Mithakhari Ranchi Basthi murder case Accused sentenced to life imprisonment

Port Blair, April 6
 The Additional Sessions Judge, Port Blair, Shri Raju Mukherjee pronounced a verdict on April 4, 2019 convicting the accused Kartick Saha for murdering his wife Hema Kerketta, punishable under section 302 of the Indian Penal Code and voluntarily causing hurt with a sharp cutting weapon to one woman Neelawathi and another man Stephen Kujur, punishable under section 324 IPC. The

Additional Sessions Judge, Port Blair sentenced the accused to suffer imprisonment for life together with a fine of Rs. 10,000 in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for a further period of six months for the offence under section 302 IPC and to rigorous imprisonment for two years for the offence under section 324 IPC. Since the offence under section 302 IPC is visited with the

alternative punishment of death or imprisonment for life and fine, the Additional Sessions Judge gave the convict opportunity of making submissions on the quantum of sentence and kept the convict in detention for reflection of his mind till April 4, 2019. On April 4, 2019, the

General Election-2019 Third & final round training for Polling officials of Ferrargunj Tehsil held

Distribution of poll materials & EVMs for Ferrargunj & Port Blair Tehsil from Netaji Stadium on April 10

 The third & final round training for the Presiding Officers and Polling Assistants of Ferrargunj Tehsil was held in the auditorium of DBRAIT here today. Addressing the poll officials, the Returning Officer, A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency, Shri Udit Prakash Rai said today's training marks the end of the training programme for the poll officials who would be manning the Polling Stations on the day of polling on April 11, 2019. Total three rounds of trainings were organised for the poll officials of both Ferrargunj and Port Blair Tehsils during which

training on procedures for smooth conduct of polling was imparted elaborately. The RO said, EVMs will be kept in the DBRAIT auditorium as well as in the District Office South Andaman on April 7, 8 and 9 so that the officials can come and get hands on training to gain confidence to handle EVMs on the day of polling. He said polling material and EVMs will be distributed to the teams of Presiding and Polling Officers from 9 AM onwards from Netaji Stadium on April 10. All the polling teams including Presiding Officers of Ferrargunj Tehsil should reach Netaji Stadium at 9AM without fail to receive the polling

kit and EVMs. The materials will be given to the Polling parties of Port Blair Tehsil from the same venue thereafter. He directed the Presiding Officers of Ferrargunj Tehsil to intimate their respective team members to be present at the venue on the above mentioned date & time where they will be intimated about their Polling Stations, Sector Officer and Sector Police Officer. Absence of team members will be viewed as dereliction of Election Duty and action deemed fit will be taken against that official. Soon after receiving the Polling

materials, the Polling parties, sector officer, police sector officer, ECIL engineer along with police personnel will proceed to their allotted Polling Stations for which conveyance facility (Bus) has been made available from Netaji Stadium, the RO added. The EVMs meant for the Southern Group of Islands and North & Middle Andaman District have already been despatched by ship and kept in the identified/ designated Strong Rooms. The EVMs meant for Ferrargunj Tehsil & Port Blair Tehsil have also

been prepared, ballot papers have been inserted and EVMs have been sealed. The ECIL Engineers assigned duties in Southern Group of Islands and N&M Andaman District have already reached at their respective places of duty while the remaining engineers will move with the polling parties of Ferrargunj & Port Blair Tehsils on April 10, 2019. Jawaharlal Nehru Rajkeya Mahavidyalaya (JNRM) has been designated as the Collection Centre to receive polled EVMs.

Andre Russell is Kolkata Knight Riders' billion dollar man: Chris Lynn

Kolkata, April 6
Opener Chris Lynn has called Andre Russell the "billion dollar man" for Kolkata Knight Riders, overwhelmed by the Jamaican's explosive hitting in the IPL.

Needing 66 runs off 24 balls against Royal Challengers Bangalore, KKR were up against it before Russell came in and smashed an unbeaten 48 off 13 balls to complete the job with five balls to spare. His knock comprised seven sixes and one four.

"We keep putting him (Russell) in tough situations and he keeps lifting his game. He is just too good. 215 was probably par on that wicket," Lynn said after the game.



"Both teams gave opportunities. We dropped Kohli and ABD and RCB also dropped a couple of chances. We had luck on our side. Change of fortune for us. It is unbelievable and entertaining for us. He (Russell) keeps doing it. He is a billion dollar man for KKR," Lynn added. Russell's brutal hitting came after Virat Kohli (84 off 49) and

Virat Kohli-led Royal Challengers Bangalore eye fresh start against Delhi Capitals

New Delhi, April 6

In charge of a house in complete disorder, Virat Kohli will hope that Royal Challengers Bangalore play in the manner that defines his cricket, when they meet Delhi Capitals in the IPL on Sunday. RCB have suffered five straight losses in this edition, while the visitors are coming into the game with two wins and three losses.

