Nonagenarian lady wins battle against COVID-19

Early detection of infection & timely approach to hospital-key for successful management of COVID-19

Port Blair, Sept. 5

Smti. Annamma Abraham, aged 90 years, a resident of R.G. Nagar, Aberdeen Bazar (behind ANIIDCO HQ) successfully recovered from COVID-19 and leads her normal, routine life. When she had initial symptoms of cough, occasional fever, body ache, she immediately got tested for COVID. On her testing COVID positive on 23rd August, she was kept in COVID Care Centre at South Point Guest House and monitored regularly. Later, on 27th August when she developed



anti virals and oxygen support. The patient was closely monitored and gradual improvement was noticed. On her recovery from COVID, the nonagenarian was discharged from hospital in a healthy state on 04/09/2020 after remaining in hospital stay for 8 days. The early detection of COVID infection and timely approach to hospital when initial signs of breathlessness is noticed, holds the key for successful management of COVID-19 patients, a press release from Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health) said.

Cultivation of Red Oil Palm as multi crop in A&N Islands Agriculture Deptt. holds meeting with Scientists & Stakeholders

Port Blair, Sept. 5

To meet the ever increasing demand for vegetable oil and to reduce the dependence on import on vegetable oil, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration has identified approximately 4000 hectares of additional lands at Little Andaman, Teressa and Katchal where Red Oil Palm (ROP) can be grown as multi crop. The existing ROP plantation based on 1593 hectares of land in Little Andaman was wound up after the acceptance of Prof. Shekhar Singh Committee report by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. However, considering the emphasis given by the Ministry of Agriculture, GoI on bringing



additional land under ROP cultivation, the A&N Administration has identified the additional lands. The Indian Institute of Oil Palm Research (IOPR), Pedagevi, Andhra Pradesh had also given favourable recommendation for ROP cultivation in A&N Islands.

In this regard, the Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change, GoI has sent a team comprising of Dr. B. Nagarajan, Scientist G and Dr. A. Rajasekaran, Scientist E from Institutes of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB), Coimbatore to conduct detailed field study and to examine various ecological issues at Port Blair on 3rd Sept, 2020.

 - ❖ Daily chart made and put up outside the washroom for cleaning staff.
 - ❖ Complete cordon off the area designated as COVID Management Centre at GB Pant.
 - ❖ Calling bells has been placed in wards of COVID positive patients.
 - ❖ Continuous photographic update received of the cleanliness in wards/washroom and food distribution etc. with feedback loop.
 - ❖ Timing along with menu of diet has been prepared and duly followed and arrangement for the same are being monitored continuously.
 - ❖ Duty roster for helpline 102 prepared.
 - ❖ Provided 50 jugs for distribution of tea/ milk for COVID patients twice a day.
 - ❖ Temperature screening alongwith roster of screening staff for all incoming patients/staff/doctors etc. at OPD and COVID ward of G.B. Pant Hospital setup.
 - ❖ 4 trolley type dustbins and 20 static dustbins has been installed for proper disposal of medical and bio-medical waste along with dedicated staff for waste segregation and scientific disposal placed on duty.
 - ❖ Setting up of testing facility for incoming patients with co-morbidities in G.B. Pant OPD ward starts.
 - ❖ In and Out register with monitoring of all staff/doctors/patients etc. entering and exiting the COVID ward of G.B. Pant Hospital has been setup.
 - ❖ A dedicated room for ambulance driver has been setup.

Simple Ayurvedic Procedures


1. Nasal application - Apply sesame oil / coconut oil or Ghee in both the nostrils (Pratimarsh Nasya) in morning and evening.
2. Oil pulling therapy - Take 1 table spoon sesame or coconut oil in mouth. Do not drink, Swish in the mouth for 2 to 3 minutes and spit it off followed by warm water rinse. This can be done once or twice a day.

During dry cough / sore throat

1. Steam inhalation with fresh Pudina (Mint) leaves or Ajwain (Caraway seeds) can be practiced once in a day.
2. Lavang (Clove) powder mixed with natural sugar / honey can be taken 2-3 times a day in case of cough or throat irritation.
3. These measures generally treat normal dry cough and sore throat. However, it is best to consult doctors if these symptoms persist.




