PM Modi inaugurates 106th Indian Science Congress in Jalandhar

Jalandhar, Jan 3
The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today delivered the inaugural address at the 106th session of the Indian Science Congress. Reflecting on the theme of the event this year - 'Future India: Science and Technology' - the Prime Minister said that India's true strength will be in connecting its science, technology and innovation, with its people. He recalled the great Indian scientists of the past, including Acharyas J.C. Bose, C.V. Raman, Meghnad Saha, and S.N. Bose, and said that they served the people through "minimum resources" and



"maximum struggle." "The life and works of hundreds of Indian Scientists are a compelling testament of integration of deep fundamental insights with technology development and nation-

building. It is through our modern temples of science that India is transforming its present and working to secure its future," the Prime Minister said. The Prime Minister recalled our former Prime

Ministers Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri ji and Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee ji. He said that Shastri ji gave us the slogan: "Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan," while Atal ji added "Jai Vigyan" to it. He said that now the time has come

to take a step further, by adding "Jai Anusandhan." The Prime Minister emphasized that the pursuit of science is fulfilled through the achievement of two objectives: generation of profound or disruptive knowledge; and use of that knowledge for socio-economic good. ISRO to set up Space Technology Park and Museums

New Delhi, Jan 3
The ISRO has plans to set up Space Galleries in various locations in the country. The Space Galleries are expected to disseminate the knowledge about space science and technology amongst the citizens of our country. The Gallery will consist of interactive methods/models describing the principles of space science and technology. Initially, Space Galleries are planned to be established

at Birla Science Centre at Hyderabad, Nehru Science Centre at Mumbai and National Science Centre at Pragati Maidan in New Delhi. In addition to this, ISRO has taken initiatives to establish space gallery in all the national museums/science centres (under Ministry of Culture) across the country in a phased manner. In addition to the Space Galleries, ISRO is planning to establish Knowledge centres, mobile exhibitions,

competitions amongst students and various talks/lectures on Space Science/technology related aspects. This information was provided by the Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Development of North-Eastern Region (DoNER), MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh in written reply to a question in Rajya Sabha today.

New vessel- 'Sea Link' launched

Tourism Secretary invites more private players to strengthen connectivity in Isles

A new vessel in the private sector named 'Sea Link', a project of 'Sea Link Adventures India Pvt. Limited', is scheduled to start its operations from Port Blair to Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep from tomorrow (Jan 4). The vessel was formally launched by the Secretary Tourism, Shri Yashpal Garg at Phoenix Bay Jetty this evening, in the presence of the Director Shipping Services, Capt. Ashutosh Pandey as guest of honour. The Adhyaksh ZPSA, Shri Sandeep Kumar Mandal was also present on the occasion. Addressing the gathering,

the Secretary congratulated the team of Sea Link Adventures for launch of the vessel. He said Tourism Department acts as facilitators in tourism promotion activities in Isles and more participation of youths and private players in shipping and other sectors is expected in the coming days. The Secretary informed that the footfall of tourists at Swaraj and Shaheed Dweep has increased with the plying of a good number of private vessels today as compared to a few years ago. "Though it is a private venture, but the increase in the connectivity is boon for the Tourism Industry of the

Isles", the Secretary added. He informed that for further promotion of tourism, the Veer Savarkar International Airport has been declared as authorized Immigration Check Post for entry into/exit from India. A request has also been made to Central Govt. to extend incentives for operating international flights from the Veer Savarkar Airport which also include allowing stopover for the flights destined to/from South East Asia. In his brief speech, the Director Shipping Services, Capt. Ashutosh Pandey welcomed the addition of another private vessel in the shipping sector which is the life line of people here.

Shri Faiz Asif, one of the Directors of the Company informed that after their Sea Walk venture at North Bay and Swaraj Dweep, now the Company has entered in Shipping Line. He said the vessel 'Sea Link' has obtained all necessary permissions from DG Shipping and all statutory bodies of Gol. The vessel is ready to sail on her maiden voyage for Swaraj and Shaheed Dweep from Port Blair and back tomorrow. The new vessel has a seating capacity of 200 passengers of which 27 seats are business class. The other three Directors of the Company present at the launch included S/Shri Rajendra Dixit, Manish Agarwal and Anoop Kumar.

