India is firmly committed to peace but if needed can use all its might to protect its sovereignty: President

Coimbatore, Mar 4
President Shri Ramnath Kovind has asserted that India remains firmly committed to peace, but will use all her might to protect her sovereignty if the need arises. He noted that the country's Armed Forces, exemplified by the air warriors, reflect India's firm resolve to defend the nation. He pointed out that the valour and professionalism of the armed forces were on display very recently, as the Indian Air Force carried out pre-emptive strikes on a known terrorist camp, hinting at the air-borne February 26 surgical strike.

India's growing stature in the comity of nations is consistent with the strength of the armed forces. Shri Kovind was speaking at a function at the Sulur near

Hakimpet station that is located near Hyderabad. President Shri Kovind noted that the Indian Air Force is in the process of a comprehensive modernisation plan, keeping pace with the latest advancements. He lauded the Air Force for being at the forefront of all humanitarian assistance and disaster relief operations, besides safeguarding the sovereign skies of the nation. He said, the resilience and tenacity displayed by India's valiant air warriors is a great source of pride for the Nation.

New Delhi, Mar 4
Indian Air Force chief Air Chief Marshal Birender Singh Dhanoa has dismissed reports that the February 26 air-borne Balakot strike missed to hit the terror targets. He participated in the ceremony to present the President's Colours to the Sulur-based 5 Base Repair Depot near Coimbatore this morning. Later, talking to the press, the Air Chief Marshal said Pakistan tried to retaliate only because the Indian Air Force operation has been successful. He said the number of casualties due to such

operations would be disclosed only by the Government, as the Air Force does not assess the exact numbers of casualties. When asked if Wing Commander Abhinandan would be allowed to fly again, he explained that it would depend on his physical fitness post his ejection from the Mig-21, that normally takes a heavy toll on the pilot's body.

Battle for World Cup slots continue as India eye 2-0 lead in Australia ODIs

Nagpur, Mar 4
Having kicked off their five-match ODI series against Australia on a winning note, India will look to capitalize on the same while World Cup hopefuls will continue to strive for berths when the Men in Blue face the visitors in the second game at Vidarbra Cricket Association Stadium in Maharashtra on Tuesday.
After slumping to a 0-2 T20I series sweep against Australia, the home side rebounded strongly to clinch a six-wicket win in the opening ODI against the Aaron Finch-led team to take a 1-0 lead in the series. While Mahendra Singh Dhoni (59) and Kedar Jadhav (81) helped India cross the target of 237 with 10 balls to spare, it was Indian bowlers—as skipper Virat Kohli said—took the game for India.
Going into the remaining four limited-overs matches ahead of the showpiece cricket event, the Virat Kohli-led side will look to sort out the available two World Cup slots in an otherwise settled Indian squad.



Though opener Shikhar Dhawan failed to click with the bat and departed for a duck, KL Rahul is unlikely to replace him in the upcoming fixtures despite a decent performance in the two-match T20I series. Skipper Aaron Finch's poor form at the top of the batting line-up continues to be a serious concern for Australia, who are eagerly waiting for the return of former skipper Steve Smith and former vice-captain David Warner whose one-year suspensions for their role in the ball-tampering scandal are all set to expire on March 28. Having endured a bad year in ODI cricket in 2018, the visitors are keen to clinch their first series in the 50-over format in two years ahead of the 2019

World Cup.

Jhulan Goswami rises to top of ICC Women's ODI rankings

Dubai, Mar 4
India's veteran pacer Jhulan Goswami on Monday rose to the summit of the ICC women's rankings for ODI bowlers following her influential role in the team's series win over England recently.
The 36-year-old Goswami, who last held the top spot in February 2017, finished with eight wickets in the series while helping her team reach second position in the eight-team championship that provides direct qualification berths to hosts New Zealand and four other top teams in the 2021 Women's World Cup. The latest rankings update also takes into account performances of another ICC Women's Championship series in which defending champions Australia scored a facile 3-0 win over New Zealand to move closer to a



direct berth as they are now at the top with 22 points from 12 matches. India are second with 16 points from 15 matches while New Zealand are on 14 from 15. Reigning World champions England are behind South Africa in fifth position, with 12 points from as many matches. Goswami, the most successful bowler in ODIs with 218 wickets, has inched closer to the record for the most number of days at the top. She

has now been number one for 1873 days, with only retired Australia fast bowler Cathryn Fitzpatrick having spent more time at the top, for 2113 days. Goswami's new-ball partner Shikha Pandey has gained 12 spots to reach fifth position after also finishing with eight wickets against England. It is for the first time in nine years that two India bowlers are in the top five after Goswami and Rumeli Dhar were in that bracket in 2010.

Apps have been put in place by the ECI especially the cVIGIL app by which people can lodge their election related complaints. Citizens can go for alternate method for lodging election related complaints by dialling toll free number 1950 if they come across connectivity issue while using cVIGIL. At present 4 lines are available for 1950 which will be increased to 8 for the benefit of the users, the RO added. Shri Udit Prakash Rai also informed about the National Grievances Service Portal (NGSP) portal which has so far received 300 suggestions and election related complaints between 60-70 so far. The disposal rate of the complaints is 100 percent, he said.
The Nodal Officer, MCC, Shri Yash Chaudhary, an IAS Probationer, through a power point presentation elaborated upon various aspects of MCC when it comes into force immediately after the election is declared. Govt. building, govt. employees and govt. money cannot be used for canvassing of candidates, the Nodal Officer said adding that if media persons come across such MCC violations they can immediately bring to the notice of election authorities.

Shri Nishant Bodh, Deputy Director (Tourism) covered on the topic paid news and 'Media Certification & Media Monitoring' (MCMC). He said paid news as defined by Press Council of India (PCI) is "any news or analysis in any media for a price in cash or kind as consideration". Informing about the role of MCMC committee, the Deputy Director said that the Committee will scrutinize all media within its region of jurisdiction to identify political advertisement in the garb of news. District MCMC shall also actively consider paid news cases referred to it by the Expenditure Observers, he added.
Shri Gautam Gupta, Technical Director NIC and Shri I Rubesh, SOVTECH, informed about "cVIGIL" App - a user-friendly and easy to operate Android application which will be operational only when elections are announced. cVIGIL app enables citizens to report MCC/expenditure violations, they added.
