An insight into the three Policies:

Bird Watching Policy:

Bird watching has become a popular activity among tourists visiting the Islands. These Islands are home to a diverse range of bird species, many of which are endemic to the region. A well-designed bird watching policy will help promote sustainable tourism that generates income for local communities and businesses, while also preserving the natural environment and cultural heritage of the Islands. The policy will also help protect the bird species and their habitats by regulating bird watching activities, minimizing disturbance to their habitats, and preventing any harmful practices that can endanger their populations. It can also contribute to sustainable development, conservation efforts, community involvement while promoting responsible tourism practices that benefit local communities.

Caravan Policy:

Caravans are a unique tourism product, which promotes family-oriented tours even in circuits/destinations which do not have adequate hotel accommodation. The Caravan Policy may add an

exciting new dimension to the Andaman Tourism experience by enabling tourists to explore the Islands in fully equipped caravans. The policy aims to promote and facilitate caravan tourism and the development of caravan parks. This initiative may promote an adventurous, flexible, and sustainable way to experience the Islands' landscapes, beaches and pristine forests. It also offers an opportunity for eco-conscious travelers to enjoy a mobile and self-sufficient stay without the environmental impact of traditional accommodations.

Policy for Luxury Tented Accommodation:

Luxury tents offer a unique and upscale accommodation experience that combines the comfort and amenities of a luxury hotel with the charm and connection to nature that camping provides. These tents are designed to provide a lavish and exclusive setting while being located in beautiful natural surroundings. There is a growing awareness and increasing demand for eco, adventure, wildlife and heritage tourism in

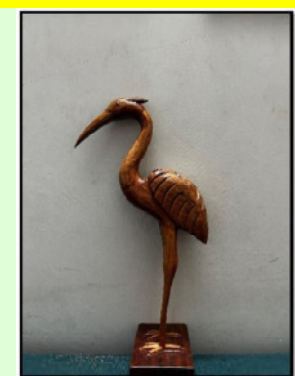

The Tourism Department of A&N Administration has strongly refuted the news item carried by Nicobar Times, a digital news publisher in its news report dated 02.12.2024 claiming that no cultural programmes have been planned for southern group of Islands during the Island Tourism Festival-2024. In this regard, the Department has categorically clarified that the report published are factually incorrect and misleading and stated that performances as part of ITF-2024 have already been planned to be organized at three venues in Nicobar District which includes Car Nicobar, Campbell Bay & Nancowry.

Refuting the news report, the Department has elaborated that programmes will be held as part of ITF at Car Nicobar for two days, Campbell Bay for one day and Nancowry for one day and without any iota of doubt, the people of the district can also enjoy the cultural richness, the festival promises. The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobars has already been requested to carry out necessary arrangements in connection with ITF in Nicobar District. IP&T Deptt. has also requested DC (Nicobars) to setup a stall at the Main Venue i.e ITF Ground in Sri Vijaya Puram for showcasing the rich cultural heritage of Nicobar District.

The Department has labelled the story as baseless, false and malicious and has advised the concerned digital news publisher to seek clarification before publishing such unverified news. It has also emphasized the importance of verifying information from the Department before publishing it to avoid spreading misinformation, which hurts the sentiments of the people residing in the far flung areas of A&N Islands.

It is to mention that the Island Tourism Festival (ITF) is one of the most awaited annual cultural events organized for the residents and tourists of Andaman and Nicobar Islands by the Directorate of IP&T in association with line Departments. This year, the main event will be held at ITF Ground, Sri Vijaya Puram while, programmes as part of the Festival

In the year gone by, ships and aircraft of the Indian Navy have maintained sustained presence across areas of interest through mission based deployments to



preserve, promote and protect national interest. Indian Naval Ships of A&N Flotilla maintain uninterrupted vigil at the approaches to the Straits of Malacca and Coco channel, keeping a sharp watch over one of the busiest shipping lane in the world which passes only 40 nm South of A&N Islands. 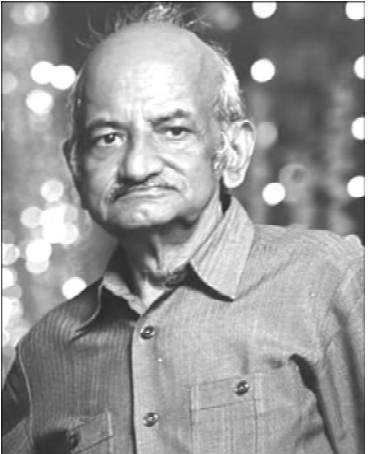
