Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has topped a global approval rating leaving behind all contemporary Heads of State and Heads of Government. According to a survey conducted among all adults, Shri Modi received a stellar approval rating of 70 per cent, while Mexico President Andrés Manuel López Obrador was second with 64 per cent and Italy Prime Minister Mario Draghi was number three with 63 per cent. German Chancellor Angela Merkel ranks 4<sup>th</sup> with 52 per cent and US President Joe Biden is at number 5 with 48 per cent. The Morning Consult, an American data intelligence firm, tracks the approval rating for governmental leaders in Australia, Brazil, Canada, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, South Korea, Spain, the United Kingdom and the United States. 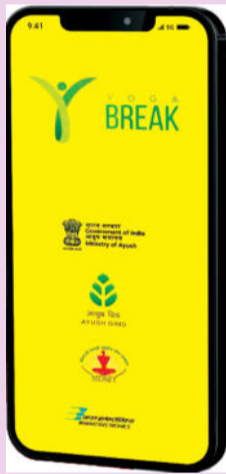
## Minister urges people to adopt 'Y-Break' at workplace to reduce stress and improve productivity

The Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) has transformed the lives and aspirations of many youth/entrepreneurs from the Islands through financial assistance under the scheme. A lot many people from the Islands have been benefitted with the implementation of the scheme by the Administration through the programme implementing agencies viz. ANIKVIB & DIC. The scheme has become the most viable option for starting self ventures and earning livelihood.

The implementation of the scheme in Isles

has witnessed the setting up of 2325 units so far, generating 5910 employment. Under the scheme, special emphasis has been given to women, Scheduled Tribes, OBC, physically handicapped and ex-servicemen. In order to simplify



the process under the scheme, the Ministry of MSME, GoI has discontinued the

system of selection of beneficiaries and recommendations of proposals/applications by the DLTC to streamline the process of selection and expedite the flow of applications under PMEGP scheme.

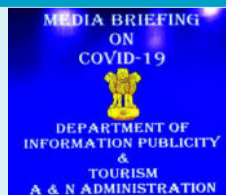

## COVID-19 management in Isles through five-fold strategy - Test, Track, Treat, COVID Appropriate Behaviour & Vaccination

**499979 samples tested so far; Rate of Test Per Million stands at 1249948**

**93.85 % of the target beneficiaries administered 1<sup>st</sup> dose of COVID vaccine**

Port Blair, Sept. 5

The Administration is strictly implementing the five-fold strategy of Testing, Tracing, and Treatment, COVID-appropriate behaviour and Vaccination for effective COVID-19 management in Isles. In order to curb the chain of transmission of the virus and to reduce the number of positive cases, various steps have been initiated. Ever since the outbreak of COVID-19, A&N Islands has augmented its testing manifold. As on date, 499979 samples have been tested in A&N Islands and the Islands' Test Per Million (TPM) presently stands at 1249948.

Apart from this, the



incoming flight passengers are also being retested with RT-PCR upon arrival at Port Blair, as double checking measure. Similarly, RAT is also being conducted on Inter-Island bound passengers travelling by ship, roadways as well as by Heli. This way, the Administration has been able to curb the

transmission of the virus and that has contributed to bringing down the number of active cases in the Islands, thus enabling relaxations in lockdown measures thereby benefiting the citizens at large in resuming their usual business with strict adherence to COVID appropriate behavior.

