

## Nation bids tearful adieu to Nightingale of India, Lata Mangeshkar; Mortal remains consigned to flames with full state honours

### PM pays last respects to the Legendary Singer

Mumbai, Feb. 6

Legendary singer Bharat Ratna Lata Mangeshkar, who died early today after weeks of hospitalisation, was cremated with full state honours at Mumbai's iconic Shivaji Park this evening bringing an end to a splendid and decorated career in playback singing and Bollywood. She was 92.

Just before the last rites, the National Flag in which the body was draped, was handed over to the family members. Lata Mangeshkar's brother Hridaynath Mangeshkar lit the funeral pyre of the singing legend.

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi visited the Shivaji Park to pay his last respects to the singer and met the Mangeshkar family members and consoled them.



Lata Mangeshkar passed away at the Breach Candy Hospital in Mumbai today. The veteran singer, popularly known as the Melody Queen had been admitted to hospital on 8<sup>th</sup> January after having tested positive for COVID-19. Government has announced a two-day

national mourning in memory of Bharat Ratna Lata Mangeshkar.

Expressing his condolences, President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind said in a tweet: 'Lata-ji's demise is heartbreaking for me as it is for millions the world over. A Bharat Ratna, Lata-ji's accomplishments will remain incomparable.'

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi in his tribute said that he has always received immense affection from Lata Didi and that interactions with her will remain unforgettable. In a tweet, the PM said: 'Lata Didi's songs brought out a variety of emotions. She closely witnessed the transitions of the Indian film world for decades.'

## Providing social & financial security to girl child under Dulari Scheme

28108 beneficiaries registered under the scheme upto January 2022 in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Feb. 6

Dulari Scheme was launched on Jan. 26, 2013 in A&N Islands, with the aim to reduce the gap in sex ratio to the replacement level of Net Reproduction Rate (NRR) i.e. 1 by ten years after implementation of the scheme whichever is earlier. The scheme is being implemented as a plan scheme. As per the present scheme, the girl child born on or after 26.01.2013 are eligible to get the benefit under the scheme for birth incentives and the girl children who are below 13 years of age not registered under the Planned Family Scheme (old scheme) will also get the benefit of this scheme. The objective of the

Benefits under the scheme

1. Benefits at Birth:
    - a) Hospital Delivery: Rs. 8,000/- OR
    - b) Home Delivery: Rs. 5,000/-
  2. Benefits on passing VIII Standard: Rs. 5,000/-
  3. Benefits on passing X Standard: Rs. 10,000/-
  4. Benefits on passing XII Standard: Rs. 10,000/-
  5. Benefits on getting married at the age of 21 years: Rs. 5,000/-
  6. Benefits on getting married after the age of 25 years: Rs. 10,000/-
- (The amount will be kept in fixed deposit in the name of the Child)



scheme is to reduce the gap in sex ratio to a replacement level of NRR, to encourage birth of girl child in A & N Islands, to provide social security to the newly born girl child, for her education and marriage, to adopt delayed marriage practices in respect of girl child and to encourage adoption of hospital delivery

practices. All the girl child born to either of the parents who are permanent resident of A & N Islands are eligible for availing benefit provided under Dulari scheme viz. Benefits at Birth (Hospital Delivery or Home Delivery) Rs.8,000/- & Rs.5,000/- respectively. Rs.5,000/- will be provided to the girl child on

passing VIII standard, Rs.10,000/- on passing X standard & Rs.10,000 on passing XII standard, Rs.5,000/- on getting married after the age of 21 years and Rs.10,000/- on getting married after the age of 25 years. A total of 28108 beneficiaries have been registered under 'Dulari Scheme' upto January 2022 in A&N Islands.

