Centre constitutes 259 member-National Committee headed by PM to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence

New Delhi, March 6

The Government has constituted a National Committee headed by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence. The committee has 259 members and includes dignitaries and eminent citizens from all walks of life. It will provide policy direction and guidelines for formulation of programs for the commemoration of 75th anniversary of Indian Independence, at the national and international levels.

The 75 years of India's Independence falls on 15th August next year and celebrations are proposed to be launched 75 weeks prior to this date on 12th March this year. 12th March is the 91st



anniversary of the historic Salt Satyagraha led by Mahatma Gandhi. The Committee will hold its first meeting on Monday to discuss modalities relating to preparatory activities. The Government intends to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence in a befitting manner at national

and international level in the form of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. A National Implementation Committee had earlier been constituted for the commemoration, to guide the policies and programs to be undertaken by various Ministries. A Committee of

First of its kind 'Maternity Home' inaugurated at CHC Bambooflat

To facilitate poor pregnant women with better health care delivery service

Port Blair, March 6

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman/Chairman, District Health Society (SA), Shri Suneel Anchipaka today inaugurated the Maternity Home at CHC Bambooflat in the presence of Shri Hari Kallikkat, SDM (SA), Dr. Omark Singh, Director of Health Services, other officials from APWD & Health Department.

Addressing the gathering, DC (SA) informed that the Maternity Home is



the first of its kind in A&N Islands and has been constructed through the District Health Society (SA) under National Health Mission to provide accommodation at minimal fee to the poor pregnant women of Inter Island for

better health care delivery services. It was also informed that this initiative has been inspired from Nicobari Birth Homes, the idea of Maternity Home incorporates Traditional Gyan with Post Modern Technologies. He also informed that

Maternity Home will be managed by the Rogi Kalayan Samiti of CHC Bambooflat in coordination with the District Administration, South Andaman to provide allotment of accommodations to the pregnant women. He also informed that the motto of this initiative is to reduce the Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR), which could improve the health indicators of A&N Islands.
