JOURNEY OF LEDs IN A&N ISLANDS

4 lakh LED bulbs distributed to domestic consumers; 35000 conventional street lights replaced with LED; 30% Govt. buildings converted to LEDs

Three villages made energy efficient; plans afoot to convert 12 more villages

Port Blair, Jan. 6

Power generation in these Islands is expensive as it is largely based on diesel resource. In this backdrop, Andaman & Nicobar Administration is fully committed to reduce the power demand in order to lessen the burden on diesel generation by introducing various energy efficiency measures on demand side. The Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), an agency of the Government of India, under the Ministry of Power has been funding to increase the energy conservation and efficient use of energy in India. A&N Administration has taken the initiative to promote efficient use of energy through nationwide schemes like UJALA (Unnat Jyoti Affordable LED for All), SLNP (Street Lighting National Programme), DSM (Demand Side



Management), ECBC (Energy Conservation Building Code) etc.

Accordingly, the Electricity Department, A&N Administration has implemented the UJALA and SNLP schemes in A&N Islands too. About 4 lakh LED Bulbs have been distributed to all the domestic consumer of these Islands @ Rs. 10/- per bulb against the replacement of conventional luminaries like incandescent bulbs/CFL. The penetration of energy efficient appliances as a measure of demand side management was effective in bringing down peak demand by 7-8%. This has not only benefited the utility by reduction in diesel consumption, but also reduced the energy charged to the consumers.

Similarly, under the SLNP (Street Lighting National Programme), 35000 conventional street lights have been replaced with LED Street Lights in

entire A&N Islands including Municipal and Panchayat areas. This has also contributed in bringing down the peak load demand in all the Islands, further effecting saving in the diesel consumption and reduction in carbon footprint. In addition to this, 1500 Nos. LED street lights have been installed as a replacement of existing conventional leftover street lights of Nicobar District.

Under the Model Energy Efficient Village Campaign, 3 villages have been made energy efficient by replacement of all conventional luminaries with energy efficient luminaries and further there is a plan to convert 12 more villages in Chowra and Teressa as energy efficient villages.

Almost 30% of the Govt. buildings have been converted from conventional luminaries to

Union Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) has been proactively carrying out the preparations for roll-out of COVID-19 vaccine, in collaboration with States/UTs and all stakeholders, over the past couple of months to ensure that the preparations for roll-out of COVID-19 vaccine are on track. Two COVID vaccines have been

given emergency use authorisation by the Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) recently. The roll out of COVID-19 vaccine is expected to begin in the near future. This milestone entails the need for testing of all planned mechanisms for conducting the vaccination drive in the country. Progress of database on COVID-19 'Vaccination Beneficiary Management System' reviewed

The meeting of the District Task Force Committee for COVID-19 vaccination was held under the chairmanship of Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman along with Superintendent of Police, South Andaman, Medical Superintendent, GBPH, Nodal Officer, COVID, District Programme Manager, NRHM, NGOs and other officials of different Departments. The



progress of database on COVID-19 'Vaccination Beneficiary Management System' (VBMS) was reviewed.

In order to implement the first phase of COVID-19 vaccination, the District Administration has made the database of Health Care Workers (HCWs) of all Govt. and Private establishments and the same has been uploaded in the CO-WIN web portal of Govt. of India for monitoring & line listing of the beneficiaries. In second phase of

COVID-19 vaccination, Front Line Workers (FLWs) will be vaccinated, for which data from the respective Department is being collected and the same will be uploaded in the portal.

The DC (SA) also reviewed the availability of Cold Chain in the District for collection and distribution of vaccine. He also stressed on Information Education & Communication (IEC) activities to be carried

On being sanctioned the amount in the month of March, 2020, Chalpat Rao was all worried on how he would repay the loan during the pandemic situation when everything came to a stop due to the lockdown. LEDs and it is targeted to complete the conversion in all the buildings by end of 2021. As a green initiative 1100 nos of LED based Solar Streetlights are under installation in various Islands.
In order to phase out the use of filament lamps and encourage the use of LEDs, a filament lamp free campaign has been initiated under which Electricity Department has notified a ban on sale/purchase of filament lamps in A&N Islands, so that such inefficient luminaries can be curbed at the source itself. The Port Management Board (PMB) also been sounded for checking their manifesto to curb the entry of incandescent lamps in these Islands. Commercial stakeholders have been sensitized to replace all the existing stock of incandescent lamps for this purpose. For effective implementation, an enforcement team has been constituted under the chairmanship of respective DCs and meetings have been conducted.
The overall agenda behind this initiative for replacement of conventional luminaries to energy efficient ones is a two pronged strategy, with the main focus on the reduction of the energy demand besides reducing the carbon footprints in these pristine Islands, a press release from Electricity Department said.

