Act; any private recognized/registered professional institution of repute conducting such skill development courses for at least last three years with established market linkages and placement record and fulfilling any other criteria laid down by the Ministry; any industry or an association of industries like ASSOCHAM, CII, FICCI etc. who are willing to run such skill up-gradation training centres as per financial norms of the scheme with a proper plan of placements; any institution of Central/State Governments including Public Sector Undertakings and Training institutes of Central/ State Governments including Panchayati Raj Training institutions; Civil Societies (CS)/Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) which fulfill certain requirements.

For availing the benefit under the scheme, the trainee should belong to minority community, should be between 14-35 years of age, minimum qualification of trainee should be at least Class V. In case seat for reserved categories as prescribed under this scheme remain vacant, these vacant seats may be treated as unreserved.

On behalf of the District Administration, AC (UT) appreciated Smti. Nazreen and appealed the general public to follow this effective model.

The Assistant Commissioner further informed that efforts are being made so that all buildings in the District should have rooftop RWHS and that maximum quantity of rain water falling in any compound should be impounded within the compound itself. The basic objective is to make sure that 'No or only limited water should flow out or the compound'. This will help in improving soil moisture and raising ground water table. The campaign targets to deliver check dams, water harvesting pits, rooftop RWHS etc; and de-silting of tanks/



ponds to increase their storage capacity; removal of obstructions in the channels which bring water from the catchment areas etc.; repairs to step-wells and using defunct bore-wells and unused wells to put water back to aquifers etc. are to be taken up with the active participation of public at large.

The speakers motivated the residents regarding the importance of cost efficient RWHS and the same is the top priority of the Administration which would augment the water conservation/preservation measures.

**Formation of low pressure over Andaman Sea; fishermen advised not to venture into sea**

Port Blair, Oct 7

A low pressure area is very likely to form over north Andaman Sea & adjoining East Central Bay of Bengal on 9 October, 2020. It is very likely to concentrate into a Depression over central Bay of Bengal during subsequent 24 hours. It is very likely to move Westnorth Westwards and cross north Andhra Pradesh & adjoining South Odisha Coast as a depression around 11 October afternoon/evening.

Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy to very heavy rainfall at isolated places would occur over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on Oct. 9 (7-20 cm) and heavy rainfall on October 10 (7-11 cm) & 11(7-11 cm), 2020.

Squally winds (speed reaching 45-55 kmph) would occur over

Central Bay of Bengal & North Andaman Sea from October 9 to 11, 2020. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 Kmph would occur over west central & adjoining north Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh & Odisha coast commencing from 10 October night for subsequent 36 hours.

Sea condition will be rough to very rough over north Andaman Sea, East Central & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal on 9 & 10; Westcentral Bay of Bengal on 10 & 11; adjoining North Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh & Odisha coast on 11 October, 2020.