As per health data, the new active case in the last 24 hours is zero while the total number of active cases during the 2<sup>nd</sup> wave (since 01.03.2021) is 6 in the entire Islands. Out of the total, 7572 confirmed cases of COVID since March 2020, 7437 patients have been cured / discharged so far.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is also progressing smoothly. So far, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with 1<sup>st</sup> dose stands at 2,64,273 covering 93.85% of the target beneficiaries (2,81,603 approx.) while 1,08,435 have been vaccinated with 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

## India registers its best-ever performance with 19 medals, including five Gold and eight Silver in Tokyo Paralympics

Tokyo, Sept. 5  
In its best ever performance, India bagged 19 medals with five Gold, eight Silver and six Bronze at Tokyo Paralympics. India finished 24<sup>th</sup> in the medals tally. On the concluding day today, Indian Shuttler Krishna Nagar won the Gold Medal in the Men's Singles SH6 Category. He defeated Chu Man Kai of Hong Kong 21-17, 16-21, 21-17. Noida District Magistrate and para-badminton player Suhas L Yathiraj bagged the Silver medal. He lost to Lucas Mazur of France in the final of the men's singles event this morning. Lucas won by 15-21, 21-17, 21-15.

Palak Kohli lost the bronze-medal match in mixed doubles. Japan's

Daisuke Fujihara & Akiko Sugino defeated the Indian pair in a close fight by 21-23, 19-21 to finish on the podium at third place.

Shooter Avani Lekhara was India's flag-bearer at the closing ceremony of Tokyo Paralympics today. Lekhara has become the first Indian woman to win two medals in the same Paralympics in addition to being the first Indian woman to win Gold at the Games.

The 19-year-old has won Gold in the 10 metre air rifle and Bronze in 50 metre rifle 3 position. Indian Paralympic athletes have made the nation proud with their rich haul of medals at the Tokyo Games. India had sent 54 athletes to compete in nine sports, including Archery, Athletics, Badminton, Swimming, Weightlifting, among others.

## Over 68 crore COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in country so far

New Delhi, Sept. 5  
Over 68 crore 46 lakh COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. In the last 24 hours, more than 71 lakh 61 thousand vaccine doses were administered yesterday. Over 42 thousand new

COVID-19 cases were reported while more than 38 thousand people recovered in the last 24 hours. Three hundred eight people lost their lives during the period.  
Till now, more than three crore 21 lakh people have recovered from COVID-19. Union Health Ministry said, the COVID recovery rate in the country now stands at 97.42 per cent. The active caseload stands at over four lakh ten thousand. Over 17 lakh 47 thousand COVID tests were conducted yesterday. So far, 53 crore tests have been conducted in the country. Accordingly, from this financial year onwards, the Programme Implementing Agencies viz. ANIKVIB & DIC are forwarding applications directly to the financing banks for credit decision after preliminary scrutiny and examining the personal and factual details mentioned in the application including project report etc. The details of the simplification in the PMEGP guidelines have already been published in print & electronic media for its wider reach. In addition, the details of the probable activities which could be financed under PMEGP scheme have also been published for the knowledge of general public and aspiring entrepreneurs from the Islands.

Further, to mobilize more and more youth to become Aatmanirbhar, the Department of Industries under the guidance of Secretary (Industries) is taking various steps including disseminating information on PMEGP and ventures available under the programme at village level. All the financing banks are also being requested to identify suitable beneficiaries under different activities from their area and sponsor their names to the implementing agencies for further action in the matter. So far, 8 Awareness Campaigns and People's Education programmes on PMEGP have been organized at different Islands through which the first generation entrepreneurs were appraised about the benefits available under PMEGP scheme. The second and third phase of awareness campaign on PMEGP scheme will start with effect from 2nd and 3rd week of September, 2021 at North & Middle Andaman District and Nicobar District respectively. Apart from this, interested beneficiaries are also provided guidance for preparation of project report and online submission of loan proposals under the captioned scheme. As against the target of 96 units proposed to be financed under the PMEGP Scheme for the current financial year 2021-22, altogether 69 projects have been sponsored to different Public Sector banks till 02/09/2021. Out of these 69 sponsored cases, 40 projects have already been sanctioned by banks of which 38 projects have been financed with a total financial involvement of Rs. 226.43 lakh as total project cost along with margin money subsidy of Rs. 47.07 lakh with an anticipated employment generation of 67 persons by these units, Directorate of Industries sources informed.