After losing the last match against Kolkata Knight Riders on Friday, RCB's position has become precarious, and they have to win almost all their remaining games to keep their chances alive. Despite AB de Villiers and



Kohli striking form by scoring 63 and 84 respectively, the RCB bowlers failed to restrict KKR, who were powered by Andre Russell's explosive knock. The defeat left Kohli frustrated, and the batting mainstay called it "unacceptable". The Jamaican walloped 29 runs in the penultimate over, which helped the visitors pull off a sensational victory. Apart from Yuzvendra Chahal and Pawan Negi, all other RCB bowlers have not been among the wickets and conceded far too many runs, which Kohli admitted in the post-match presentation ceremony. Against KKR, they leaked 66 runs in the last four overs.

Special arrangements have been made to receive the Polled EVMs which will be kept in the designated Strong Room at JNRM. The road leading to JNRM will be closed from all corners on April 11. Vehicular traffic will be diverted



and only vehicles coming with polled EVMs will be allowed to proceed to JNRM on April 11. He requested all the polling officials to collect their EDC certificates without fail as without EDC they will not be able to vote. "It should be our collective responsibility to participate in the election and exercise our franchise", he said. The RO's Office will provide EDC to all Polling officials till April 10 who have filled 12A form so that they can vote and participate in this democratic process while on duty without any hindrance.

The RO said that the officials from both Ferrargunj and Port Blair Tehsils have participated in all the three rounds of training enthusiastically and interacted with master trainers to get their doubts clarified. The polling officials should not feel that they are alone. The entire election machinery, especially the Sector officers are with them to sort out any problem on the polling day. "I have full confidence in the entire team of polling officials that they will execute their duties with utmost responsibility and sincerity for the conduct of free, fair and transparent election in A&N Islands which goes to polls in the first phase on April 11, 2019", the RO added.

The State Level Master Trainer, Shri Mukesh Rajora briefed the participants on the use of EVMs, VVPAT and sensitized them about the procedures to be completed before the start of the actual polling. Later, the Sector Officers interacted with Presiding Officers and Polling Assistants in small groups in different classrooms of DBRAIT and enlightened the polling officials about the laid down procedures to be followed to conduct the poll on April 11, 2019. UPSC 2018 exam results announced; Kanishak tops exam

The Union Public Service Commission has declared final results of Civil Services Examination 2018. A total of 759 candidates including 577 men and 182 women have been recommended by the Commission for appointment to various Services. 36 persons with benchmark disability have also been recommended by the Commission. B. Tech Graduate from IIT Bombay, Kanishak Kataria has topped the examination. Akshat Jain got the second position while Junaid Ahmad stood third. A Chemical Engineer from RGPV,



Bhopal, Srusti Jayant Deshmukh is the topper among the female candidates securing an overall fifth rank. The Civil Services (Preliminary) Examination, 2018 was conducted on 3rd June last year. Over ten lakh sixty-five thousand candidates applied for this examination, out of which over 4 lakh 93 thousand candidates actually appeared. 10,468 candidates qualified for the Main Examination and of them, 1994 candidates qualified for the Personality Test.

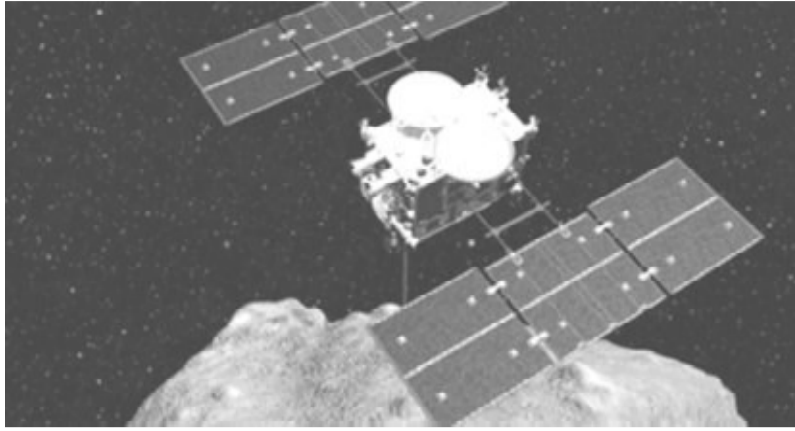

Japan space probe drops explosive on asteroid to make crater



Tokyo, April 6
Japan's space agency has said its Hayabusa2 spacecraft released an explosive onto an asteroid to make a crater on its surface and collect underground samples to find possible clues to the origin of the solar system.

The Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA), said in Tokyo that Hayabusa2 dropped

a "small carry-on impactor" made of copper onto the asteroid and safely evacuated and remained intact. JAXA is analyzing further details.

Hayabusa2 successfully touched down on a tiny flat surface on the boulder-rich asteroid in February, when the spacecraft also collected some surface dust and small debris.

Rare artefacts from Tipu Sultan's armoury auctioned

London, April 6
A collection of rare artefacts from Tipu Sultan's armoury, including one of his personal swords, has been auctioned for around 107,000 pounds. It was discovered by a couple in their attic in the English county of Berkshire.

The highlight lot, a silver-mounted 20-bore flintlock gun and bayonet from the personal armoury of the last ruler of Mysore, proved hugely popular. The collection also included a gold-encrusted sword

and suspension belt ensemble believed to be one of Tipu Sultan's personal swords. The two centrepieces formed part of a collection of eight items brought back by Major Thomas Hart of the East India Company after the Tiger of Mysore's defeat at Seringapatam in 1799. Tipu died in 1799 at the age of 48.

The auctioneers said that majority of the buyer interest had come from Indians based in India.

State of the Climate in 2018 shows accelerating climate change impacts

Geneva, April 6
The physical signs and socioeconomic impacts of climate change are accelerating as record greenhouse gas concentrations drive global temperatures towards increasingly dangerous levels. This is as per the World Meteorological Organization, WMO's statement on State of the Global Climate.

The statement highlights record sea level rise and exceptionally high land and ocean temperatures over the past four years.

The key climate change indicators are becoming more pronounced. Carbon dioxide levels, which were at 357.0 parts per million kept rising - to 405.5 parts per million in 2017. For 2018 and 2019, greenhouse gas concentrations are expected to increase further.

Above average sea surface temperatures, partly because of a

weak strength El Niño in the Pacific, is expected to lead to above-normal land temperature, particularly in tropical latitudes. The start of this year has also seen warm record daily winter temperatures in Europe, unusual cold in North America and searing heat waves in Australia. Arctic and Antarctic ice extent is well below average yet again.

WMO Secretary-General Petteri Taalas said extreme weather has continued in early 2019, most recently with Tropical Cyclone Idai, which caused devastating floods and tragic loss of life in Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Malawi. He also added that Idai's victims personify why we need the global agenda on sustainable development, climate change adaptation and disaster risk reduction.

Scientists warn of amphibian pandemic that already killed 90 species

Santiago, April 6

A deadly disease affecting amphibians has descended into a global pandemic and it has already wiped out 90 species. This was disclosed by a prominent US biologist Jonathan Kolby, at the World Organisation for Animal Health Aquatic Conference in Santiago, Chile yesterday. The disease attacks the skin of frogs, toads and other amphibians. As the creatures use their skin to breathe

and regulate their bodies' water levels, the damage caused by the disease eventually leads to heart failure and death. Over the past five years, the highly contagious disease has already caused nearly 90 species to disappear, with over 500 impacted. Amphibians play a major role in maintaining aquatic environmental quality. They also feed on mosquitoes, which carry human diseases such as malaria and the Zika virus.

Discovery of 'death switch' mechanism in plants may yield stronger crops: Scientists



Beijing, April 6

Chinese scientists have discovered a possible "death switch" mechanism in plant's immune system that triggers infected cells to self-destruct, thus limiting the spread of the disease and keeping other parts of the plant healthy. This is as per the findings published in the journal 'Science'.

Scientists said the discovery provides clues to cell death control and immunity for plants, and they hope further research can lead to a new generation of disease-resistant crops that use significantly less pesticide and are more environmentally friendly. The research was done by scientists from Tsinghua University and the Chinese Academy of Sciences' Institute of Genetics and Development Biology. About 20 years ago, scientists discovered that plants, like animals, have robust immune systems that can protect them from pathogens including viruses, fungi, bacteria and parasites. Plants also have a unique "lure and catch" immune response to deal with pathogens that have breached their cellular defence, but exactly how this

worked remained unknown. To probe this mystery, Zhou Jianmin, a researcher and his team investigated a protein called AvrAC, which is produced by a bacterial pathogen that causes black rot on cabbage. The bacterium injects AvrAC into plant cells, where it acts as a "biochemical weapon" weakening the plant's immune system.

They discovered that some plants have evolved to carry a resistance protein called ZARI that can detect bacterial proteins like AvrAC. These plants use special proteins as "bait" and trick the bacterial protein into attacking them instead.

While the bait is being attacked, ZARI is activated to form a multiprotein structure called resistosome. The resistosome itself into the cell's membrane and triggers it to destroy itself along with the invading pathogens, thus protecting other healthy cells.

In addition to discovering this defence mechanism, Zhou and his associates from the Tsinghua University created structural models of the resistosome from their research.
