## Unique initiative by Health Department Free Medical Kit to be distributed to COVID-19 positive patients under home isolation

**Patients can interact with medical team at Helpline Nos. 1070/102 in case of any medical need**

Port Blair, Aug 6

The Health Department of A&N Administration and the District Health Society have taken the unique initiative of distributing a Medical kit containing the following items, free of cost to all COVID-19 positive patients who are currently under Home Isolation:

### Allopathic Medicines:

- > Tab Paracetamol/Dolo 650
- > Tab Zinc
- > Tab Azithral 500
- > Cetirizine

### Ayurvedic Medicines:

- > Tab. Samshamani Vati

### Pulse Oximeter (Returnable on discharge)

A Doctor's prescription for the intake of the above medicines is also being provided in the kit for the benefit of the patients.

Apart from the above items, all such patients under home isolation will be provided with 2 nos. of bio-degradable garbage bags for safe disposal of hazardous bio-medical waste. This would be taken back by the Department for safe disposal at the time of discharge of the patient.

A voluntary undertaking in the prescribed format of the MoHFW will be obtained from all the positive patients under home isolation to adhere to strict self-isolation at all times for the prescribed quarantine period and to monitor their as well as the health of their kin. The District Surveillance team will daily monitor their health status and wellbeing telephonically. Apart from this, the patients will also have the facility to interact with the medical team at the Helpline Nos. 1070/102, in case of any medical need/requirement.

The A & N Administration is taking all suitable steps to curb the spread of COVID-19 in the Islands. The cooperation of the general public is solicited in this endeavour, a press release from District Magistrate (SA) said.

## Measures to contain spread of COVID-19

**All persons arriving at N&M Andaman District must undergo 14 days home quarantine**

Port Blair, Aug 6

Keeping in view the increased number cases of Corona Virus being reported in South Andaman District resulting in more chances of ship passengers to be infected coming to the North & Middle District. Any person violating the above District Magistrate, North and Middle Andaman District, proceeded against in pursuance of powers vested u/s

51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under section 188 of the IPC. and other legal provisions as applicable. This shall also be applicable to all passengers who are already under quarantine after arriving on or after 29th July, 2020, the order to this effect issued by District Magistrate, N&M Andaman said.

## Administration takes elaborate & proactive steps for containment of COVID-19 in A&N Islands

### General public urged to scrupulously adhere to safety measures

Port Blair, Aug 6

The spread of the COVID-19 pandemic is a matter of serious concern requiring concerted efforts by all. The Administration of A&N Islands reiterates the importance of people's responsibility in war against COVID-19.

The Administration has made elaborate and proactive arrangements for prevention, containment and management of COVID-19. Regular COVID specific surveillance is being made on a daily basis. Adequate arrangements of beds at Hospitals, COVID Care Centres and Quarantine Centres have been made in all the Districts. The Administration has arranged adequate stocks of medical equipments and medicines required for the purpose. 228 beds have been made ready in the Hospitals in South Andaman District. Further, in the North and Middle Andaman District, 123 beds have been made ready and 26 beds have been made ready in Nicobar District, a press release issued by A&N Administration said.

The release further stated that in Port Blair, out of 316 beds ready in COVID Care Centres, 157 beds are occupied and 159 beds are vacant. Further, 470 additional beds are being added at ITI and DBRAIT in a phased manner as per requirement. Further, arrangements of beds are being made at JNRM on need basis.

As per the estimation and trends seen by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt of India, 80% COVID positive cases are asymptomatic and with mild symptoms and are to be isolated at home and may not require to be kept in COVID Care Centre. Therefore, the planned capacity is more than sufficient to accommodate moderate and severe patients who will be only 20 % of the total patients.

The most effective measures in fight against COVID-19 is the compliance of precautionary and preventive measures by the general public which are being regularly informed and are reiterated. The following must be scrupulously adhered to by the citizens:-

1. **Wear face mask in public.**
2. **Repeated washing of hands with soap (20 seconds) or alcohol based sanitizers.**
3. **Social distancing of at least 06 feet.**
4. **Maintain strict protocol of sneezing and coughing.**
5. **Isolate one self and inform nearest Health worker/ 102 helpline immediately on having ILI/SARI like symptoms.**
6. **Avoid all unnecessary travel.**

In view of the increase in infection as well as to protect patients visiting G B Pant Hospital from unnecessary exposure to COVID-19, OPD services of G B Pant Hospital for minor ailments, are being shifted to the designated Urban Health Centres w.e.f 7th August, 2020.