## COVID-19 vaccination continuing smoothly in A&N Islands

### 98.78% beneficiaries in the age group of 15-18 vaccinated so far

22,720 doses of Covaxin administered to children since Jan. 3

Port Blair, Feb. 6

COVID-19 vaccination for children between 15-18 years of age which began in these Islands from Jan. 3 is continuing smoothly. With the concerted effort taken by the A&N Administration and the Health Department, so far, 22,720 doses of Covaxin have been administered to children between 15-18 years of age out of the 23,000 approx eligible beneficiaries under this age group. To cover maximum number of eligible beneficiaries, the Health teams are administering Covaxin to the eligible beneficiaries without fail and the vaccination drive to cover children between 15-18 years of

age is still continuing in the Covid Vaccination Centres (CVCs). The percentage of eligible beneficiaries under 15-18 years of age stood at 98.78 as on Feb. 6, 2022. The children who have been inoculated with Covaxin, second dose will be repeated between 4-6 weeks after the first dose. The beneficiaries will receive the certificate online after the vaccination which needs to be downloaded from portal.

Apart from the eligible beneficiaries under 15-18 years of age, the Administration of COVID precautionary vaccine dose for Healthcare and Frontline Workers and

those over 60 years of age with co-morbidities which started from Jan 10, 2022 is continuing smoothly at different parts of the A&N Islands. As per the guidelines issued by the Central Govt., no new registration is required to get a COVID precautionary vaccine dose and the precautionary vaccine dose is the same as administered previously in the first two doses.

The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 6654 in the Islands. Those completed 270 days after second dose are eligible to receive COVID precautionary vaccine dose.

As per data available, a total of 6,05,113 beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands. The cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose so far is 304487, the percentage of which stands at 106.46. Similarly, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with second dose so far is 300626, the percentage of which stands at 98.73.

Today, a total of 57 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, a press release from DHS said.

## ICC U-19 World Cup- 2022 India lifts a record fifth title after beating England by four wickets in Antigua

Antigua, Feb. 6  
In the ICC Under-19 Cricket World Cup, India lifted a record fifth title after beating England by four wickets in the summit clash at Sir Vivian Richards Stadium in Antigua. Earlier, batting first after winning the toss, England posted 189 runs losing all wickets in 44.5 overs with the help of James Rew's 95-run knock. For India, Raj Bawa picked up a 5-wicket haul while Ravi Kumar took four.



In reply, the Yash Dhull-led Indian side overhauled the target for the loss of six wickets in 47.4 overs riding on the fifties smashed by Shaikh Rasheed and Nishant Sindhu. For England, Joshua Boyden, James Sales and Thomas Aspinwall scaped two wickets apiece. Earlier, India had won the U19 World Cup in 2000, 2008, 2012, and 2018. Meanwhile, BCCI Secretary, Shri Jay Shah on Twitter announced cash rewards for under-19 Indian team. He said, each player from the victorious Indian team will get a cash reward of 40 lakh rupees.

## India wins first ODI against West Indies by six wickets

Ahmedabad, Feb. 6  
Riding on a clinical bowling display by Yuzvendra Chahal, and some fine hitting by Rohit Sharma at the top, India defeated West Indies by six wickets in the first ODI in Ahmedabad. Rohit completed his 44<sup>th</sup> ODI fifty and added 84 runs for the opening wicket with Ishan Kishan. The Indian Captain got out on 60(51) and soon after his dismissal Virat Kohli too returned to the pavilion on 8. Ishan scored 28(36) and

Rishabh Pant was the final batter to be dismissed on 11(9). Suryakumar Yadav 34(36) and debutant Deepak Hooda 26(32) wrapped up the proceedings, completing the 177-run chase in just 28 overs. Earlier in the day, Yuzvendra Chahal returned with four wickets as Team India bundled out West Indies for 176. After being invited to bat first, Windies got off to a slow start with Mohammed Siraj removing Shai Hope early. Washington Sundar then joined the proceedings and picked two wickets. West Indies kept losing wickets in the middle overs and were reeling at 79/7 at one stage. However, smart batting by Jason Holder and Fabien Allen helped Windies reach a respectable total. Holder was dismissed on 57(71). Sundar scalped three and among the pacers Prasidh Krishna picked two wickets.

