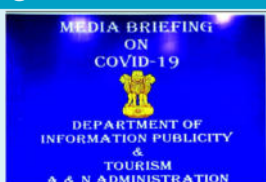

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration Shri Jitendra Narian inspected the roads in Diglipur during his visit to N&M Andaman District recently. He directed the APWD, DCs to prepare a detailed report on the status and condition of roads constructed by NHIDCL and also wrote about the pathetic state of roads in Andamans to CMD, NHIDCL. Consequent to this, the Executive Director, NHIDCL, Col. Devendra Singh (Retd.) has been asked to resign by his organization and new Executive Director, Col. Hemant Bhardwaj



will take over shortly. The Chief Secretary stated that strong action will be taken against all Departments and PSUs, who neglect to do their work properly and timely, as he always says 'delay is criminal'.

A report submitted by SE (CC-I), APWD in

this regard states that the condition of the roads in N&M Andaman is very bad and the work executed by NHIDCL is not satisfactory. There may be lack of adhering to the specification and the delay in work ranges from 10-19



months. Similarly, in South Andaman District too, depression and cracks have been noticed in many stretches.

Meanwhile, APWD & Deputy Commissioners of South Andaman & N&M Andaman

Districts have been directed to ensure that the roads are in good condition and it should become better and last long. Further, some enquires are also being shortly launched against the construction of road and its maintenance.

Food Safety Deptt. officials inspect food business premises to check quality of cooking oil

TPM formed on repeated frying found within prescribed limit

Port Blair, Aug. 6

An MoU 2021-22 was signed between the Apex Food Regulator, FSSAI, New Delhi and Commissioner Food Safety, A&N Islands to strengthen Food Safety Eco System in the Union Territory islands which includes various initiatives like collection of regulatory samples, Eat Right Campus, Eat Right School, RUCO (Reused cooking Oil), BHOG (Blissful Hygienic Offering to God), Save Food Share Food, Clean Street Food Hub, Hygiene Rating and third party audit of Food Premises, Clean and



Fresh Food Vegetable Market, Food Fortification etc.

As per the initiative under RUCO, the officials of Food Safety Department inspected Hotels, Dhabas, fast food eateries and other food business premises in and around Port Blair Municipal area to check the quality of cooking oil.

The oil used for cooking and frying were monitored with fry oil monitor. The Total Polar Compounds (TPM) formed on repeated frying, were found within limit prescribed by FSSAI. The Food Business Operators were sensitized regarding the ill effects of repeated use of cooking oils and the legal implications under FSSAI Act, Rules & Regulations against the violators.

Similarly, fish markets of the city were also inspected. The officials with the help of formalin

Promoting self-employment through NRLM scheme

How backyard poultry empowers rural women- a success story

Port Blair, Aug. 6

National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) scheme is focused on promoting self-employment and organization of rural poor. The basic idea behind this program is to organize the poor into SHG (Self Help Groups) and make them capable of self-employment. Backyard poultry farming is increasingly offering remote rural families both food and financial support. And as take-up for these products grows, its effects on marginalised groups, especially women, could prove beneficial. Rural India is increasingly becoming a place where people are exploring the possibilities of rearing poultry. Poultry has become a tool for rural women to overcome poverty.

One such example is of Vartika producer group comprising of about 20 SHG's. This group was formed in December. They sell country chicken birds and eggs at the Beodnabad Panchayat. Every Sunday market is organised at the Beodnabad Panchayat Building hall where the SHG women showcase various handmade products. Moreover, Vartika Producers also operates from the same Panchayat Building and for procurement of Birds and eggs the Group members can be contacted every Sunday from 9 am to 12 pm. Backyard poultry farming primarily involves country chicken birds. They are selling today's popular breeds which include several varieties such as Vanaraja, Kadaknath, Country chicken bird, Common Quail,

Duck. One of the primary objectives of popularising backyard poultry farming in rural areas is to provide better income opportunities to the poor farmers and people from indigenous communities living in remote areas. Among its benefits is that it can help make rural women economically and socially empowered and can address the issues of food insecurity and malnutrition.

In such a scenario, the scope for backyard poultry is enormous and would be expanded through NRLM scheme especially in rural areas, a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

Supply Chain in the Post Covid Global World. Considering the size of our economy and potential, our manufacturing and service industry base, there is tremendous potential for export growth. He added that when the country is moving towards the mission of Atmanirbhar Bharat, one of its goals is to increase India's share in exports manifold. He said that to achieve this we have to make sure that we get access to the global supply chain, so that our business can scale and grow. He added that our industry will also have to move towards the best technology, focus on innovation and increase share in R&D. He said our share in the Global Value Chain will grow only by following this path. While encouraging competition and excellence, we have to prepare global champions in every sector, he stressed.

The Prime Minister listed four factors that are very important for increasing exports. Manufacturing in the country has increased manifold and that has to be qualitatively competitive. Second, the problems of transport, logistics should be removed for that centre, states and private stakeholders will have to work continuously. Third, The Government should walk shoulder to shoulder with the exporters and, finally, the international market for Indian products needs to be expanded. He said only when these four factors are synergized, India will be able to achieve the goal of Make in India for the world in a better way.

3,01,903 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far in Isles

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 3,01,903 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far in Isles, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 882 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. A total of 97,107 eligible people in the age group

of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date. 850 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 648 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 21 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District. In Nicobar District, 11 beneficiaries were vaccinated out of which, 7 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

The Nodal Officer, (COVID-19) informed that the registration slot for 18+ category for COVID-19 vaccination will be open from 9.30 am onwards tomorrow. Vaccination doses will be administered to the eligible beneficiaries at JNRM and also at PHCs Garacharama & Ferrargunj & CHC Bambooflat from August 9, a press release from DHS said.

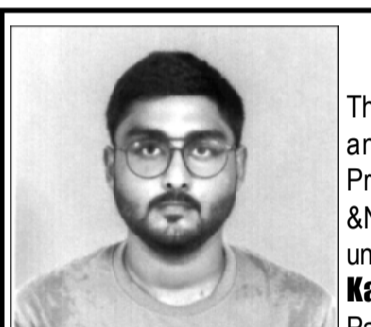

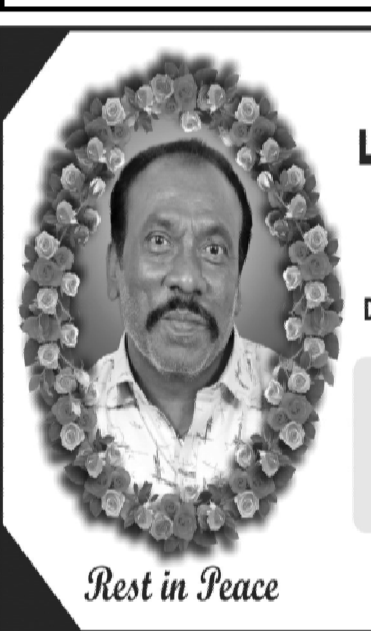
