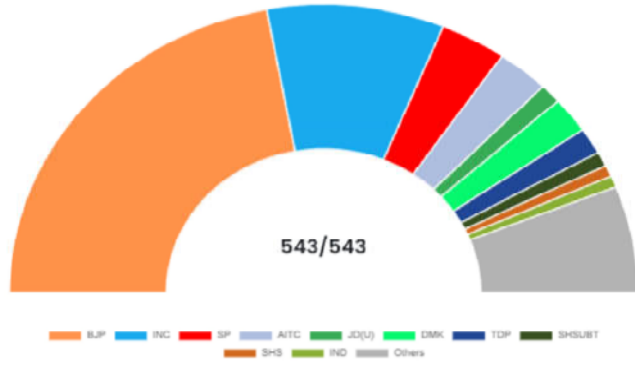

Counting of votes underway for 2024 Lok Sabha elections and Andhra Pradesh & Odisha Assembly Polls

New Delhi, June 4
 The counting of votes is underway for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The counting is also taking place for the Assembly polls in Andhra Pradesh and Odisha and bye-elections to 25 Assembly Constituencies.

General Election to Parliamentary Constituencies: Trends & Results June-2024



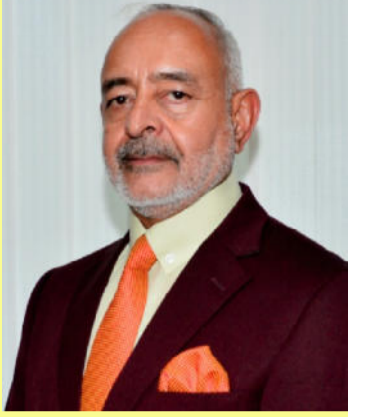
As per latest trends & results for the Lok Sabha elections, BJP-

led NDA has won/leading in 291 seats at the time of going to the press. I.N.D.I.A bloc has won/leading in 234 seats while others have won/leading in 18 seats.

In the election to Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly, Telugu Desam Party has won/leading in 135 seats, Janasena Party in 21, YSRCP in 11 and BJP in 8 seats. In Odisha, out of a total of 147 seats, BJP has won/leading in 78 seats, ruling Biju Janata Dal in 51 and Congress in 14, Independents in 3 and CPI(M) in 1 seat.

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray of BJP elected as Member of Parliament from A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency

Port Blair, June 4
 Shri Bishnu Pada Ray of the Bharatiya Janata Party has been elected Member of Parliament to the lone Lok Sabha seat from the A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency. He defeated his nearest rival Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma of the Indian National Congress by a margin of 24396 votes. Shri Bishnu Pada Ray polled 102436 votes while Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma got 78040 votes. Shri Bishnu Pada Ray secured 50.58 % of votes while Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma got 38.54 % of votes. Shri Ray got 102182 EVM votes and 254 Postal Votes while Shri Sharma got 77829 EVM votes and 211 Postal Votes.

Training on Bee Hive Boxes manufacturing imparted to Officials of Agriculture Deptt.

Port Blair, June 4

A group of 5 Officials of Agriculture Department have undergone a 10 day long training programme on 'Bee Hive Box manufacturing' at the Wood Making Unit of the Industries Department from May 20 to 30, 2024 in order to promote bee keeping activities in these Islands.

In the first phase, the Regular Mazdoors of South Andaman zone have been imparted hands on training on how to prepare bee boxes and subsequently the Officials of various other zones will be trained.

Bee keeping is a part of organic agriculture and an ideal industry for development as subsidiary occupation and could provide livelihood support to lot of Island farmers.



There is an added advantage of enhanced crop production through pollination. It is promoted to maximise economic, ecological and social benefits by diversification, by production of higher quantity and good quality honey and other high value bee hive products for the domestic and export market.

Under the National Horticulture Mission scheme-'Pollination Support through Bee Keeping', the financial assistance is

extended for Bee Colonies at the maximum extent of Rs.800/- per colony (40% of the cost limited to 50 colonies per beneficiary) and Rs. 800/- per hive (40% the cost limited to 50 hives per beneficiary). For Bee keeping equipments including honey extractor (4 frames), food grade container (30 Kg), net, Mask etc., Rs. 8000/- per set is provided (40% of the cost limited to one set per beneficiary), a press release from Deptt. of Agriculture said.

PS Bambooflat seizes 32 kg of venison

Port Blair, June 4

A routine patrol led by Sub-Inspector Rangaswamy, In-charge of OP Wimberlygunj along with PCs S. Srinivasan & Harinder Kumar resulted in a significant seizure of 32 kilograms of illegal venison (Deer meat) on June 2, 2024.

During patrolling in the Padauk Bagicha area, the team noticed a white Omni vehicle bearing Registration No. AN01 L-2332 hasty heading towards Wimberlygunj. The vehicle was promptly stopped for inspection and upon checking, the Police team

recovered 32 kilograms of venison inside the vehicle.

