## FIGHT AGAINST COVID-19

### Administration ensuring adequate supply of medical equipments

Port Blair, Aug.4

The Department of Disaster Management in tandem with Department of Health has taken various steps to ensure uninterrupted smooth supply of medical equipment in A &

N Islands. As part of this, 90,000 N-95 Mask, 15,000 PPE kits, 15,000 Goggles and 20,000 pairs of Gloves has reached Port Blair today by private cargo ship. Meanwhile, the Administration has also taken steps to

air cargo sufficient number of Gloves, TrueNat testing kits, Oxymeter etc. The supplies are likely to reach the Islands soon. The Administration has also taken steps to procure sufficient number of disease. CBNAAT testing kits, RTPCR kits, Rapid Antigen testing kits, beds, face shields, shoe cover, disposable medical caps etc. These equipments are crucial in the fight against COVID - 19 disease. It is worth mentioning that the supply chain of the COVID-19 disease essential medical items is being constantly monitored at senior level, a press release from Secretary, Disaster Management said.

## Precautionary measure to contain spread of COVID-19 Service of stage carriage buses, autorickshaws, taxis & jeeps suspended till Aug 11

### Bus service to be provided to employees working in Departments involved in essential services

Port Blair, Aug 4

To contain the spread of COVID-19 in the South Andaman District, the Directorate of Transport, A&N Administration in an order issued today, has decided to suspend public transport service till August 11. The decision has been taken following increased movement of general public in the public transport service operated in South Andaman District which might be one of the medium for

transfer of virus between the infected and non-infected persons resulting in faster spread of the virus. The Order stated that the following transport restrictions shall come into effect in the Port Blair and Ferrargunj Tehsils under South Andaman District from the midnight of 04.08.2020 till the midnight of 11.08.2020. > Services of all Stage carriage buses (STS and Private) shall remain

suspended during this period. > Services of passenger autorickshaws, taxis and jeeps shall remain suspended during this period. However, for the movement of employees working in the Departments involved in essential services for performing their duties, bus service would be provided by strictly following the safety protocols, the order to this effect issued by the Director of Transport said.

## Towards drug free society: community based services for addicts

### 15 bedded Integrated Rehabilitation Centre to be set up in all three Districts of A&N Islands

Port Blair, Aug 4

To address the issue of drug addiction in the Islands, a proposal was sent to Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment for setting up of a 15 bedded IRCAs in all the three Districts of A&N Islands. Accordingly, the Ministry has sanctioned IRCAs to be operated under the administrative control of the respective Deputy Commissioners. Necessary bank accounts have been opened in all the three Districts and linked with PFMS portal. The IRCA in each District will be operationalised after receipt of funds from the Ministry. The Integrated Rehabilitation Centre

for Addicts (IRCA) provides a whole range of community based services for the identification, motivation, counseling, de-

addiction, after care and rehabilitation for Whole Person Recovery (WPR) of addicts, to make a person drug free, crime free and gainfully employed. Apart from this, the Department of Social Welfare is also organizing Art of Living sessions for the inmates of Swadhar Greh, Senior Citizen Home for male and shelter for Divyang Children. Accordingly, two Art of Living sessions by Vyakti Vikas Kendra, are being conducted in a month for the inmates. During the sessions, meditation, pranayam and sitting yoga are demonstrated for women, senior citizens and disabled children, a press release from Social Welfare said here.

with the objective for India to become food factory of the world. The gamut of exhaustive reforms and measures are intended to strengthen all activities and services in agriculture, horticulture and allied sectors through creation and development of agriculture infrastructure, micro food enterprises, value chains and logistics for fishery and animal husbandry, medicinal and herbal plants, bee keeping and Operation Green. Significant legislative amendments have been made to create conducive environment for agriculture.

Appreciating the efforts of NCDC, the Minister said that a key strategy in the ecosystem is to facilitate involvement of youth in cooperatives. Formation of new cooperatives is a prerequisite for bringing new life and dedication in the realm of cooperative movement. The guidance videos in different languages covering 18 States would also strengthen and deepen the major initiatives of our Government to promote and form 10,000 FPOs. NCDC has a major role in formation of FPOs in cooperative mode. More states would be added to the collection of guidance videos on NCDC Sahakar Cooptube Channel in due course of time.

NCDC as an apex level statutory institution under the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare has achieved tremendous success with cumulative financial assistance to cooperatives to the tune of Rs.1,54,000 crore. Beginning with meager disbursement of Rs.2.36 crores in 1963, NCDC disbursed around Rs.28,000 crore during 2019-20. NCDC has made an unprecedented progress in the last six years. It has achieved 83% of the cumulative financial assistance calculated since 1963, during these last six years alone.

Cooperatives in India have come a long way and have proven their success in improving the condition of farmers and economic development. Largely as association of small and marginal farmers and rural poor, the cooperatives have acquired a huge network of over 8.50 lakh organizations and 290 million members.
