### Agriculture is central to Indian identity; it's our tradition, our way of life: Vice President

#### As a nation we can prosper only if our farm sector grows

Chandigarh, Nov. 4 (PIB) The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today underlined that agriculture has always been central to the Indian identity and as a nation we can prosper only if our farm sector grows. Addressing a gathering during the inauguration of CII Agro Tech -2022 in Chandigarh today, the Vice President said that sustainability and food security go hand in hand. "There cannot be long term



food security without sustainable agricultural practices," he stressed. Shri Dhankhar, who arrived today on his maiden tour to Chandigarh after taking over as the Vice President, described agriculture as a tradition and a way of life in India. Referring to the strides made during the past 75 years in the field of agriculture, he stressed the need to adapt our agriculture according to new requirements and new challenges in

processing and value addition. Mentioning that the United Nations has unanimously adopted India's proposal to declare 2023 as the International Year of Millets, Shri Dhankhar said that in a world faced with food shortage, water scarcity and unprecedented climate crises, focus on millet cultivation comes as a smart solution. Listing various affirmative steps taken by the Government for farmers' welfare such as PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, Soil Health Cards, Fasal Bima Yojana and the KUSUM scheme, the Vice President said that farmers are backbone of India's growth; care should be taken to address their concerns as well. Calling for out of the box solutions for various problems facing the agriculture sector, he stressed the need to increase synergy between research institutions and industry.

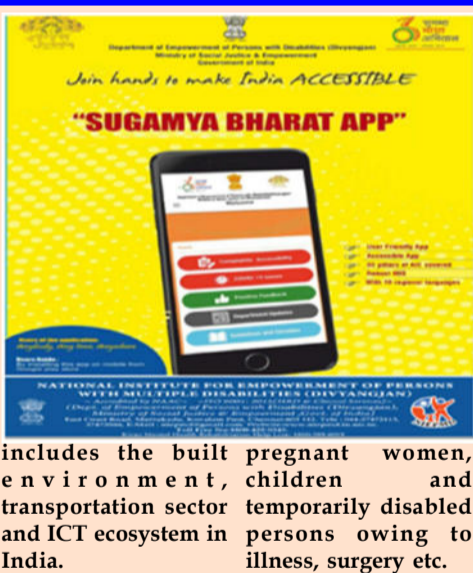
## MP sanctions Rs. 20 Lakhs from MPLADS fund for setting up Fish Cold Storage Chamber at Panighat Fish Landing Jetty

men's team has won three silver medals in the Asian Team Squash Championships and seven bronze medals. Earlier, the Indian women's team settled for the Bronze medal after losing to Malaysia 1-2 in the semifinals.

(Contd. from page 1) school education from primary to higher secondary stood at 25.57

crore as compared to 25.38 crore enrolment in 2020-21, registering an increase of 19.36 lakh enrolments. The total enrolment of Children with Special Needs in 2021-22 stands at 22.67 lakh as compared to 21.91 lakh in 2020-21.

The Ministry also said, over 95 lakh teachers are engaged in school education during 2021-22 out of which more than 51 percent are female teachers. Further, in 2021-22, the Pupil Teacher Ratio (PTR) stood at 26 for primary, 19 for upper primary, 18 for secondary, and 27 for higher secondary showing an improvement since 2018-19.

In 2021-22, over 12.29 crore girls are enrolled in primary to higher secondary showing an increase of 8.19 lakh as compared to the enrolment of girls in 2020-21.

It also said that the total number of schools in 2021-22 stood at 14.89 lakhs as compared to 15.09 lakhs in 2020-21. The decline in total schools is mainly due to closure of private and other management schools and the clustering of schools by various States. (Source: india.gov.in)

applying for financial assistance under this scheme are Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act,1860; a public Trust registered under any law for the time being inforce, a private limited non-profit company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act,1956; Universities/ Institutions of higher learning recognized by University Grants Commission(UGC), Training institutes of Central and State Government/UT Administration including Panchayati Raj Training Institutes and duly registered Cooperative Societies of Women/ Self Help Groups.

The selected organization would have the responsibility to motivate, identify and select women to be trained in accordance with the criteria of the scheme from villages/urban localities having a substantial minority population. The organizations will involve Head of the Gram Panchayat/Municipal Body/ Local Authority for identification/ selection of women trainees.

The details of the trainees will be submitted by the organization before the start of training through the Online Application Management System (OAMS) for Nai Roshni, once the project is approved.
