

Scrutiny of nominations for 3rd phase of LS polls held

New Delhi, Apr 5
 Scrutiny of nominations for the third phase of Lok Sabha elections was held on Friday. Filing of nominations for this phase ended last evening. Monday is the last date for withdrawal of nominations. One hundred and fifteen seats, spread over 12 States and two Union Territories, will go to polls in this phase on the 23rd of April. All parliamentary constituencies of Gujarat, Goa, Kerala, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu will go to polls in the third phase. Voting in this phase will also take place for 14 seats each in Maharashtra and Karnataka, ten in Uttar Pradesh, seven in Chhattisgarh, six in Odisha, five each in Bihar and West Bengal, four in Assam, and one seat in Jammu and Kashmir. In Gujarat, the total number of nominations filed is 573. In Kerala, a total of 303 candidates filed their nominations for 20 Lok Sabha constituencies. In Assam, 62 nomination papers have been submitted for this phase for the four Lok Sabha constituencies. In Goa, 16 candidates filed their papers for two parliamentary constituencies. A total of 69 nominations were filed in Odisha for six Lok Sabha seats, while in Bihar, 114 candidates filed nomination for five parliamentary constituencies. In Karnataka, 317 candidates have filed 457 nominations for 14 constituencies.

The Indian women's Football team faces a stern test against a tricky Nepal in their Olympic Qualifiers Round 2 match in Mandalay, Myanmar on Saturday.
The two teams will be up against each other for the third time since February. In the

Hero Gold Cup, Nepal had triumphed 2-1 in Bhubaneswar, while the Indians had revenge of sorts in their 3-1 win in the SAFF Championship final.
India head coach Maymol Rocky said her side would look to score first and put the opposition under pressure.

With only one team qualifying, and both India and Myanmar level on points, a win for India will further boost their chances for a qualification from the Olympic Qualifiers Round 2.
The Indian team registered a 2-0 win over Indonesia in its opening match.

IPL 2019: Battle of leadership styles of Dhoni and Ashwin as CSK take on KXIP

Chennai, April 5
It will be a battle of leadership styles of Mahendra Singh Dhoni and Ravichandran Ashwin when Chennai Super Kings clash with Kings XI Punjab in an IPL match in Chennai on Saturday.
Dhoni's ability to stay calm and keep his cool even in the trickiest of situations versus Ashwin's aggressive approach and out-of-the-box decisions would certainly make for an interesting contest.
The two teams have three wins each and both will try to outdo each other to take the upper hand.
Defending champions CSK suffered their first defeat at the hands of Mumbai Indians in their last match after three straight wins, and they would hope to get back to winning ways as they return to



their 'den'
The two previous matches at MA Chidambaram stadium have produced contrasting performances. While Royal Challengers Bangalore were shot out for 70, Rajasthan Royals made CSK sweat before going down by eight runs on a better surface for the batters.
The spin-heavy CSK will now

be up against KXIP, which also have quality spinners in their line-up with Ashwin himself at the forefront apart from Mujeeb Ur Rahman, leggie M Ashwin and mystery bowler C V Varun.
The home team's bowlers will be wary of Chris Gayle's power-hitting provided he plays after missing the game against Delhi Capitals on April 1.

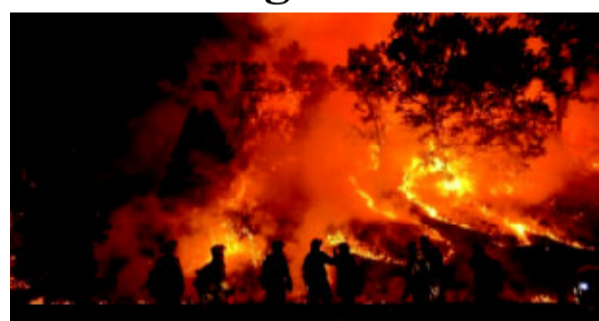
K Srikanth crashes out of Malaysia Open

South Korea declares national disaster after massive blaze engulfs 5 cities

Seoul, Apr 5
The South Korean government yesterday declared a state of national disaster over the massive blaze that engulfed five cities and counties along the northeastern coast. Thousands of residents were ordered to evacuate overnight.
According to Choi Jinho, a fire captain at Gangwon Fire Headquarters in Seoul, the fire likely started on Thursday night from a transformer spark near a resort in the town of



Goseong and spread to the nearby mountains. Affected by strong wind, the flame rapidly spread to nearby mountainous regions including the Inje county and the cities of Sokcho, Donghae and Gangneung in Gangwon province.

Hundreds of firetrucks have been mobilised from across the country, with around 10,000 personnel, including firefighters, civil servants, the military and police, gathered from across the nation for the firefighting and rescue operations.


