Bridging the Islands: Seamless connectivity from South to North District Much awaited State of the Art Humphrey Strait Creek Bridge likely to be fully bridged by April



Port Blair, Feb. 6

Roads and bridges are the lifeline of any nation and play a vital role in the socio-economic development of far flung areas. The construction work of a State of the Art bridge over Humphrey Strait Creek by the National Highway Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (NHIDCL) in A&N Islands is progressing well. The coming up of this bridge will provide seamless connectivity on Andaman Trunk Road (NH-4)



Disclosing the status of the progress of the work, the Executive Director, NHIDCL, Shri Devendra Singh in a press release

stated that as on date about 87% work has been completed with almost two spans being bridged in a month's time. With the current progress of work, the much awaited bridge is likely to be bridged fully by the first week of April, 2021. Other ancillary activities like delaunching of launching girder, construction of crash barriers and footpaths etc. will take about a month's time, he added.

Upgrading skills of minority youth in various modern/traditional vocations

Port Blair, Feb. 6

The Ministry of Minority Affairs, GoI is implementing the Central Sector Scheme- Seekho aur Kamao (Learn & Earn) for Skill Development of Minorities. The scheme aims at upgrading the skills of the minority youth in various modern/traditional vocations depending upon their educational qualification, present economic trends and the market potential, which can earn them a suitable employment or make them suitably skilled to go for self employment. The scheme is implemented through selected expert Project implementing Agencies (PIAs). It ensures placement of minimum 75% trainees, out of which at least 50% placement is in organized sector.

#My Port Blair My Pride: Let's pledge to keep our city clean PBMC records remarkable growth in collection & transportation of segregated wastes

Port Blair, Feb. 6

In the absence of dry municipal waste processing units in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and limited scope of transportation to transfer the waste to mainland, Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) was finding it challenging to dispose of these wastes by adopting proper processing mechanism.

To overcome this challenge, PBMC has invited 'Expression of Interest' for waste collection vendors. 14 vendors expressed their willingness for



transportation of segregated waste through PBMC's designated Solid Liquid Resource Management (SLRM) Centres.

Accordingly, the waste vendors have established their machineries at established SLRM Centres. To facilitate them, PBMC has introduced new 8 tipper mounted compartmentalized autos in the solid waste system. With the introduction of this, a remarkable growth in transportation of waste has been observed showing 120MT of dry waste transported within a month's time.

Whereas, earlier this quantity of wastes were transported in one year.

Further, PBMC is constructing additional SLRM Centres at Ward levels in decentralized manner and will also introduce 16 new compartmentalized autos in the existing fleet. After implementation of this, the waste transportation will further increase to ensure that the city has a clean and hygiene environment.

Chennai Test: Joe Root becomes 1st batsman to score 200 in 100th Test; England 555/8 at stumps

Chennai, Feb. 6

England were 555 for the loss of eight wickets in their first innings against India at stumps on the second day of the first Test Cricket match at M. A. Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai on Saturday. Dom Bess with 28 and Jack Leach with six runs were at the crease when the stumps were drawn.



Earlier, the visitors resumed their first innings at the overnight score of 263 for three. England Skipper Joe Root became the first batsman in the history of Test cricket to score a double century in his 100th Test. Ben Stokes scored 82 valuable runs and helped further consolidation of the innings. Ollie Pope contributed 34 and Jos Butler added 30 runs. England's intimidating 555 was built around Root's 218. For India, Ishant Sharma, Jasprit Bumrah, Ravichandran Ashwin and Shahbaz Nadeem claimed two wickets each.

FICCI etc.who are willing to run such skill up-gradation training centres as per financial norms of the scheme with a proper plan of placements; any institution of Central/State Governments including Public Sector Undertakings and Training institutes of Central/ State Governments including Panchayati Raj Training institutions; Civil Societies (CS)/Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) which fulfill certain requirements.

For availing the benefit under the scheme, the trainee should belong to minority community, should be between 14-35 years of age, minimum qualification of trainee should be at least Class V. In case seat for reserved categories as prescribed under this scheme remain vacant, these vacant seats may be treated as unreserved.

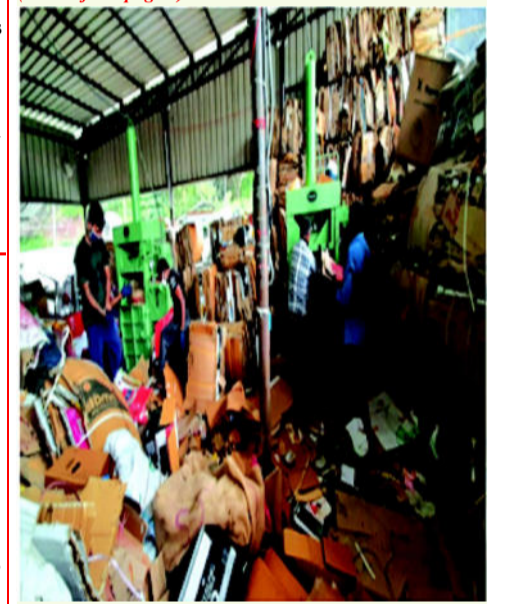


