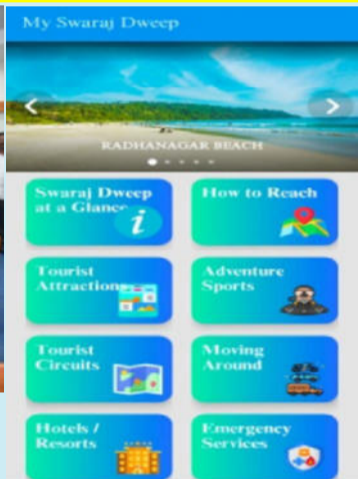

Most of the cases were examined by PHC, Dr. Irene and were briefed to Dr. Pakhe who was connected online. A review OPD of Gynaecology will be



organized after two weeks. One of the patients who availed the service said that such services are of great benefit to us and we are getting treatment from mainland doctors. Earlier, we had to go to thousands of rupees but now we can get their opinion free of cost at Campbell Bay. Dr Nitin Shakya, Assistant Commissioner / SDM Campbell Bay informed through a press release that telemedicine will be organized on regular basis and the next OPD will be for skin and child diseases. The District Administration is also planning to rotate Specialist Doctors to far flung areas so that expert opinions are provided to such patients, a press release from AC, Campbell Bay said.

N&M District Police conducts intensive jungle search to curb illicit liquor manufacturing

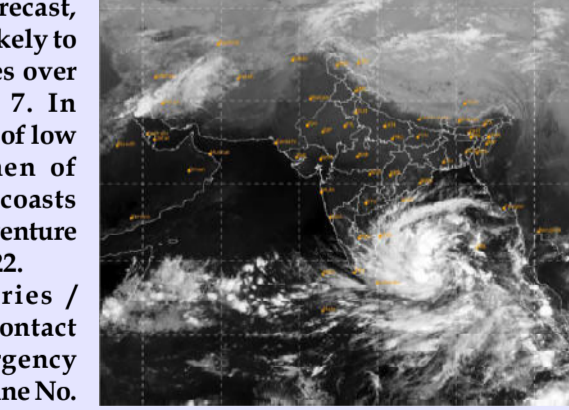
Mayabunder, Dec. 6

Squadron equipped with state of the art surveillance radar and electronic suite.

5th A&N Civil Accounts Day to be celebrated today

Port Blair, Dec. 6

The Accounts Cadre Service of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration will be celebrating the 5th A&N Civil Accounts Day tomorrow (Dec.7). The service owes its origin to a major institutional reform undertaken in public financial management during 1980 that of separation of audit from accounts.

The Pay & Accounts Organization of A & N Administration was established on 1st June, 1980 consequent to the departmentalization of accounts. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration is the Chief Accounting Authority and discharges the functions with the assistance of the Pr. Secretary (Finance), Secretary (Finance) and Director of Accounts & Budget.

The Chief Pay & Accounts Organization functions on analogous pattern of other organized accounts cadre and looks after payment and accounting functions of all Departments under the Andaman & Nicobar Administration. The Organization comprises of Chief Pay & Accounts Office, Port Blair with four PAOs functioning under it, that is two PAOs at Port Blair (PAO -I & PAO-III) then at the outstations it has Pay & Accounts Office, Rangat and Pay & Accounts Office, Car Nicobar. Apart from that, to facilitate offices situated in far flung islands five Sub PAOs are also functioning in different islands viz. Diglipur, Mayabunder, Little Andaman, Nancowry and Campbell Bay.

During last 15 years, the cadre has grown by leaps and bounds. The Accounts cadre officers now serve all major departments as well as all the Divisions of APWD, Forest & Electricity Departments. This has immensely helped in the overall improvements of both the Payment and Accounting functions of the departments as well as timely reporting of expenditure and revenue status to the Administration. The Accounts cadre shoulders the responsibility to judiciously spend the budget provided to a department by ensuing adherence to all Govt. rules and instructions.

During the financial year 2022-2023, the total budget estimates for this Administration is 5763.65 (in crores) and the payment and accounting of this huge budgetary allocation is being performed by the Pay & Accounts Organization. The core responsibilities of the organization includes payment and accounting functions, settlement of personal claims, authorization of pensions, GPF final payment, maintenance of GPF accounts of employees and remittances of NPS subscription of the subscribers to the trustee bank.

Besides this, the Principal Accounts Office submits the monthly accounts, annual accounts viz., Headwise accounts, Appropriation accounts, Finance of Andaman & Nicobar Administration to the Controller General of Accounts which is done in compliance with the Civil Accounts Manual. PFMS is being used by the PAOs for timely updation of accounting data and to control the overall budget. The monthly accounts of PAOs are being uploaded online through e-lekha and PFMS to submit the same to the CGA New Delhi.

The Auditing of various Panchayati Raj Institution, Municipal Council and other Grantee Institutions is also being done by the Local Fund Unit of this organization under the supervision of Pay & Accounts Officer. The inspection of various departments of A & N administration is also being done by this organisation.

Further, the Pay & Accounts Organisation has transformed the entire Payment, Accounting and reporting system by taking digital initiatives with implementation of various modules of PFMS such as Employee Information System (EIS), Non Tax Receipts Portal (NTRP), GPF, Pension (Bhavishya), Expenditure Advanced Transfer, DBT modules.

All the payments to the beneficiaries under all the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) schemes are being made through either DBT module of PAO or DBT module of agency.

36 UT DBT schemes have being End to End Digitized. Out of 36 UT DBT schemes, 02 schemes have been on boarded to National Scholarship Portal, 30 schemes have been on boarded to Service Plus Portal and 04 schemes on e-District Portal. All the above schemes have been also onboarded to Umang Mobile platform.

The accounts cadre of A&N Administration has felt the need to observe 7th of December as the A&N Civil Accounts Day to look back on the journey so far for the cadre and to provide a platform to the staff numbering around 170 posted at different offices across the Islands to share their views, interact with each other, to learn from each other as well as to create a sense of belonging to the organization. This platform is also for learning from the good practices adopted by the officers of the cadre in various departments and also to discuss and adapt various new changes in the govt. civil accounts sphere.

This is the day in 1992 from which the Ministry of Home Affairs has declared the Pay & Accounts Organisation of A & N Administration as organised Accounts Cadre at par with IA & AD and has extended the higher pay scale and parity with the cadre of O/o the Controller General of Accounts, New Delhi. The foundation stone for the CPAO building was also laid on the same day in the year 1983.

On this historic moment, the Staff Council and Chief Pay & Accounts Office congratulated all their staff and officers for the dedicated works rendered by them.