Policy recommendations by GST Council Dates for furnishing forms GSTR-3B & GSTR-1 extended

Port Blair, Jan.3
The Commissioner (GST), A&N Islands has sought the attention of the trade to the policy recommendations made by the GST Council in its 31st meeting held on Dec 22, 2018 at New Delhi, which may have positive impact on the trade. These recommendations include: 1. ITC in relation to invoices issued by the supplier during FY 2017-18 may be availed by the recipient till the due date for furnishing of FORM GSTR-3B for the month of March, 2019, subject to specified conditions. 2. One more window for completion of migration process is being allowed. The due date for the taxpayers who did not file the complete FORM GST REG-26 but received only a Provisional ID (PID) till 31.12.2017 for furnishing the requisite details to the jurisdictional nodal officer shall be extended till 31.01.2019. Also, the due

date for furnishing FORM GSTR-3B and FORM GSTR-1 for the period July, 2017 to February, 2019/quarters July, 2017 to December, 2018 by such taxpayers shall be extended till 31.03.2019. 3. Late fee shall be completely waived for all taxpayers in case FORM GSTR-1, FORM GSTR-3B & FORM GSTR-4 for the months / quarters July, 2017 to September, 2018, are furnished after 22.12.2018 but on or before 31.03.2019. 4. Taxpayers who have not filed the returns for two consecutive tax periods shall be restricted from generating e-way bills. This provision shall be made effective once GSTN/NIC make available the required functionality. 5. All the supporting documents/invoices in relation to a claim for refund in FORM GST RFD-01A shall be uploaded electronically on the common portal at the time

of filing of the refund application itself, thereby obviating the need for a taxpayer to physically visit a tax office for submission of a refund application.

Parliament passes NCTE amendment Bill

New Delhi, Jan 3
Parliament has passed the National Council for Teacher Education (Amendment) Bill, 2018, with the Rajya Sabha approving it on Thursday. The Lok Sabha had already passed it. The bill seeks to grant retrospective recognition to Central and State institutions which had conducted teacher education courses without approval by the Council. This will be a one-time measure to ensure that the

future of about 17 thousand students having degrees from such institutions is secured. All institutions running teacher education courses, such as B.Ed, have to obtain recognition from the Council. Replying to a discussion on the bill, Human Resource Development Minister, Shri Prakash Javadekar said 23 state and Central universities and colleges offering B.Ed

Cyclonic storm 'Pabuk': Islanders & tourists advised to take precautionary measures

Port Blair, Jan.3
A cyclonic storm 'Pabuk' may emerge into Andaman Sea around the forenoon of 5th January 2019 as per IMD reports. Heavy to heavy rain is expected in few places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and wind speed will be 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph over ANI sea by next 48 hrs. Sea will be rough and very rough from 4th to 7th, Jan, 2019 which may affect the passenger vessel movement also from Swaraj Dweep (Havelock) and Shaheed Dweep (Neil).



Fishermen have been advised not to venture into sea. All islanders and tourists have been advised to take precautionary

measures and plan accordingly, a communication from the Assistant Director (Ops.), DDM said.

Sydney Test: Cheteshwar Pujara torments Australia as India end Day 1 at 303-4

Sydney, Jan 3
Cheteshwar Pujara contributed an unbeaten 130 to India's 303 for four on the opening day of the fourth Test against Australia on Thursday, keeping the tourists firmly on track for a historic breakthrough with his third century of the series. The hosts, facing a desperate scrap to avoid being the first Australia team to lose a series to India on home soil, managed to dislodge Mayank Agarwal after a bright 77, Virat Kohli for 23 and Ajinkya Rahane for 18. Pujara, however, would just not budge and eked out his innings at a rate of little more than a run every other ball to take his series tally to 458 and add another century to those that helped India to victories in Adelaide and Melbourne.



