The AYUSH System of Medicine are quite popular among the people from all walks of life in the Islands. Ever since the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, AYUSH Hospital is continuously creating awareness among the masses about the precautionary measures to be taken to prevent the disease. To boost the immunity of populace, the AYUSH hospital is continuously distributing immunity



boosting medicines through its centers in various parts of the Islands.

Presently, apart from the existing AYUSH hospital at Junglighat,

two Panchakarma Centers, 19 Homoeo Dispensaries, 13 Ayurveda dispensaries and 6 Yoga Wellness Centers co-located at

ANPCC monitoring industrial discharge & seawater quality of beaches
Conducts testing at Shaheed Dweep; pH & Dissolved Oxygen parameter found within prescribed standards

Action being initiated against one unit for non installation of STP

Port Blair, Dec. 6

The Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) has begun monitoring of industrial discharge to know the quality of effluent standards as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for various industries. A team from ANPCC visited Shaheed Dweep last month to check the discharge quality of water from hotels and to also monitor seawater quality of the beaches. The ANPCC have procured the equipments to monitor the pH (Potential of Hydrogen) and DO (Dissolved Oxygen) of the industrial discharge. Additionally, the DO &

Temperature of the sea water was collected from the beaches which are frequently visited by the tourists.

During the visit to Shaheed Dweep, the team visited 8 Industrial Units. Out of the 8 industries (Hotels), four were found closed due to lockdown and in the 3 units which are operational, the discharge quality of water coming out from the outlet of the Sewage Treatment Plant, the pH and DO parameter were found within the prescribed standards. Action is being initiated in accordance with the provisions made under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act,

1974 against one unit which has not installed STP for treatment of sewage.

The team also collected water from four beaches namely Laxmanpur beach, Laxmanpur beach-II near natural bridge, Sitapur beach and Bharatpur beach. The standard of DO were found well within the prescribed limits.

The ANPCC also monitored the water quality of 3 identified idol immersion sites namely Chatham, Sippighat and Bambooflat during Durga Puja-2020 in accordance with the revised guidelines for idol immersion issued by the Central Pollution Control

Pfizer seeks emergency use authorisation for its COVID-19 vaccine in India

New Delhi, Dec. 6 country, after its parent phase-3 clinical trials. Drug firm Zydus Pfizer, one of the world's premier biopharmaceutical companies, has sought emergency use authorisation for its COVID-19 vaccine in India. The firm, in its application submitted to the drug regulator, has sought permission to import the vaccine for sale and distribution in the country. Pfizer India has become the first pharmaceutical firm to seek from the Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) an emergency use authorisation for its COVID-19 vaccine in the country, after its parent company secured such clearance in the UK and Bahrain. The firm, in its application submitted to the drug regulator, has sought permission to import the vaccine for sale and distribution in the country. Five vaccine candidates are in advanced phases of clinical trials in the country. The Serum Institute of India is conducting a phase-3 trial of the Oxford-Astrazeneca COVID-19 vaccine. Indigenously developed vaccine by Bharat Biotech in collaboration with ICMR has already started the phase-3 clinical trials. Drug firm Zydus Cadila has received approval from the DCGI to start the phase-three clinical trials of the indigenously-developed coronavirus vaccine candidate. Dr Reddy's Laboratories and the Russian Direct Investment Fund (RDIF) have announced that they commenced adaptive phase two and three clinical trials for COVID-19 vaccine candidate Sputnik V in the country. Biological E. Ltd has also started early phase 1 and 2 human trials of its COVID-19 vaccine candidate. (Source: india.gov.in)

Maintain proximity from electric lines/poles; PBMC urges inhabitants to demolish unauthorized construction near poles

Port Blair, Dec. 6 lights provided are covering the GI Poles, outdoor fixture and RCC pole. If any untoward accident occurs on these poles, the responsibility will be solely on the inhabitants, who has done the violation of building bye-laws during construction/ unauthorized construction etc. It is therefore directed to the inhabitants to immediately remove/ demolish the unauthorized occupied/area/shed/ construction, if any and maintain proximity from electric lines as per the notified building bye-laws, a press release from PBMC said. It has been observed by PBMC that inhabitants under its jurisdiction has constructed their residential, commercial building/ shed either adjacent or touching or covering GI Pole and RCC pole provided by the Electricity Department or by PBMC in which the LED streetlight sets and service wires/LT lines has been provided. Such buildings constructed by the inhabitants are not maintaining the proximity from the electric lines which is violation as per the PBMC building bye-laws. The LED street

various DHs, CHCs, and PHCs are catering to the general public across the Islands. In addition to the regular OPD care, AYUSH units carry out a range of field activities including free Health Camps, Poshan camps, Yoga classes, awareness meetings at community level for preventive and curative health of the public. So far, the AYUSH Hospital has distributed a total of 2,61,978 immunity boosting AYUSH medicines (preventive, prothylactic against COVID-19) viz. Samshamani Vati/Giloy Churna, Chavanprash, Amla Churna, Ashwagandha Churna, Anutaila, Thaleesapathradi Chooranam and Arsenicum Album -30 etc. to people across the Islands including frontline workers i.e. Health, Police, Revenue, Sanitation Staff, quarantine people, cases of Influenza Like Illness (ILI) and general public. These immunity boosting medicines were also distributed at Airport. As per the guideline of Ministry of AYUSH, these medicines are beneficial in boosting the immunity of the people to fight COVID-19.

entirely upon its shoulders. The entire budget of Andaman & Nicobar is projected, formulated and released apart from imposing the cardinal rules derived from the General Financial Rules by the Accounts cadre. The service also provides internal finance mechanism and manpower to all Departments within the A&N Administration apart from the PRI's and autonomous bodies such as the PBMC. The entire budgeting of the Islands is shouldered by the Accounts cadre which is handling an annual budget of more than Rs.4500 crores and is also responsible for expenditure in tandem with a plethora of cardinal rules designed for financial prudence and propriety. The Pay & Accounts Office and the Sub-PAO's cater to the payment and accounting functions and are spread across the Islands from Port Blair, Rangat, Mayabunder to Diglipur and Car Nicobar, Nancowry and Campbell Bay. All the salaries, wages, personal claims, GPF and pension is handled though these Offices. The Pension Wing handles all the pension related cases and is providing a commendable service in ensuring timely finalisation of pension of the Govt. Servants retiring from the A&N Administration. During the current year, the Officers of the Cadre have taken up the mantle to implement the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) in the accounting work sphere of the Administration. With the dedicated and able team of officers, a different module of the PFMS viz. Employee Information System (EIS), DBT module, EAT module are being implemented across the Islands. The PAO, Port Blair has successfully got it implemented from 1st October, 2020 onwards. Further, the Officers of the Accounts cadre are playing vital role in bringing all the social benefit schemes, subsidies etc under DBT framework so that benefits may reach to genuine beneficiaries, a press release said here today.
