Education must lift language barrier and let talent flourish: PM

New Delhi, March 4 Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has stressed the need for the education system to overcome linguistic barriers so that talent from rural areas gets the opportunity to flourish. He said, the new National Education Policy will be implemented on a mission mode towards this purpose.

Addressing a webinar on effective implementation of the provisions in the Union Budget for the education sector,



Shri Modi said every area of academics and experts of every language should make available the best content in the country and the world in Indian languages. He said, it is necessary to produce content in Indian languages for every area of expertise, be it medical, engineering, technology or management. Asserting that there is no dearth of talent in the country, Shri Modi said those living in villages and the poor, who do not know any language other than their local language, have no shortage of talent. We should not let the talent of our villages, our poor die due to language difficulties, he said. Prime Minister said, the second biggest focus after health in this year's budget is on education, skill, research and innovation. Final rankings of Ease of Living Index-2020 and Municipal Performance Index-2020 announced

New Delhi, March 4 Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri today announced the release of the final rankings of Ease of Living Index-2020 and the Municipal Performance Index-2020 in New Delhi today in an online event. The rankings under Ease of Living Index-2020 were announced for cities with a population of more than a million and cities with less than a million people. In all, 111 cities participated in the assessment exercise that was conducted last year. Bengaluru emerged as the top performer in the Million Plus category, followed by Pune, Ahmedabad, Chennai, Surat, Navi Mumbai, Coimbatore, Vadodara, Indore and Greater Mumbai. In the Less than Million category, Shimla was ranked the highest in ease of living, followed by Bhubaneswar, Silvassa, Kakinada, Salem, Vellore, Gandhinagar, Gurugram, Davangere and Tiruchirappalli. Her husband who is an auto driver helped her in making her dreams become a reality. He guided her to learn the work of manufacturing of hollow blocks by working in a private firm.



Having gained enough experience in the trade and being courageous enough to face risks that would arise in running a business, Laxmi entered into the Office of the Khadi & Village Industries Board, Middle Point and expressed her need for financial assistance to set up a hollow block manufacturing unit at Calicut. She was advised to talk to a financing bank which could sanction her the loan under PMEGP Scheme.

of Living Index, the assessment framework under Municipal Performance Index-2020 has classified municipalities based on their population, Million plus and less than Million Population.
In the Million plus category, Indore has emerged as the highest-ranked municipality, followed by Surat and Bhopal. In the Less than Million category, New Delhi Municipal Council has emerged as the leader, followed by Tirupati and Gandhinagar.
The Municipal Performance Index examined the sectoral performance of 111 municipalities with Delhi being assessed separately for NDMC, and the three Municipal Corporations across five verticals which comprise of 20 sectors and 100 indicators in all totality. The five verticals under Municipal Performance Index are Services, Finance, Policy, Technology and Governance. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Puri said, as per the Census of 2011, India's urban residents account for 31 per cent of the population and by 2030, it is estimated to reach 40 per cent or 60 crore and by 2050, 50 per cent or 80 crore people. He said, cities are the engines of growth and so the rapid urbanisation also indicates how fast the economy is growing.

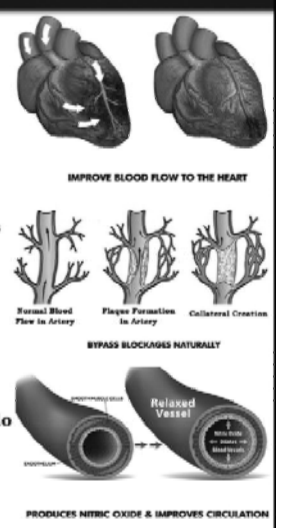