Those victories to Australia's one win in Perth means India only need to avoid a defeat in the final Test at the Sydney Cricket Ground (SCG) to secure their maiden Test series triumph Down Under. Again India's rock, Pujara put together partnerships of 116 with Agarwal, 54 with Kohli, 48 with Rahane and finished the day with an unbroken stand of 75 with Hanuma Vihari, who

will resume on day two on 39 not out. Australia's bowlers laboured manfully on a hot day but it was hard to avoid the conclusion that they were firmly behind the eight-ball from the moment Tim Paine lost the toss. India have never lost a test match when Kohli has won the toss -- winning 18 and drawing three -- but more importantly the tourists had the opportunity

to bat the Australians out of the game as they did in Melbourne. Josh Hazlewood struck early on a wicket with a greenish tinge to remove KL Rahul for nine but that only brought Pujara to the crease to join Agarwal, the senior man initially happy to let the opener take the scoring load. Agarwal faced some hostile short bowling from the Australian pacemen, brushing off blows to his elbow and helmet as Mitchell Starc, in particular, gave him a thorough going over. After adding a second half-century to add to his first on debut in Melbourne, the 27-year-old opened up with a couple of sixes off Nathan Lyon only to hole out to Starc at long on going for a third.

Serena Williams sweeps Hopman Cup singles ahead of Slam record bid



Perth, Jan 3
Serena Williams completed a clean sweep of her singles matches at the mixed teams Hopman Cup in Perth Thursday as she prepares for her bid to make Grand Slam history at the Australian Open. The winner of 23 Slam singles titles, Williams was made to work a little harder than expected by young Brit Katie Boulter in the United States' final group tie, but prevailed in straight sets to make it three victories from as many outings. However, the 37-year-old's perfect singles record this week wasn't enough to keep the USA in contention at what is expected to be the last Hopman Cup, where she has twice been

a winner. Williams and Frances Tiafoe were already eliminated after losing their opening two ties. Watched by her daughter Alexis Olympia, Williams' 6-1, 7-6 (7/2) win over the 97th-ranked Boulter followed victories over former top 10 player Belinda Bencic and Greece's Maria Sakkari earlier in the week. Currently ranked 16th, Williams needs just one more Grand Slam singles title to equal the record of Australian Margaret Court, but hasn't won a major since the Australian Open in 2017. She gave birth to her daughter in late 2017 and was beaten in the Wimbledon and US Open finals last year.

Surface Current speeds vary between 40-64 cm/sec. High waves in the ranges of 3.0 - 4.0 meters have been forecasted during the same time along the west coast of Nicobar Islands from Ten Degree Channel to Great Channel. Surface Current speeds vary between 40-61 cm/sec. Due to Tropical Cyclonic Storm 'Pabuk' very likely to emerge into Andaman sea around the forenoon of Jan 5, 2019, squally wind speed between 40 and 50 Kmph gusting to 60 Kmph and gradual increase in speed up to 75 Kmph likely from Jan 4, over Andaman sea. The Fishermen have been advised not to venture into Andaman Sea during Jan 4-7 and into adjoining southeast and eastcentral Bay of Bengal during Jan 6-7. The Fishermen who are in deep sea were also advised to return to the coast by the night of Jan 3. of 2015 and Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare letter No. S-11011/16/2012-CGHS (P) dated 8th April, 2015, the DHS has emphasized all General Duty Doctors and specialist, the need of prescribing drugs with generic name legibly and preferably in capital letters and also to ensure that there is a rational prescription and use of drugs, said the Director, Directorate of Health Services in a press release received here today. With regard to shortage of medicines in the Hospitals, the DHS stated that at present there is no such shortage of essential and life saving medicines in any of the Health Institutions in A&N Islands as reported in the news paper. The Central Medical Store, Directorate of Health Services is having adequate stock of all Life Saving Drugs and Emergency Drugs as per the National List of Essential Medicines for the following ailment viz. Heart Disease, Diabetes, Hypertension, Medicine for Renal Transplant Patient, Chronic Kidney Diseases, Drugs for Dialysis Patients, Medicine for Epilepsy, Medicine for Psychiatric patients, Medicine for ICU (Medical/Surgical), Medicine for Sick New Born Care Unit, Medicine/Drug for OT/Anaesthesia, Medicine for Respiratory illness, Medicine for Skin/Dental/ENT/Eye, Obstetrics & Gynaecology and Medicines for G.I. Tract. He also mentioned that some of the patients insist the Doctors to prescribe branded medicines of different pharmaceutical company based on their treatment obtained from mainland Hospitals. In some cases the patients do not show any interest in using generic medicine prescribed by Doctors owing to the fact that in the past, the Directorate of Health Services used to prescribe branded medicines in brand name. After implementation of National List of Essential Medicines and also in terms of instructions of the Ministry of Health & FW to prescribe generic drugs to the maximum extent with a view to make treatment cost effective and affordable, the patent branded drugs especially Anti Diabetics drugs/medicine of Gliptin Groups were not available in the CMO (Stores) Directorate of Health Services, Port Blair. However, adequate stock of all other anti diabetic generic drugs including insulin for treating of all diabetic patients and also treating and managing serious/complicated diabetic cases are available with the DHS. All the generic drugs are chemically identical to their branded counterparts, the releases added.