## Fees of 50% seats in Private Medical Colleges to be at par with Government College: NMC

New Delhi, Feb. 6  
The National Medical Commission, NMC has issued guidelines for determination of fees and all other charges in respect of 50 per cent of the seats in private medical institutions and deemed to be universities governed under NMC Act 2019. In an Office Memorandum the Commission said, after extensive consultations, it has been decided that the fee of the 50 per cent

seats in Private Medical Colleges and Deemed Universities should be at par with the fee in the Government Medical Colleges of that particular State and Union Territory. The NMC said, the benefit of the fee structure would be first made available to those candidates who have availed Government Quota seats, but limited to the extent of 50 per cent of total sanctioned strength of the medical college or deemed university. It said, however, if the Government Quota seats are less than 50 per cent of total sanctioned seats, the remaining candidates would avail benefit of fee equivalent to the Government Medical College fee, based purely on the merit. The order comes as a relief for students from economically backward sections who cannot pursue MBBS even after securing better scores in the eligibility tests. (Source: india.gov.in)

September 28, 1929, to a Marathi and Konkani musician Pandit Deenanath Mangeshkar. Originally named Hema, she was the eldest of five siblings, including veteran singer Asha Bhosle. Her father Pandit Deenanath Mangeshkar was a classical singer and theatre actor.

Lata Mangeshkar recorded her first playback song for a Marathi film, Kiti Hasaal, at the age of 13, and even acted in a Marathi film, Pahili Mangalagaur in the year 1942. In 1946, she recorded her first Hindi film playback song for Aap Ki Seva Mein, directed by Vasant Jogalekar.

In 1972, Lata Mangeshkar won the first National Award for Best Female Playback Singer for the film Parichay. Over the years, the veteran singer won numerous national and international awards including the prestigious Bharat Ratna, the title of Officer of the French Legion of Honour, Dadasaheb Phalke Award, three National Film Awards, four Filmfare Best Female Playback Awards, Filmfare Lifetime Achievement Award and many more. In 1984, the State Government of Madhya Pradesh instituted the Lata Mangeshkar Award, while the Government of Maharashtra also instituted a Lata Mangeshkar Award in 1992 to promote singing talent. The leadership development training scheme shall be implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs through selected organizations. The selected organizations should implement the project directly through their organizational set-up in the locality/village/area. The Central Government and UT Administration training institutes including universities and institutes of higher learning can also implement the scheme. Organizations which would be eligible for applying for financial assistance under this scheme are Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860; a public Trust registered under any law for the time being in force, a private limited non-profit company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act, 1956; Universities/ Institutions of higher learning recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), Training institutes of Central and State Government/UT Administration including Panchayati Raj Training institutes and Duly registered Cooperative Societies of Women/ Self Help Groups.

The selected organization would have the responsibility to motivate, identify and select women to be trained in accordance with the criteria of the scheme from villages/urban localities having a substantial minority population. The organizations will involve Head of the Gram Panchayat/Municipal Body/ Local Authority for identification/ selection of women trainees.

The details of the trainees should be submitted by the organization before the start of training through the Online Application Management System (OAMS) for Nai Roshni, once the project is approved. Although there will be no annual income bar, a woman/parent or guardian of woman having annual income not exceeding Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources would be given preference in selection. They should be between the age group of 18 years to 65 years.

The proposal should be submitted in the prescribed format through Online Application Management System (OAMS). The link of OAMS is available on official website of Ministry of Minority Affairs i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. After filling up the complete proposal in the OAMS, a print of the same may be taken and submitted to the District Collector/ District Magistrate for their recommendation in the prescribed format. The detailed guidelines of the scheme are available on the website www.minorityaffairs.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.
