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## Formation of Block Level Federations under DAY-NRLM

# BLFs to empower & develop rural areas for better livelihood of local populace through innovative ideas

Port Blair, March 5

The Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs, A&N Administration is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- Nation Rural Livelihood Mission' (DAY-NRLM) in the Islands since 2016 and has formed institutions of rural poor women such as Self Help Groups and Village Organizations (Primary Level Federations/PrLF) under the esteemed guidance and support of the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRDPR), Hyderabad. Time to time capacity building of the members of these institutions is being done with the support of the NIRDPR for their empowerment.

Moving a step ahead towards formation of higher level of federation of rural poor women under DAY-NRLM, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Rural Livelihood Mission (ANIRLM) under the



Directorate of RD, PRIs and ULBs, A&N Administration has formed five Block Level Federations at Prothrapur, Ferrargunj, Rangat, Mayabunder and Diglipur under the guidance and support of a team of Resource Persons of NIRDPR, Hyderabad.

These Block Level Federations (BLFs) are formed by bringing together all Village Organizations (PrLF) in the said Blocks. The BLFs are formed to provide space, voice, better bargaining power and resources to the poor and reducing their dependence on external agencies. Now, all funding to the SHGs shall be routed through BLF which shall ensure proper development of all the SHGs attached to it through Village Organizations. These institutions will partner with Government, Public and Private sectors for the

last mile delivery of social and economic services for the rural poor. It will also promote livelihood collectives, producers cooperatives/ companies for deriving economies of scale, backward and forward linkages and access to information, credit, technology, markets etc.

The formation of these Block Level Federations was done in the presence of State and Block Level Officials attached to ANIRLM, leaders of all Village Organizations (VO) under the Blocks and the Community Resource Persons engaged under DAY-NRLM for hand holding of SHGs and its smooth functioning. Basic orientation about the role, responsibilities and functioning of the BLF was done by the teams of NIRDPR.

Shri Vinay Kumar Jindal, Director (RD/Panchayats) informed that for smooth and effective functioning of BLFs, trainings on SOP of general management, vision building, business development

# Financial assistance to individuals/ SHGs/ Co-operatives/ FPOs; scheme adopts 'One District One Product' approach

Port Blair, March 5

The Department of Industries, A & N Administration is implementing a newly introduced Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Prime Minister Scheme for Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM FME)' under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan with the objective to strengthen backward/ forward linkages, common infrastructure, packaging, branding & marketing of products of micro food processing enterprises. Under the scheme, financial assistance in the form of grant/ seed capital would be provided to individuals/ SHGs/ Co-operatives/ Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs).

The scheme adopts 'One District One Product (ODOP)' approach to reap the benefit of scale in terms of requirements of input, availing common services and marketing of

products. The ODOP identified for the South Andaman District is Marine based Fish products and for Nicobar and North & Middle Andaman District is Coconut based products.

**SCHEME COMPONENTS:**  
 > **Support to Individual Micro Enterprises :** Credit-linked Capital subsidy @ 35% of the eligible project cost with a maximum ceiling of Rs.10.00 Lakh per unit. Beneficiary contribution should be minimum 10% of the project cost.

> **Group Category :**  
 ♦ **Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs)/ Producers Cooperatives :** FPOs and Producers Cooperatives would be provided the following support:

> Credit linked grant @ 35% of the project cost. Maximum limit would be as prescribed.

The Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) is gaining popularity in A&N Islands with more and more people seeking loan under the scheme for setting up income generating ventures. The scheme is being implemented in these Islands through banks. As per the data available with the Lead Bank, under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana against the target of



80.19 Crore, loan amounting to 142.51 Cr have been disbursed which is 177.72% covering 6681 beneficiaries in A&N Islands.

PMMY is an initiative by the Government of India to offer loans under 3

entrepreneurs with existing businesses and loans up to Rs 10 lakh are disbursed under the Tarun scheme

In A&N Islands, under the Shishu Loan scheme, 2896 accounts were opened and a loan amount of Rs 6.85 crores was disbursed. Similarly, under Kishor Loan scheme, 2901 accounts were opened and a loan amount of Rs. 67.17 crores was disbursed. **Ahmedabad Test: India 294/7 in first innings against England at stumps**

Ahmedabad, March 5

India were 294 for 7 in their first innings against England at stumps on the second day in the fourth and final Test match at Narendra Modi Stadium in Ahmedabad. Wicket-keeper batsman Rishabh Pant's brilliant century of 101 from 118 balls gave India a solid lead against England. The hosts are now leading by 89 runs. Washington Sundar on 60 and Axar Patel on 11 were at the crease when stumps were drawn this evening. Earlier, after resuming their play from the overnight



score of 24 for one, India lost six wickets before the Tea on second day. Top guns including Rohit Sharma, Cheteshwar Pujara, Virat Kohli and Ajinkya Rahane parted in quick succession and Shubman Gill and Virat Kohli were removed for duck. After the departure of Washington Sundar also registered a half-century. For the visitors, James Anderson claimed 3 wickets while Ben Stokes and Jack Leach bagged two each. Earlier on the opening day, England were bowled out for 205 in their first innings.