In addition to the OPD services at your nearest UHCs, PHCs and CHCs, one may also take the benefit of tele-medicine services being provided by the specialists of GBPH, Department of Health Services. These consultations have been restricted to minor ailments and routine follow-up:

The hospital staff will collect these prescriptions from the consulting Doctor at the closure hours of OPD i.e. 1.30 pm and obtain medicines from the pharmacy counter of the hospital and dispatch the same to the nearest UHC from where the patient can collect it between 5 pm to 8 pm.

**RBI maintains status quo in its Monetary Policy, leaves repo rate unchanged at 4%**

New Delhi, Aug 6 RBI Governor, Dr. Shaktikanta Das today said that the apex bank's monetary policy committee has decided to unanimously leave the policy repo rate unchanged at 4 per cent. He added that RBI will continue with the accommodative stance of monetary policy as long as necessary to revive growth, mitigate the impact of COVID-19, while ensuring that inflation remains within the target going forward.



In an address after the conclusion of the three day MPC meeting today via video conferencing, Dr.Das said the Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and the Bank rate remain unchanged at 4.25 per cent. He said, the reverse repo rate stands unchanged at 3.35 per cent. He said the MPC's assessment is that the global economic activity has remained fragile and in retrenchment in the first half of 2020. The MPC also observed that a renewed surge in COVID-19 infections in major economies in July has subdued some early signs of revival that had appeared in May and June. The MPC is also of the view that the global financial markets, however, have been buoyant, with the return of risk-off sentimenting a disconnect from the underlying state of the real economy. The RBI Governor said the headline CPI inflation, which was at 5.8 per cent in March 2020, was placed at 6.1 per cent in the provisional estimates for June 2020. (Source: india.gov.in)

**SAI launches Khelo India Mobile App online training program for Principals, PE Teachers**

New Delhi, Aug 6 schools have been shut and the new academic session has begun across India in form of online classes or webinars. In this current situation, Training-of-Trainers (TOTs) in their original format and physical assessments of students in schools could not be conducted till children and teachers start going back to schools again. On August 7, various School Principals or Head of Institutes will be encouraged and motivated and made aware about the need to empower their PE Teachers with knowledge, attitude and skills for undertaking the Khelo India Fitness Assessment through the Khelo India Mobile App (KIMA) besides giving them goals for 2020-21. This session is titled 'Whole School Approach to Fitness'. From August 11 to 14, Training and technical knowhow of the Assessor mobile app will be provided to the school PE teachers. They will be given sessions on the introduction to Khelo India Fitness for School Going Children and Fit India, how to undertake Khelo India battery of tests, the Khelo India Assessments protocols, Talent Identification roadmap, goals for 2020-21 and more. The training will be provided by selected Master Trainers who had conducted various National and Regional level TOTs, both offline and online, in 2019 and conducted Assessment of their schools.

**Ministry of Agriculture funding start-ups under innovation & agripreneurship component of RKVY**

New Delhi, Aug 6 (PIB) The Union Government accords very high priority to the agriculture sector. In order to contribute directly and indirectly to enhancing the income of farmers by providing opportunities to them and to provide employment to youth, start-ups are being encouraged. A component, Innovation and Agri-entrepreneurship programme has been launched under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana in order to promote innovation and agripreneurship by providing financial support and nurturing the incubation ecosystem. These start-ups are in various categories such as agro-processing, artificial intelligence, digital agriculture, farm mechanisation, waste to wealth, dairy, fisheries etc. DAC&FW has selected 5 Knowledge Partners (KPs) Centres of Excellence. In all, a total of 346 startups in the agriculture and allied sectors are being funded for a sum of Rs. 3671.75 lakhs in this phase. This fund will be released in instalments. 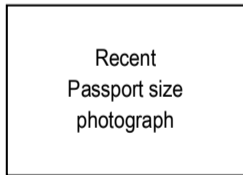
