As on 5th January, 2022 in A & N Islands, the total registration has crossed 19,173, out of which, about 45% are female workers. About 19% workers belongs to Agriculture sector and around 18% workers belongs to construction sector and balance fills domestic, apparel, miscellaneous, others etc. About 50% of workers utilized the

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 406 passengers who arrived here yesterday, 16 positive cases have been detected. Today, 13 flights with 1894 passengers arrived, out of which, 1444 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 450 passengers (includes 63 foreign travellers) and the reports are awaited. About 23 positive cases were found during the test conducted yesterday.

2135 Omicron cases detected in 24 States, UTs: Govt

New Delhi, Jan. 5
The government has informed that so far 2 thousand 135 Omicron cases have been detected in 24 states and Union Territories in the country. Briefing media in New Delhi today, Joint Secretary in the Union Health Ministry, Shri Lav Agarwal said that out of the total Omicron cases, 828 infected people have recovered and there are 1 thousand 306 active cases of Omicron. He said, Maharashtra has reported the highest 653 Omicron cases, followed by 464 in Delhi and Kerala reported 185 cases. Shri Agarwal also informed that a sharp surge in cases of COVID-19 has been witnessed in the country in the last one week. He said, on 29 December, 2021 where the number of COVID cases remained 9 thousand 195, the cases have now gone up to over 58 thousand while the case positivity went up from 0.79 per cent to 5.03 per cent during the same week. He also informed that more than 10 thousand active cases are reported in Six States while 28 States have shown less than 5 thousand active cases. Shri Agarwal also informed that Maharashtra, West Bengal, Delhi, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Jharkhand and Gujarat are the States of concern where there has been a rise in cases. He added that 28 districts in the country are reporting more than 10 per cent weekly positivity of cases. (Source: india.gov.in)

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Blood fruit: a potential fruit cum natural colourant

Blood fruit is a perennial, woody climber that grows taking support of large trees in its natural habitat. Plants bear sweetish sour fruits in bunches, which originate directly from the stem. In backyard gardens, it could be grown using large trees such as mango, jackfruit etc. as live standards and hence, does not require additional space for its cultivation. Fruits have dark red, juicy pulp owing to which it is known as blood fruit. Fruit clusters are borne on old wood and are of about 30-45 cm length weighing 1.0-1.5 kg each. As the fruits are collected from wild/semi-wild conditions and sold in local markets at the rate of Rs. 250-300/- per kg, efforts were made to popularize it as a backyard crop among the island farmers so that the natural populations are conserved. Nursery techniques have been standardized and regenerated seedlings are being provided to various stakeholders to promote the species as a crop. Pulp was found to be a rich source of anthocyanins of which Pelargonidin and Cyanidin were the dominant ones. Use of blood fruit pulp as a natural colourant was also demonstrated.


Benefit: Growing a few liana in the backyards could serve as additional source of income to the farmers besides being a source of nutrients. Further, use of pulp as a natural colourant for beverages could be promoted among the island hoteliers or caterers.

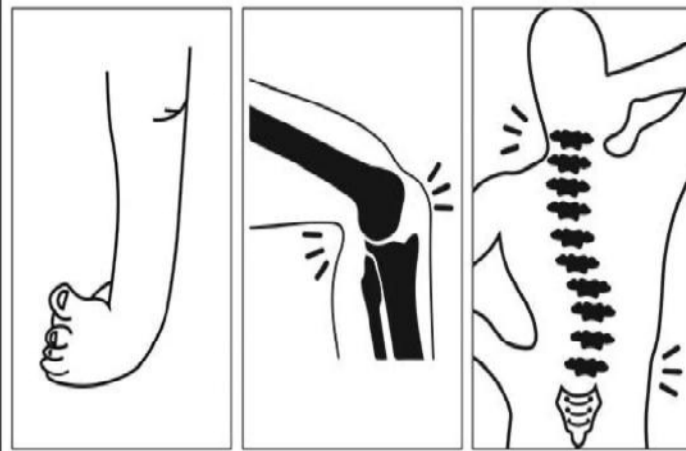

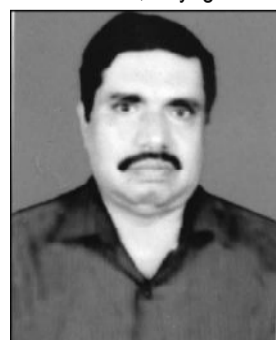

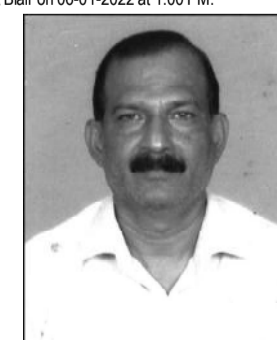
