Vice President calls for promoting joint family system in country

New Delhi, Oct 1 Vice President Shri Venkaiah Naidu has called for promoting the age-old tradition of joint family system in the country saying this would ensure the share and care of elderly people in the society. He also suggested the renaming of the old-age homes as homes for 'varishta jan'.

He was speaking at a function in New Delhi today to mark the International Day of Older Persons. The Vice President presented the 'Vayoshresta Samman' awards to several eminent senior citizens, including the noted Cardiologist Dr. P Venugopal. Shri Naidu said the recognition of their



outstanding achievements in the form of the national awards would motivate them to continue their good efforts. It would also be an encouragement to others to emulate their example. Shri Naidu underlined the need for conducting an official survey to find the population of elderly

people and making use of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's 'Ayushman Bharat' health scheme. He said the government has launched several welfare schemes for providing comprehensive healthcare and economic independence to the senior citizens.

Shri Naidu said India had an elderly population of 10.38 crore according to 2011 Census and this constituted about 8.6 per cent of the total population. Presiding over the function, attended by hundreds of elderly people, Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot gave an account of welfare programmes undertaken by his Ministry for the elderly people. This includes the 'Vayoshree Yojana', providing wheel chairs and eye-sight glasses among other things.

Cricket: India to play 2 Tests, 5 ODIs and 3 T20s against West Indies

New Delhi, Oct 1
Ahead of the tour to Australia in November, India will host West Indies for 2 Tests, 5 ODIs and 3 T20s starting October 4, 2018. The series will start just a week after the completion of the Asia Cup. The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) announced the schedule for the home series against West Indies on Tuesday.

home series against West Indies set to be played from October 4 to November 11, 2018. India will play 2 Tests, 5 ODIs & 3 T20s during this tenure," BCCI secretary Amitabh Choudhary said in a release. The series will begin with a Test starting October 4 to 8 in Rajkot, which will be followed by the second Test starting October 12 in Hyderabad. The 5-match ODI series will begin from October 21 and will continue till November 1. The 3 T20s will be played on November 4, November 6 and November 11.

After Asia Cup success, Rohit Sharma, Shikhar Dhawan rise in ICC ODI Rankings

Dubai, Oct. 1
After Asia Cup success, Indian opening pair Rohit Sharma and Shikhar Dhawan made significant gains in the latest ICC ODI rankings released on Sunday. Sharma, who led India to the 7th Asia Cup title, in the absence of Virat Kohli, jumped up two spots to reach his career-best 2nd position. With the rise, the top two slots are now both filled by Indian batsmen, with Kohli still filling up the top spot. It is for the second time that Sharma, who scored 317 runs in 5 innings at an average of 105.67 in the Asia Cup, has reached the 2nd place as he did so back in July this year. Dhawan, who was awarded the man-of-the-tournament award in the tournament with 342 runs in 5 innings at an average of 68.40, jumped up four slots to reach the fifth position in the ICC Rankings. Apart from the two batsmen, India's chinaman Kuldeep Yadav also saw an increase in ODI Bowling Rankings. The left-arm spinner jumped up

three spots, to reach his career-best third position, as he finished the tournament as the joint-highest wicket-taker along with Bangladesh seamer Mustafizur Rahman and Afghanistan's leggie Rashid Khan with 10 wickets each. With Pakistan failing to make it into the final, batsman Babar

Azam faced a slump in the Rankings as he dropped by four spots to reach the 6th position in the ICC ODI Batsmen Rankings. India defeated Bangladesh in the final by three wickets on the last ball to clinch their record 7th Asia Cup trophy on Friday.


