GST Council cuts rates on Insurance, Medicines, Daily Essentials; Major relief for Common Man, Farmers & Industries

New Delhi, Sept. 4

The GST Council has approved the rate rationalisation with a focus on the common man, labour-intensive industries, farmers and agriculture, health, and key drivers of the economy. Briefing the media in New Delhi last night, Finance Minister, Ms. Nirmala Sitharaman said that the Goods and Services Tax on common man and middle-class items has been reduced from 18 per cent or 12 per cent to 5 per cent. She informed that the GST Council approved exemption of GST on all individual life insurance policies, whether term life, ULIP or endowment policies, all individual health insurance policies, including family floater policies and policies for senior citizens and reinsurance thereof.

All these changes will come into effect from the 22nd of this month, the first day of Navratri. Ms Sitharaman said this move aims to make insurance affordable for the common man and increase insurance coverage in the country. The Finance Minister further announced the



reduction of GST from 12 per cent to NIL on 33 life-saving drugs and medicines, and from 5 per cent to NIL on three life-saving drugs used for the treatment of cancer, rare diseases, and other severe chronic conditions. GST on all other drugs and medicines has been reduced from 12 per cent to 5 per cent. The GST on various medical apparatus and devices used for medical, surgical, dental, or

veterinary purposes, or physical and chemical analysis, has also been reduced from 18 per cent to 5 per cent.

The Finance Minister informed that items such as hair oil, toilet soap, soap bars, shampoos, toothbrushes, toothpaste, bicycles, tableware, kitchenware, and other household articles will now have only 5 per cent GST. She further said that GST on ultra-high temperature

milk, chena and paneer has been reduced to zero from 5 per cent, while all Indian breads will now see a nil rate. Ms. Sitharaman also announced that GST on food items such as namkeen, bhujia, sauces, pasta, instant noodles, chocolates, coffee, preserved meat, cornflakes, butter and ghee has been reduced from 12 per cent or 18 per cent to 5 per cent.

The Minister added that the GST slab on items like air-conditioning machines, televisions above 32 inches, all types of TVs, dishwashing machines, small cars and motorcycles has been lowered to 18 per cent from 28 per cent. Ms Sitharaman said that labour-intensive industries have given strong support, while farmers and the agriculture sector will also benefit from the decisions. She said the GST on all agricultural equipment has been reduced from 12 per cent to 5 per cent.

The Finance Minister further said that Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi set the tone for

DM (SA) reviews arrangements for Durga Puja-2025

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 4

The District Administration, South Andaman, under the Chairmanship of Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, SA convened a coordination meeting with Presidents and Secretaries of Durga Puja Committees along with representatives of all Line Departments today at the Conference Hall of the District Office to review the arrangements for Durga Puja-2025.

At the outset, the District Magistrate welcomed all participants and highlighted the need for collective responsibility

and inter-departmental coordination to ensure peaceful, safe and environmentally sustainable celebrations.

During the meeting, it was decided that adequate police personnel will be deployed at all Puja Pandals and immersion sites to maintain law and order. Puja Committees have been directed to restrict the height of idols to below 16 feet to avoid accidents due to overhead HT lines and to use eco-friendly materials instead of harmful chemicals. Fire and electrical safety were strongly

emphasized, kitchens are to be placed at a safe distance with adequate fire-fighting equipment, while Pandals must ensure insulated wiring, proper earthing and obtain NOCs from the Electricity Department. Joint inspections by Police, Fire Brigade, Electricity Department and Revenue Officers will be conducted before the commencement of festivities.

The use of loudspeakers has been restricted till 10 PM.

Further, all Puja Committees must comply with the guidelines of the

Relentless Anti-Poaching Operations in N&M Andaman results in arrest of 9 more Myanmarese poachers

23 poachers apprehended so far; search & combing operations still in progress

Mayabunder, Sept. 4

In continuation of the on-going Anti-Poaching Operation launched by the Andaman & Nicobar Police on 24/08/2025 to curb illegal poaching activities in vulnerable areas of North & Middle Andaman District, the teams achieved a significant breakthrough by apprehending 9 more Myanmarese poachers from the dense jungles of Khaal Gora near Jal Tikrey, Elizabeth Bay and Talbagan. With this, the total number of apprehensions has risen to 23 so far.

The areas where



these poachers have been apprehended so far-namely Nappi Ghop, Loha Tikrey, Khaal Gora near Jal Tikrey, and Talbagan-are spread across an extensive stretch of nearly 100 sq. km of dense forest. This widespread operation is a testimony of the scale and organized nature of deployment

and coordination with all coastal security stakeholders. Search and combing operations are still in progress across remote forest stretches of N&MA District to ensure that no remnants of these organized poaching groups remain undetected. This operation stands as the largest and most

sustained anti-poaching drive undertaken in N&MA District so far this year, both in scale and intensity. It marks a major step in dismantling organized poaching networks and safeguarding the region's fragile ecosystems. Meanwhile, the

the next generation of tax reforms and ensured that people receive benefits at the earliest. She said that the Government has corrected inverted duty structure issues, resolved classification-related matters, and ensured greater stability and predictability in the GST regime. Rationalising the indirect tax structure, the GST Council also cut the current four slabs down to two by scrapping the 12 per cent and 28 per cent rates, while retaining the 5 per cent and 18 per cent slabs. Revenue Secretary, Shri Arvind Shrivastava said the rationalisation of rates would entail a financial impact of 48,000 crore rupees, which would be "fiscally sustainable for the Centre and the State.
