.

All the interested Entrepreneurs/Enterprises desirous of setting up of new enterprise/ under take substantial expansion of existing enterprise willing to avail benefits under LANIDS-2018 have been requested to register themselves through online portal 'www.ls1.and.nic.in/LANIDS'. fodder compatibility, disease susceptibility and hence is expensive in comparison to indigenous cattle.

As observed, the milk production in these animals is less in comparison to exotic cross breeds but the quality of milk is perceived to be a natural food with nutritional health benefits. Appreciable yield of quality milk (Herd average of 08 liters/day/animal) in ideal management is being achieved from the first generation cross bred Gir cattle maintained at CHF, Dollygunj.

Farmers interested to adopt dairy unit with indigenous cows can adopt Artificial Insemination in cows available with them utilizing the facility available with the Departmental Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries. Interested farmers can also undergo hands-on training at the Departmental Cattle Holding Farm Dollygunj. Those farmers who are unable to access the facility of Artificial Insemination of their cattle can purchase male Gir cross-bred calves from the farm for the breeding purpose. Female calves are also being supplied to farmers as per the availability. The Departmental Cattle Farm has supplied 25 such calves/cows to farmers so far, a press release Senior Veterinary Surgeon, Govt. Cattle Farm Dollygunj said.

The Andaman and Nicobar Administration invite applications from interested person for appointment to the post of **Member** on Forum for Redressal of Grievances of Consumers set up in this UT under the said Regulation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Member:- shall be a Retired Officer of any State/Central Power Sector Department's/ PSU not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent possessing Degree in Electrical/Mechanical/Electronics/Computer Engineering and having atleast 15 years experience preferably in matters relating to the distribution of electricity or a serving officer of the distribution licensee of the same jurisdiction not below the rank of Executive Engineer. (Not below the rank of Assistant Engineer in case of Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands).

AGE LIMIT:

(i) That the member shall hold office for a term of three years from date of appointment or till he attains the age of 65 years whichever is earliest as per provision (1) of Regulation 10 of JERC Notification dated 11.09.2019. The Licensee shall ensure that working of Forum is not disrupted on account of non-filling of the vacancy.

(ii) In case any Member decides to relinquish the post, he may do so after giving a notice of two (2) months in writing to Licensee or deposit two months salary in lieu thereof.

ALLOWANCES:

The Pay and Allowances and other conditions of services of the member from amongst the serving officers shall be same as he shall be otherwise entitled while in service alongwith deputation allowance as admissible.

The Member other than mentioned in class 7 (ii) above shall be eligible to receive a consolidated remuneration of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees sixty thousand only) per month. They shall also be entitled for TA/DA while out on duty as eligible to Class-I Officers of the rank of Deputy Secretary in the Central Government.