The driver of the vehicle identified as S. Venkat Raman, R/o Valluvar Nagar, Bambooflat was immediately detained. Later, both the vehicle and the illegal venison were seized on the spot U/s 50/51 of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 after observing all Codal formalities. Later, the seized items along with the detained individual were handed over to the Forest Department for further investigation and necessary action.

This operation highlights

the commitment of A&N Police in enforcing Wildlife Protection Laws and preventing illegal trade activities. The patrol team's vigilance and prompt action dented the marketing of illegal venison.

The operation was conducted under the supervision of Insp. Rizwan Hassan, SHO PS Bambooflat and Shri Vinay Mathur, SDPO Bambooflat and under the overall supervision of Smti Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District, a press release from SP(SA) said.

PS Kalighat strikes hard; major cannabis busted in N&M Andaman District

Diglipur, June 4

To conquer the menace of illicit ganja in N&M Andaman District, PS Kalighat proved their mettle once again by ongoing tough against the drug peddlers. On June 1, 2024, based on credible information received, a raiding team led by SI Ashok Kumar Baghel, SHO, PS Kalighat, conducted a raid in the Kishorinagar No.4 area. The team, which included ASI D.K. Singh, HC (D) N Rupesh Kumar, PCs Subrata Biswas, Baikanta Majhi, Ripon Mistry and Sunitha, along with two independent witnesses, was supervised by Shri. Brij Mohan Meena, SDPO Diglipur.

The team reached the suspected house at Kishorinagar No. 4 and conducted a thorough search of the surrounding premises. During the search, at the backside of the suspect's cultivation land, the team successfully confiscated 10 cannabis plants weighing 1.078 kg, which were ingeniously concealed among the banana trees and bushes on the property. Upon enquiring about the plants, Gopal Sarkar admitted to planting the cannabis and revealed that the seeds were supplied by Anadi Sarkar, a resident of



Kishorinagar No. 4.

Subsequently, the team searched Anadi Sarkar's house and seized 136 cannabis seeds. Anadi Sarkar confessed that he had collected the seeds during a Naam Kirtan Puja celebration in Kishorinagar about a year and a half ago. He further explained that he and Gopal Sarkar had chosen the secluded location on Gopal Sarkar's land for cultivation to avoid detection.

Following a thorough interrogation, both the accused persons namely Gopal Sarkar, S/o Late Giris Sarkar, 49 yrs, R/o Kishorinagar No. 04 & Shri Anadi Sarkar, S/o Late Kalipado Sarkar, 50 yrs, R/o Kishorinagar No. 04

confessed to their involvement in the illegal cultivation. They were subsequently arrested, and a case was registered at PS Kalighat under the NDPS Act.

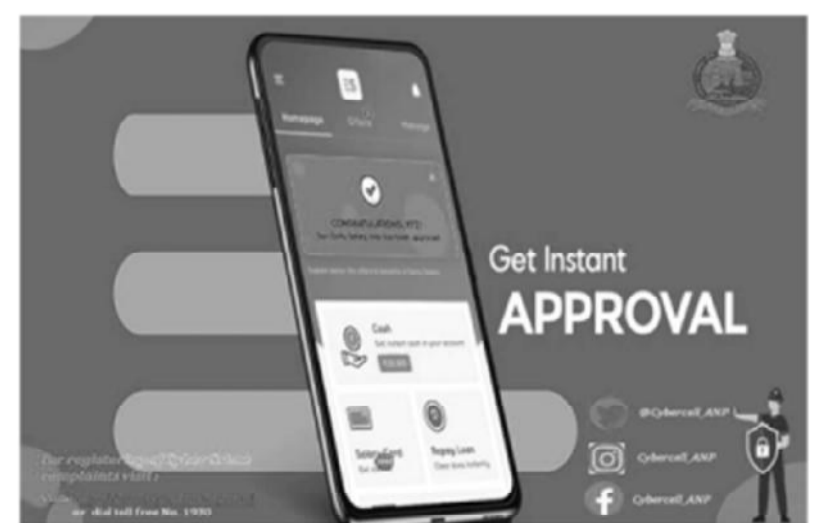
The operation was conducted under the supervision of Shri Brij Mohan Meena, SDPO Diglipur.

A&N Police issues public advisory on illegal digital lending apps

A large number of complaints are being reported nationwide pertaining to illegal digital lending apps, which provide short term loans/ micro credits at exorbitant interest rates along with processing/hidden charges. These apps, which may not be Regulated Entities (RE) by RBI, target members of vulnerable and low income groups, and the borrowers, are asked to provide mandatory access to confidential personal data like contacts, location, photos/videos, in order to avail the loans. This personal data is then misused for blackmail and harassment. The illegal apps make use of bulk SMSs, digital advertisements, chat messengers and mobile app stores, etc. on a mass scale.



All citizens have therefore been advised against the usage of these illegal lending apps, for availing loans. If anyone has been cheated, blackmailed or harassed as a result of using these apps, they have been advised to report the matter to the Cyber Cell, CID, Port Blair or the nearest Police Station of the area without
