 Union Minister of Information & Broadcasting, Shri Prakash Javadekar will confer the first 'Antarrashtriya Yoga Diwas Media Samman', in New Delhi tomorrow. Acknowledging the positive role & responsibility of media in disseminating the outreach of Yoga in India and abroad, the Ministry of I&B had instituted the first Antarrashtriya Yoga Diwas Media Samman (AYDMS) in June, 2019 to mark the contribution of media in spreading the message of Yoga. The Samman to be conferred on Media Houses would be given



under the following categories: Thirty Sammans under three categories will be conferred. Eleven Sammans to be conferred under the category "Best Media Coverage of Yoga in Television. Eleven Sammans to be conferred under the category "Best Media Coverage of Yoga in Radio. The Samman will comprise of a special medal/plaque/trophy and a citation. The contribution

Paradigm shift from production & nutrition security aspects to doubling farmers' income by 2022: ICAR DG

Bengaluru, Jan. 6
 At the ongoing Science Congress in Bengaluru, ICAR, Director General Dr. Trilochan Mohapatra told audience at the Farmers Science Congress that there is a paradigm shift from production and nutrition security to doubling of farmers' income by 2022. Speaking after inaugurating Farmers Science Congress, he said that this shift in thinking was result of a call given by Prime Minister. Shri Mohapatra said ICAR has developed 56 models of integrated farming in this direction, which will be promoted with NABARD

by linking them to the Rural Development programmes. He added that these models are right now being tested on the fields. Dr. Mohapatra informed that Farmers Innovation Fund and Innovation Centres will be set up to encourage innovations made by progressive farmers. To encourage organic farming, 45 types of Organic Farming systems are developed in niche areas. In another such decision on Prime Minister's direction, the country has now witnessed a revolution in pulses production. He informed that in the last

three years pulses production has increased from five million tonnes to about nine million tonnes substituting imports worth 10,000 crore rupees. In response to another call of Prime Minister, ICAR is making efforts to reduce the use of fertilizers by introducing Microbial Consortium that promotes microbes in soil, thereby reducing use of fertilisers. In this direction Nano fertilisers and nano pesticides are also being developed. Around 120 innovative farmers from across the country are participating in Farmers Science Congress.

Delhi Assembly polls on Feb 8

New Delhi, Jan. 6
 Polling for 70-member Delhi Assembly will be held on 8th of February and counting will be undertaken on 11th of next month. The notification will be issued on 14th of January and the last date of nomination will be 21st of this month. The Election Commission announced the schedule for the Assembly elections in the city this evening. Addressing a press conference in New Delhi, the Chief Election Commissioner, Shri Sunil Arora said that the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with the declaration of elections.

Auckland, Jan. 6
Serena Williams and Caroline Wozniacki teamed up in the doubles for the first time to beat Japanese pair Nao Hibino and Makoto Ninomiya 6-2 6-4 at the Auckland Classic on Monday. Wozniacki is set to retire after the Australian Open later this month and Williams said she wanted to partner the Dane before she hung up her racket. "I had to play with her before she retires," the 38-year-old Williams said after the win saw the unseeded pair advance to

the quarter-finals, where they could face the top seeds Caroline Dolehide and Johanna Larsson. The Japanese duo struggled to deal with Williams' powerful serve in the opening stages before they got the measure of the American veteran to break her once. But Williams and Wozniacki, who looked relaxed throughout the match and even found the time to joke with each other, continued to press in the second set and wrapped up the match in 71 minutes.

Aryna Sabalenka begins Shenzhen title defence with emphatic win

Shenzhen, Jan. 6
Defending champion Aryna Sabalenka started her 2020 season in style with a 6-3 6-0 victory over Russian qualifier Margarita Gasparyan in the first round of the Shenzhen Open on Monday. The Belarusian -- who also won titles in Wuhan and Zhuhai last year -- needed only 71 minutes to wrap up the contest, breaking Gasparyan five times on centre court to advance to the last 16. "I'm happy to start my season with a two-set win," she said in her

post-match interview. "It was a tough match and really tough to start. "She's a great player and it was tough to play against her. She has strong strokes. Sabalenka will next face the Czech Republic's Kristyna Pliskova, who beat Romanian Irina-Camelia Begu 6-3 6-3. Sixth seed Garbine Muguruza fought back to beat China's Wang Xin Yu 3-6 6-3 6-0 while Aliaksandra Sasnovich advanced with a 6-2 6-3 victory over Germany's Anna-Lena Friedsam.

India's Magesh Chandran wins Hastings International chess title

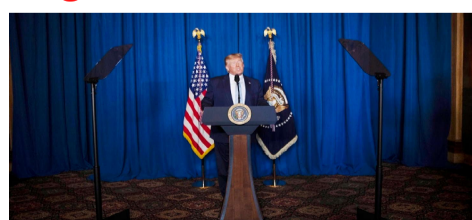
Chennai, Jan. 6
India's P Magesh Chandran remained unbeaten in nine rounds to win the title in the 95th edition of the prestigious Hastings International Chess Congress in Hastings, England. The 36-year old Grand Master with a FIDE rating of 2479, remained unbeaten and finished in clear first place with 7.5 points from nine games after securing a 33-move draw in the final round against compatriot GA Stany, also a GM on Sunday. He beat fellow Indian GM Deep Sengupta in the eighth round. Stany took the sixth place with 6.5 points while India's woman GM R Vaishali obtained six points to finish 10th. Two other Indians -- Deep Sengupta and Swayams Mishra -- finished 13th and 14th respectively with



identical six points. He was delighted with his performance and rated the win over compatriot Deep Sengupta as his best in the tournament. "It is great (to win the tournament). I haven't had such a performance in a long time," Chandran, who hails from Madurai in Tamil Nadu, said. "The game against Deep Sengupta won the best game award. I also liked the game I won against David Howell," he added.

US Prez warns Iran, Iraq of 'major retaliation' if Tehran carries out any attack against America

Washington, Jan. 6
US President Mr. Donald Trump has warned Iran of major retaliation if Tehran carries out any attack against America to avenge the killing of top military commander Qasem Soleimani and hinted at striking its cultural sites. Trump was talking to reporters on board Air Force One on his way to the White House after spending his Christmas and New Year vacation. He threatened severe sanctions against Iraq also after its parliament called on US troops to leave



the country. Mr. Trump told reporters that US have a very extraordinarily expensive air base in Iraq and it cost billions of dollars to build. He said US will not leave Iraq unless they pay back for it. Trump's statement came hours after Iran announced it will no longer abide by the limits contained in the 2015 landmark nuclear deal. Meanwhile, Trump spoke to British Prime Minister Mr. Boris Johnson. The White House said two leaders discussed the current situation in Iraq and Iran and reaffirmed the close alliance between the two countries.