Simranjit, Sonia enter quarters of National Boxing Championships

In the third women's National Boxing Championships at Vijayanagar, Karnataka, world Championships medallists Sonia Lather and Simranjit Kaur beat their respective rivals with consummate ease to storm into the quarterfinals yesterday. Commonwealth Games bronze medal winners Pinki Jangra and Manisha Moun both have entered the last eight round. Twenty-year-old Pinki of Haryana defeated Delhi's Pratibha in 51kg class when the referee was forced to stop the

contest in the third round. World Championship bronze medallist Simranjit defeated Himachal's Sandhya 5:0 in the 64kg category. In the 51 kg category, Nikhat Zareen of Telangana beat Likhitha Battini of Andhra Pradesh by 5:0 verdict. Earlier in the day in the 48kg, All India Police's K Bina Devi defeated Khushboo Tokas of Delhi 5:0 to earn a quarterfinal meeting with Tamil Nadu's S. World Championship bronze medalist Lovlina Borgohain of Assam will open her campaign today.

James Neesham goes 6, 6, 6, 6 in one over on comeback



Mount Maunganui, Jan 3
New Zealand batting all-rounder James Neesham smashed five sixes in an over against Sri Lanka in the first ODI of their ongoing three-match series on Thursday. The 28-year-old, who was playing his first international match since June 2017, bombarded the sixes in the 49th over of the match which was bowled by Sri Lanka all-rounder Thisara Perera. Neesham's unbeaten score of 47 runs of 13 balls helped his side put a solid total of 371 on the board. The left-hand

batman narrowly missed the chance to break the record for the fastest ODI century as New Zealand completed their 50-overs limit. Opting to bat first, New Zealand got a good start to their innings as one of their openers played a tone-setting knock of 138 runs. Skipper Kane Williamson and middle-order batsman Ross Taylor contributed a respective total of 76 and 54 to further strengthen their position in the match. The last-minute Cameo by Jimmy Neesham further deflated the spirits of Sri Lanka.

must also focus on innovation and start-ups, the Prime Minister said. He said that the Government has launched the Atal Innovation Mission to promote innovation among our scientists. More Technology Business Incubators have been established in the last four years than in the forty years before that, he added. "Our Scientists must commit themselves to addressing problems of affordable healthcare, housing, clean air, water and energy, agricultural productivity and food processing. While Science is universal, technology must be local for providing solutions relevant to local needs and conditions," the Prime Minister said. The Prime Minister said that big data analysis, artificial intelligence, block-chain etc should be utilised in the agricultural sector, especially to help the farmers with relatively small farm-holdings. He urged the scientists to work towards ease of living for the people. In this context, he mentioned issues such as drought management in low rainfall areas; early disaster warning systems; tackling malnutrition; tackling diseases among children such as encephalitis; clean energy; clean drinking water; and cyber security. He called for time-bound solutions through research, in these areas.
