digital financial infrastructure established over the past five years acting as a model worth replicating by other developing countries. A big step towards customer centricity and establishing a direct connection of the government with the people was enabled by the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY), said NITI Aayog CEO, Shri Amitabh Kant. The Yojana successfully enabled zero-cost, zero-balance bank accounts. It is equally noteworthy that of the 380 million PMJDY bank accounts opened to date, around 53% are in the names of women.

Technology has been a great enabler, especially in the Aspirational Districts of India, he said. 'Agents are using computers, mobile phones and micro-ATMs to conduct transactions.' In April 2020, close to a billion UPI and 403 million AePS transactions were recorded, he said.

Earlier on Friday, Foreign ministry officials of both nations reviewed overall scenario of bilateral relations.

Joint Secretary (East Asia) in Ministry of External Affairs, Shri Naveen Srivastava held talks with Wu Jianguo, Director General in the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs through video conference. They agreed that peaceful, stable and balanced relations between India and China will be a positive factor for stability in the current global situation.

feed during rainy season is a common problem. Do not store the feed for longer time. The feed in the house should be placed on the platform above the ground to prevent the feed from regaining moisture and mildew. As a precautionary measure the farmers should avoid transport of feed during rain and feed must be stored in clean and dry place.

In rainy season, the birds are likely to be chilled and therefore there is urgent need to keep vigil at night and make sure the heating element is a light and radiating enough heat to keep the chicks warm and comfortable. Consider adding energy rich sources like oil/fat to the diet or level of other nutrients may be reduced keeping the energy at same level. In free-range system, provide supplementary feeding to the birds to meet their nutrient deficit.

Consider confining the chicks during the first eight weeks of age. Feed approximately 2 kg each of balanced feed and thereafter keep under semi-scavenging conditions. At eight weeks of age, the chicks are less susceptible to attacks by predators and more resistant to disease, due to their larger body weight and more effective vaccination immunization.

In deep litter system, removal of wet litter, breaking of caked litter, and periodic addition of fresh litter should be done on regular basis. With the rain, birds may encounter standing water (mostly in free-range) and end-up drinking from the ground leading to parasitic infestation from intestinal worms. Administer de-wormers before laying starts.

Above measures shall help the farmers to keep the chicken flocks as comfortable as possible and to reap the maximum out of chickens in terms of production, growth and survival.

Common Yoga Protocol of International Day of Yoga: Day 3

PĀDA-HASTĀSANA (The Hands to Feet Posture)

Pāda means feet, *hasta* means hands. Therefore, *Pāda Hastāsana* means keeping the palms down towards the feet. This is also referred as *Uttānāsana*.

Technique

- ♦ Stand straight with feet 2 inches apart.
- ♦ Inhale slowly and raise the arms up.
- ♦ Stretch up the body from the waist.
- ♦ Exhale and bend forward until both palms rest on the ground.
- ♦ Stretch the back, to make it straight as much as possible.
- ♦ Maintain this final posture for 10-30 seconds with normal breathing.
- ♦ Those who are suffering with stiff back should bend according to their capacity.
- ♦ Now inhale, come up slowly to the upright position and stretch the arms straight above the head.
- ♦ Exhale, slowly return to the starting position in the reverse order.
- ♦ Relax in *Samasthiti*.

Benefits

- ♦ Makes the spine flexible, improves digestion, and helps in overcoming menstrual problems.

- ♦ Please avoid this practice in case of cardiac disorders, vertebral and disc disorders, abdominal inflammation, hernia and ulcers, glaucoma, myopia, vertigo.