already conducted/ will be conducting the dry run in all districts on 5th January and 7th January respectively) is planned on 8th January 2021 to ensure efficient planning and management for vaccine delivery in each district of all States/UTs. Each district will identify three types of session sites, similar to the previous dry run including a public health facility (District Hospital/Medical College), private health facility and rural or urban outreach sites.
In this regard, a meeting of Hon'ble Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Dr. Harsh Vardhan with the State/UT Health Ministers is scheduled on 7th January 2021 to guide States/UTs on the conduct of dry run.
To facilitate the entire vaccination process, a software, 'Co-WIN', has been developed by the Health Ministry for real time information of vaccine stocks, their storage temperature and individualized tracking of beneficiaries for COVID-19 vaccine. This software will assist the programme managers across all levels in conduct of the vaccination sessions. A dedicated 24x7 call centre has also been established for technical queries of Co-WIN users. The cold chain infrastructure (like walk-in-freezers, walk-in-coolers, ice-lined refrigerators, deep freezers) along with sufficient supplies of syringes and other logistics have been ensured to begin COVID-19 vaccination drive.

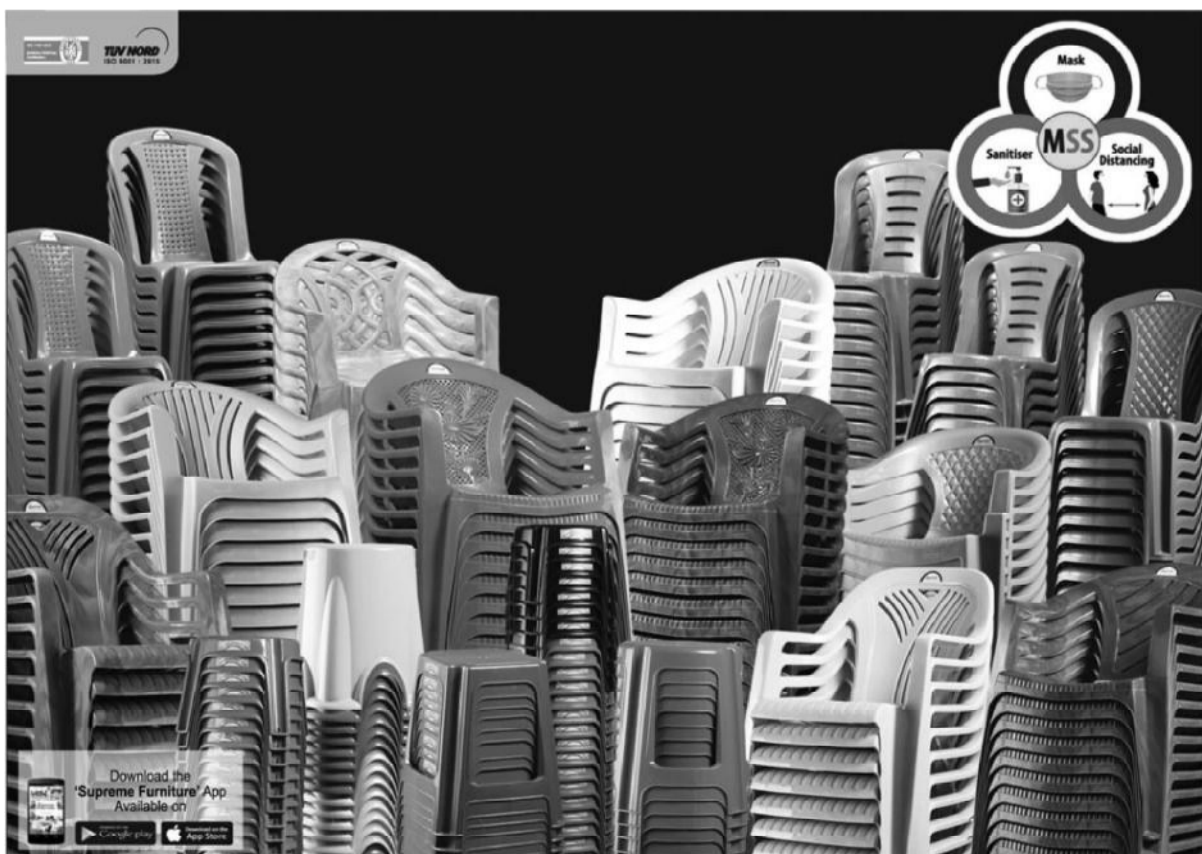
