PMAY (G) treads towards realizing goal of 'Housing for All'

1554 beneficiaries in Isles to be provided all-weather resistant pucca houses equipped with modern amenities

Construction of 513 dwelling units completed

Port Blair, Feb. 4

In a significant step towards realizing the Hon'ble Prime Minister's dream of 'Housing for All by 2022', the Department of Rural Development, A&N Administration has been persistently implementing the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Gramin, the flagship scheme of the Government of India across the Islands. The scheme aims at providing a pucca house with basic amenities inclusive of a hygienic cooking space, functional toilet to the houseless and those living in kutcha houses. Under PMAY-G, beneficiaries are provided unit assistance of Rs.1.2 lakh along with 90 mandays of unskilled labour through convergence with Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee



Scheme (MGNREGS). Additionally, an incentive of Rs.12000/- for construction of toilets through convergence with Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin (SBM-G) is also provided to the beneficiaries.

In the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Department of Rural Development aims to provide 1554 beneficiaries with all-weather resistant pucca houses equipped with all modern amenities like water, LPG, toilet and electricity supply. 513 beneficiaries have already completed the construction of their houses.

The beneficiaries have expressed their heartfelt gratitude to the Administration for helping them to realise the dream of owning a pucca

house. One of the beneficiaries of Beodnabad Gram Panchayat, Shri Viswanathan, who now owns a house under the scheme is a private labourer and is managing his family's livelihood with Rs.8000/- per month. He had a house in a very decrepit condition and sanctioned a house under PMAY (G), during the financial year 2020-21. He completed the construction of house in a very short period with the assistance provided under PMAY-G, work of 90 mandays under MGNREGS and his own resources.

The scheme is being implemented to promote a coactive partnership between the public and the Government. Furthermore, the construction activity under the scheme has had a huge impact

The Directorate of Tribal Welfare, A&N Administration proposes to provide 'Grant of additional scholarship to ST students for pursuing higher studies' under UT Scheme to the students belonging to Scheduled Tribe community notified by the A&N Islands. ST student pursuing graduation, post graduation and post matriculation level non-degree courses for which educational qualification is vocational stream, ITI course, 3 year Diploma Course in Polytechnic etc are eligible to avail the scheme.

In order to avail this opportunity, the applicants have been advised to apply online on the website of the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) at www.scholarships.gov.in. The last date for submission of online application for scholarship under the scheme is 28th February, 2021.

Value of additional scholarship is Rs. 1000/- per month which will be paid to the eligible students through NSP/PFMS. 28,945 persons insured under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana in A&N Islands

51 claims settled; Rs. 102 lakhs disbursed to insured persons

Port Blair, Feb. 4

Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) is available to people in the age group of 18 to 50 years having a bank account who give their consent to join/enable auto-debit. The life cover of Rs. 2 lakhs shall be for the one year period stretching from 1st June to 31st May and is renewable. Risk coverage under this scheme is for Rs. 2 Lakh in case of death of the insured, due to any reason.

As per the data received from the Lead Bank Port Blair, altogether, 28,945 persons have been enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) in these Islands as on Jan 25, 2021. A total of 53 claim received under this



insurance scheme, out of which, 51 claims were settled while two claims are pending with the insurer. Of the claims settled, Rs. 102 lakh were disbursed to 51 insured persons (Rs. 2 lakh for each claim).

As per the salient feature of the scheme, the premium is Rs. 330 per annum which is to be auto-debited in one installment from the subscriber's bank account as per the option given by individual on or before 31st May of each annual coverage period under the scheme. (Contd. on last page)

People urged not to indulge in any tax evasion activities

Andaman & Nicobar Islands UTGST Department conducted search and seizure operation in Swaraj Dweep on 5 hotels & resorts. During search and inspection, it was found that these firms are huge tax defaulters and were indulged in several tax-

evasion activities varying from wrong availment of Input Tax Credit; non-payment of tax to the Government; non-filing/delayed filing of the mandatory statutory returns without paying appropriate returns and mis-declaration under the head zero-rated supplies which pertains

to export of goods and services in order to evade tax.

Meanwhile, the Department of UTGST, Andaman & Nicobar Islands has appealed to all such persons/firms not to avail in-eligible tax credit and pay the tax collected to the Government as well as file their mandatory returns within due time to avoid any legal action that may be taken against them under GST Act, otherwise demand of tax along with appropriate interest and penalty will be raised and action for recovery of the same will be initiated (Contd. on last page)

The Indian Cricket team under Virat Kohli is set to lock horns with Joe Root's England in the first Test of the four-match series, beginning tomorrow at the historic M A Chidambaram Stadium at Chepauk in Chennai.



This game will mark the return of international cricket in India after a yearlong COVID-19 break. India played the last test match before a pandemic against Bangladesh on the 22nd November 2019

at Eden Gardens, defeated Sri Lanka 2-0. Kolkata. India is likely to field three spinners as the Test rubber gets interesting as its result will decide the second finalist of the ICC World Test Championship, who will face New Zealand at The Lord's in June 2021. minimum graduate degree from a recognized university. Students appearing in final year examination of degree course or students who have appeared and their results have not been declared are also eligible for the above scheme. SC/OBC students having family income from all sources of Rs.8 lakh or less per annum are eligible. For this purpose income declaration of self employed parents/guardians issued by Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar is necessary. Employed parents/guardians should obtain income certificate from their employer, thereafter they should also obtain consolidated certificate from Revenue Officer for any other additional source of income, or give self declaration if they have no other income other than employment.
