Promote new & renewable energy to ensure energy security, to protect climate and to reduce pollution: Vice President

New Delhi, April 3
The Vice President, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu has called for the promotion of new and renewable energy in a big way. He said moving to renewable would not just ensure energy security but also protect the climate, reduce pollution.
'Adequate growth in renewable energy would serve dual purpose - firstly, it would contribute towards achieving energy security to the nation and it would address the environmental concerns, which need to be tackled on a war-footing,' he said.
Addressing the gathering after inaugurating the GRIDTECH 2019, an



International Exhibition and Conference, organised by the Power Grid Corporation of India Limited to deliberate on new technologies in transformation, distribution, renewable energy integration, Smart Grid Communication, the Vice

President asked experts to find out new technologies to harness renewable energy to fulfill India's energy demands and also to fulfill India's international commitment to de-carbonize the electricity generation.
Shri Naidu also called for the promotion of clean and green mode of transport, such as Electrical Vehicles (EVs) on a large scale. He said that they have the potential to save foreign exchange on crude oil import apart from reducing carbon emissions. He also called for inclusion of renewable energy provisions right from the planning of towns.
The Vice President said that world was looking

towards India for investments and opined that India's economic growth was the main factor for the new found enthusiasm of the world community.
Opining that rapid urbanization led to increased energy demand and rise of Green House Gas (GHG) emissions, Shri Naidu urged technologists to find new methods for tapping the huge potential in the renewable energy sector and also wanted them to educate the common man on the need to cut down GHG emissions.
Pointing that connectivity and electricity were key to development, Shri Naidu

Over 1.2 M early deaths in India due to air pollution: Report

New Delhi, April 3
A global report has found that life expectancy of children born today will be shortened by 20 months on average, growing up in current high levels of air pollution.
According to a study, conducted by the Boston-headquartered Health Effects Institute, the situation in South Asia is much worse with the life expectancy shortened by two years and six months. The institutes' State of Global Air Report 2019, released today, said that overall long-term exposure to outdoor and indoor air pollution contributed to



nearly 5 million deaths across the world from stroke, diabetes, heart attack, lung cancer, and chronic lung disease in 2017. This means that air pollution contributed to nearly one in every 10 deaths in 2017, making it a

bigger killer than malaria, malnutrition, and road accidents. The analysis found that China and India together were responsible for over half of the total global attributable deaths, with each country facing over 1.2 million deaths from all air pollution in 2017.

216 IMFL Bottles seized by Central Crime Station

In an effort to manage and treat fish waste generated at Modern Fish Selling Center at Junglight, the Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) has initiated an onsite processing of fish and other meat waste into manure through Organic Waste Converter (Electric Composter). The waste is

being converted into organic compost. Therefore, all the fish vendors in and around Modern Fish Market at Junglight have been asked to ensure that the fish waste shall not contain any gritty matter like pieces of stone, metal, etc., to protect the machine's performance. Further, they have also been asked to

ensure that the premises are kept clean and odours free, since the hygiene of fishes are a priority. Any non compliance of the provisions of the direction will attract penalty under the provisions of the Port Blair Municipal Council-Solid Waste (Handling & Management) Bye-Laws, 2017, a release from the PBMC Secretary said here.

Indian women's hockey team confident of taming Malaysia in five-match series



New Delhi, April 3
High on confidence after a spate of good results, the Indian women's hockey team, led by ace goalkeeper Savita, will start as favourites in the five-match series against Malaysia beginning on Thursday.
The Indian team go into the series after a successful outing in Spain earlier this year, where it defeated hosts and 2018 world cup bronze medallists, once (5-2), drew twice (1-1 and 2-2) and lost once (2-3).
The Indian team had further improved its performance by

holding last year's World Cup runners-up, Ireland to a 1-1 draw before registering a 3-0 win.
"Always raising the bar is not easy, that demands discipline and taking responsibility. That ownership is again one of the main areas I would like to see our team improve. Our challenge is not our opponent but always ourselves," said Indian women's hockey team's chief coach Sjoerd Marjine.
The last time India met Malaysia in a big event was at the 2017 Asia Cup, where it won 2-0 in the round robin

league before winning the title in a tense final against China. "It is difficult to say how they play as we have not played against them in a while but the last time I saw Malaysia was during the Asian Games in Jakarta and that is a while ago. From what I saw there, they like to play long aerial balls and like to defend with a lot of passion," Marjine said.
The matches between the two countries will take place every alternate day, starting Thursday. The final match of the series will be played on April 11.

Top Indian shuttlers PV Sindhu and Kidambi Srikanth advanced to the second round of the Malaysian Open World Tour Super 750 tournament in Kuala Lumpur today.

Olympic and world

championship silver medallist Sindhu staved off a spirited challenge from World No. 20 Aya Ohori 22-20, 21-12 to record her sixth win over the Japanese. India Open finalist Srikanth beat Indonesia's Ihsan Maulana Mustofa 21-18, 21-16.
Fifth seed Sindhu will now look to avenge her All England loss against Korea's Sung Ji

Hyun whom she faces next, while Srikanth will meet Thailand's Khosit Phetpradab tomorrow.
HS Prannoy, who had reached the quarterfinals last week at New Delhi, however, bowed out after losing 12-21, 21-16, 21-14 to Sitthikom Thammasin of Thailand following a hard-fought battle.

The man who had lost his way and his place in the National squad, after winning World Cup gold and silver medals, with a world record to boot, last year, Shahzar Rizvi has fought his way back into the team for the World Cups to be held in Beijing and Munich.
Shahzar was able to regain his berth in the team, thanks to a fine spell in the selection trials. Asian Games gold medallist Saurabh Chaudhary, who recently won an individual and mixed gold in the first World Cup, did top the rankings, but has been kept in the MQS section, as he has already won an Olympic quota place.
The Beijing World Cup will be held from April 22 to 28 and the World Cup in Munich will be from May 25 to 30.

UAE Cabinet announces new process of visa facilitation

Abu Dhabi, April 3
The UAE Cabinet has announced that a new process of visa facilitation will take into account salary of the expat workers, rather than job title to sponsor their immediate family member to come and stay with them.
In a tweet, the UAE government said that the Cabinet has approved new facilitation for expats sponsoring family members and reaffirms UAE's position as a hub for talents and the land of opportunities.
A statement by the General Secretariat of the Cabinet stated that the amended provisions now

indicate income as a requirement for sponsoring family members, such as wife and children, subject to conditions which include minimum salary of 4,000 Dirhams or 3,000 Dirhams plus accommodation. The male sponsor must also hold a profession which allows him to sponsor his family. However, the mother is not allowed to sponsor them. The UAE government website also clarifies that the Domestic helpers and certain other categories cannot sponsor their families regardless of their salary. A large number of Asian expats especially Indians work as domestic help in the UAE.


