Oral Polio Vaccine successfully administered to 21820 children in the age group of 0-5 years in Isles

Two days house-to-house visit to be held on Mar. 4 & 5

Port Blair, Mar.3 The Union Territory of A&N Islands organized the National Immunization Day for Polio in the entire Territory today. The inaugural ceremony of National Immunization Day for Polio was organized at UHC Junglighat with the administration of first drop of Oral Polio Vaccine by Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman District as the chief guest. The program was attended by Dr. Suja Antony, Director of Health Services and Dr.

Avijit Roy, State Immunization Officer alongwith other officials of DHS. The National Deputy Commissioner welcomed the gathering and requested the general public to vaccinate their children between 0-5 years of age. A total of 534 fixed booths were established. Arrangements were made to cover the children at Bus Terminals, and Seaport. Apart from this, arrangements were also made to cover the children travelling by Inter

Island Vessels as well as at Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair. In the A & N Islands, out of 21778 children, 21820 children in the age group of 0-5 years were administered Polio Vaccine on 1st day, which includes Port Blair and Defence area. Catphishing is a form of online abuse, wherein the cyber criminal makes use of various channels like instant messaging apps, SMS, online dating apps, social media platforms, porn sites etc., to lure the users into intimate video/audio chats and makes them pose nude or obtains revealing pictures from them. The fraudsters later make use of this material to harass, embarrass, threaten, exploit and blackmail the victims.



In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard oneself against online Catphishing:

- > Never share any compromising images, posts, videos of yourself to anyone, no matter who they are.
- > Never pick up any calls / video calls from anonymous number.
- > Turn off your electronic devices and web cameras when you are not using them.
- > Use two factor authentication with strong passwords and different passwords for your different social media accounts.
- > Enable privacy and security features in all your social media accounts.

> Do not suffer in silence, know that you are not alone, reach out and seek help from trusted family and friends.

> Avoid browsing the suspicious websites and websites fully which are not aware.

> On social media or dating platforms, be cautious of unknown users who try to move the conversation to another interactive platform very quickly.

Whereas, as per the section 25(RESTRICTIONS ON NEW OUTLETS AND NEW DISCHARGES) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, No person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process, or any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.

Whereas, as per the section 21(RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL PLANTS) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the industrial unit to obtain Consent To Establish(CTE) from Andaman Nicobar Pollution Control Committee(ANPCC) before establishment of industry and also obtain Consent to Operate(CTO) after establishment of unit. Non compliance of this is the violation of the provisions made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

Whereas, it has come to the notice of ANPCC that the many of Industrial Units have been established without obtaining CTE and also started operating without CTO under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1981, which is a violation of the aforesaid rules.

Whereas, ANPCC has given an opportunity to such units by giving window to all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment by giving60 dayswindow from 10-03-2023 to 10-05-2023 and 90 days windows from 01-07-2023 to 30-09-2023 for getting CTO from ANPCC. Even after the lapse of such period, ANPCC is still receiving applications for issue of CTO without having prior CTE.

Now, therefore, the ANPCC in its XXIX meeting held on 24-11-2023 has decided to extend the window for further period of 90 days to regulate all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment by giving a window from 20-12-2023 to 20-03-2024 to apply for getting CTO from ANPCC. However the CTO will be issued subject to fulfillment of environmental norms applicable to the industry.

Therefore, it is informed to all the stakeholders and general public that it is the statutory responsibility of all the industries to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry& CTO after establishment in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The industrial unit/entrepreneur shall apply for CTE& CTO using the URL: www.anocnms.nic.infor the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Any industrial unit which fails to obtain CTO from ANPCC within the stipulated time shall be liable for action as the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

No Consent to Operate will be issued to any industry after lapse of 90 days(i.e. 20-03-2024)who have not obtained CTE before its establishment.
