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Chief Secretary chairs first meeting of State Steering Committee to review preparatory activities for administration of COVID-19 vaccine in A&N Islands

Issues direction for ensuring adequate manning & equipment maintenance of Cold Chain Points

Health Care Workers & Anganwadi Workers to be inoculated with vaccine in first phase

Port Blair, Dec. 5

The first meeting of the State Steering Committee for reviewing the preparatory activities for vaccine administration of COVID-19 vaccine was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Chetan B. Sanghi, Chief Secretary, A & N Administration today. The meeting was attended by Shri Vijay Kumar, Principal Secretary (Finance/Planning), Shri Madhup Tiwari, Additional Director General of Police, Secretaries and Directors of Health Services and Tribal Welfare.

The committee was apprised of the cold chain preparedness, operational planning and human resource mobilization for the anticipated launch of the vaccine.

The Department of Health Services had listed

out the various Cold Chain Handling Points and the Health Care Institutions where such vaccine administration sessions shall be carried out as per the relevant Standard Operating Procedures.

As per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, the Health Care Workers and the Anganwadi Workers will be inoculated with the COVID-19 vaccine in the first phase. The A&N Islands Administration has requested the MoH&FW for inclusion of workers of the Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti (AAJVS) under the Department of Tribal Welfare, in the first phase of the proposed inoculation. The Ministry has assured to take up the issue with the National Expert Group for Vaccine Administration.

The Committee was also informed about the Electronic Vaccine Intelligence Network (eVIN) which is under process of implementation in these Islands with the help of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). eVIN shall make online monitoring of all Cold Chain Points possible.

The Chief Secretary directed that all prescribed guidelines and timelines issued from time to time by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare be adhered to and the District and Block Level Committees to also review the related issues at their level within the stipulated time frame, to ensure adequate manning and equipment maintenance of the Cold Chain Points, a press release from A&N Administration said.

Affordable RAT/ RTPCR for Inter-Island bound passengers

Administration reduces testing charges to Rs. 200; to be applicable from Dec. 7

Port Blair, Dec. 5

In view of the steady decrease in the number of positive cases and to make the testing charges affordable to everyone for the Rapid Antigen Test (RAT)/ RTPCR being conducted on passengers who intend to proceed to Inter-Islands by any mode of transport (Heli/Ship/ATR) will be Rs.200/- henceforth.

The passengers arriving at airport will be charged at Rs. 500/- for the same tests. However, patients arriving from mainland after treatment along with their attenders are exempted from payment.



The revised charges will be applicable with effect from Dec.7,2020 and the validity of the tests will be for 3 days. The District Administration has appealed to the general public for their cooperation in the fight against COVID-19 pandemic, a press release from DC (SA) said.

Additional scholarship to students of OBCs of A&N Islands for pursuing higher studies anywhere in India after Secondary Level (except Class XI & XII)

The Department of Social Welfare has invited applications for providing additional financial assistance (Scholarship) to the Other Backward Classes (OBC) students belonging to non-creamy layer of Andaman & Nicobar Islands for pursuing higher education after Secondary (X) /Senior Secondary (XII), in Government recognized Polytechnic/ITI/College/University anywhere in India, as an incentive to supplement to the cost of their education.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

○ The scholarship shall be open to students belonging to non-creamy layer of OBC of the

Andaman and Nicobar Islands listed in the Notification issued by the Andaman and Nicobar Administration dated 16th December, 2005 and amendments therein.

○ Only those students who belong to OBCs so specified and notified in relation to Andaman and Nicobar Islands and are domicile of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and who have passed Secondary (Class X) / Senior Secondary (Class XII) from a recognized Board of School Education and pursuing higher education in a recognized Institution / University shall be eligible for award of this scholarship.

South Andaman Police confiscates 203 kgs of venison; one person arrested

To curb the menace of illegal trade of wild life products, the South Andaman Police has once again proved their efficiency in curtailing this illegal trade and bringing the culprits in front of law. On 03/12/2020, a credible information was received at PS Pahargaon that one person is carrying all venison at Garacharma near Murdhakhari area. Immediately, a team headed by Insp. D. Jagdishwar Rao, SHO PS Pahargaon reached the spot and recovered 203 kgs of venison from the possession of one person namely P. Sasi Kumar, S/o Late S. Pitchai (44) yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o Garacharma. The said person has been booked under Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 and after observing all codal formalities, the seized venison and detained person were handed over to the concerned officials of A&N Forest Department for further legal action. The market value of the seized venison is over Rs. 1 lakh. The entire operation took place under Shri. Ajay Kumar Rai, SDPO, SA under the overall direction and supervision of Shri. Ravi Kumar Singh, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District, a press release from SP (SA) said.

 - (i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or
 - (ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - (iii) Passport; or
 - (iv) Ration Card; or
 - (v) Voter Identity Card; or
 - (vi) MGNREGA Card; or
 - (vii) Kisan Photo Passbook; or
 - (viii) Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or
 - (ix) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or
 - (x) any other document as specified by the Department.
- Provided further that the above documents shall be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the requirement of Aadhaar under the Scheme.
3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely :—
 - (a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with fingerprint authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
 - (b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
 - (c) in all other cases where Biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response Code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of Quick Response Code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its Implementing Agency.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained hereinabove, no child shall be denied benefit under the Scheme in case of failure to establish his identity by undergoing authentication, or furnishing proof of possession of Aadhaar number, or in the case of a child to whom no Aadhaar number has been assigned, producing an application for enrolment. The benefit shall be given to him by verifying his identity on the basis of other documents as mentioned in clauses I.(b) and I.(c) of the proviso of sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 1, and where benefit is given on the basis of such other documents, a separate register shall be maintained to record the same, which shall be reviewed and audited periodically by the Department through its Implementing Agency.
 5. In order to ensure that no bonafide beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his due benefits the concerned Department in the Union Territory Administration shall follow the exception handling mechanism as specified in the Office Memorandum of Direct Benefit Transfer Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India No. D-26011/04/2017-DBT dated the 19th December, 2017 (available on <https://dbtbarat.gov.in/>).
