PBMC executes various projects under AMRUT Scheme to enhance livability index of citizens

67 citizen centric projects out of 79 approved by MoHUA completed; rest to be finished by March 2021

Port Blair, Sept. 4

Port Blair city was selected under AMRUT (Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation) implemented from 2015 by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs along with other cities with a mission to provide and improve water supply, storm water drainage system and development of green space. Under this mission, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has approved 79 projects covering the components of water supply, drainage system and green spaces.

Under this, Port Blair Municipal Council has so far completed 67 projects which include 3 Open Air Gyms one each at Gandhi Park, Marina Park and Sunder colony have been made functional besides 1 water reservoir at Dairy Farm has also been made operational. Apart from this, approximately 25 kilometers of water distribution network system covering 17 Wards have been laid and 2 kilometers of storm water drainage



system in 5 Wards have been constructed. These citizen centric facilities will benefit approximately 23000 households, covering 17 Wards across the city. In addition to this, all the existing street lights have been replaced with LED lights covering 14441 poles across the entire city of Port Blair.

Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Rolls; Election Commission of India fixes Jan 1, 2021 as qualifying date for enrollment of new electors

CEO, A&N Islands holds meeting to discuss streamlining of enrollment of new and left out electors

Port Blair, Sept. 4

The Special Summary Revision (SSR) of Photo Electoral Rolls has been scheduled by Election Commission of India with reference to January 1, 2021 as the qualifying date for enrollment of new electors. In this context, a meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), A & N Islands, Shri K R Meena with all District Election Officers (DEOs), Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) / Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs) in the conference hall of Secretariat today. DEO North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar District along with all AEROs attended through video conference.

The objective of the meeting was to streamline the process of verification of existing entries in the electoral roll and also



enrollment of new and left out electors so as to prepare an error free and healthy Electoral Roll. Currently, the Commission is carrying out pre-revision activities which cineraria includes rationalization of polling station, removal of discrepancies of DSEs, EPICs etc. so that an error free and healthy electoral roll is prepared before the draft publication.

CEO emphasized on the rationalization of Polling Stations and formation of section as per the instruction contained in Manual on Polling Station 2016 in consultation with political parties. The main objective of rationalization is to group all the family members and neighbours in a section and maintain uniformity of addresses in Electoral Roll and EPIC. Direct Benefit Transfer for LPG 'PAHAL' scheme receives overwhelming response in A&N Islands

85% LPG consumers receive subsidy through DBT; efforts on to achieve 100% coverage

Port Blair, Sept. 4

Direct Benefit Transfer for LPG (DBT-L) scheme titled 'PAHAL' was implemented by Government of India to ensure that the subsidy benefit meant for the genuine domestic consumer reaches them directly without any pilferage. This further protected the entitlement of domestic cylinders to the rightful beneficiaries by taking away the incentive for diversion. In a press release, the Director, CS & CA, stated that the UT Administration received overwhelming response to the scheme from the domestic LPG consumers and approximately 85% of LPG beneficiaries are presently receiving their LPG subsidy in their respective savings bank accounts.

The release further mentioned that the Administration is committed in extending its support to all the left out beneficiaries to achieve 100% coverage of the PAHAL scheme in this UT and thereby ensuring that the benefits of the scheme is extended to all the consumers of this UT. The concerned consumers have been informed to furnish their Know Your Customer (KYC) details including Aadhaar number and Bank account number to the respective LPG distributors immediately for direct transfer of the subsidy amount.

following conditions would be eligible for assistance under ADIP Scheme viz. an Indian citizen of any age, holds a 40% Disability Certificate, his monthly income from all sources not exceeding Rs. 20,000/- per month, in case of dependents, the income of parents/guardians should not exceed Rs. 20,000/- per month and who has not received assistance during the last 3 years for the same purpose from any source. However, for children below 12 years of age, this limit would be one year.

Income certificate of beneficiaries staying in orphanages and half-way homes etc. will be accepted on certification of District Collector or Head of the organization concerned.

(i) Up to Rs. 15,000/- per month	(i) Full cost of aid/appliance
(ii) Rs.15,001/- to Rs. 20,000/- per Month	(ii) 50% of the cost of aid/appliance

Beneficiaries fulfilling the above criteria may apply to the Director, Directorate of Social Welfare in the prescribed format available with the Social Welfare Department.

The documents required for registration are Disability Certificate certifying minimum 40% disability issued by the authorized Medical officer of Andaman & Nicobar Administration; 2 nos. passport size photographs of the applicant; income certificate from Revenue Authority in the space provided in the form self attested copy of Aadhar Card is mandatory.

Eligible and interested Divyangjan have been requested to submit the filled application form in the Department of Social Welfare, Goalghar or in the Office of the CDPO Concerned or to the Anganwadi Worker by 30th September, 2020, a press release from Nodal Officer (Disability) said.
