## Media briefing on COVID-19 held Strictly adhere to COVID Appropriate Behaviour and help Administration in its fight against corona virus: Secretary (IP&T) Outlines steps taken by Administration to contain spread of the virus in the Islands

Port Blair, Jan. 7  
The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Pankaj Kumar briefing the media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that corona cases are increasing in the Islands and to contain the spread of the virus in Isles, the Administration has taken several steps. He appealed to the people to take this pandemic seriously and cooperate with the Administration in fighting the virus and its variant Omicron by strictly adhering to COVID Appropriate Behaviour viz. wearing of face mask, maintaining 'Do Gaj Ki Doorri' and hand sanitization. This, he said, will immensely help in flattening the COVID curve and make things easier and safer for each one of us. He also urged the people to minimize arriving at VSI Airport, particularly to mandatorily carry RT-PCR negative test. Further, all passengers with history of foreign travel in the last 30 days, all unvaccinated and partially vaccinated passengers shall also be tested by RT-PCR on arrival at VSI Airport, Port Blair and they have to strictly self isolate themselves till the receipt of negative RT-PCR report. The District Administration is reaching out to general public in wake of the sudden surge of COVID-19 wave in all possible ways. Control Rooms with 1077 toll free number have been strengthened by the District Administration and the COVID cases are being monitored on regular basis by the Deputy Commissioner (SA) and the team. Screening of all incoming passengers in the Veer Savarkar International Airport is being carried out scrupulously and all passengers are immediately put on surveillance and any positive case found in the sample collected are quarantined immediately by the District team. Four District Level Control Rooms have been established in the District Office for resolving grievances related to COVID for the public and also aims at redressing various other issues arising out of the present situation. Two control rooms are functioning in the District Conference Hall in which Doctors are monitoring the health conditions of ILI/SARI/suspect cases through telephonic surveillance. Quarantine and other mechanisms are also put in place for managing COVID-19. A dedicated Control Room at Zilla Parishad Conference Hall has been setup

## SC cleared decks for medical counselling, admissions including OBC & EWS reservations for current academic year 2021-22

New Delhi, Jan. 7  
The Supreme Court today cleared the decks for postgraduate medical counselling and admissions, including the Other Backward Classes (OBC) and Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) reservations for the current academic year, 2021-22.

A bench headed by Justice D.Y. Chandrachud and A.S. Bopanna upheld the constitutional validity of 27 percent

reservation for OBC and 10 per cent EWS for the NEET-UG and NEET PG. However, the top court added that it would decide on the rationale of criteria of Rs 8 lakh income for EWS category in March this year. Petitioners in the matter had challenged the 29<sup>th</sup> July notification of the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) providing 27 percent reservation for OBCs and 10 percent for the EWS category in the NEET-UG and PG (All India Quota). same. While vessels are in drydock, periodic monitoring system were evolved by which the progress of repairs were monitored to ensure the vessels complete the repair works within the allotted period of drydock and undock as per schedule.

With the above initiation by the Directorate of Shipping Services, around 87 vessels were provided drydocking facilities during the Calendar Year 2021. Though due to the pandemic situations, proper precautionary measures by following COVID protocol and meticulous planning the Directorate by addressing various constrains has been able to achieve the desired result. While streamlining the drydock allotment and its optimum utilization, the Directorate has also considered allotment to private passenger vessel which are operated in Tourism sector and cargo vessel which are essentially operated to transport cargo including essential commodities to various Islands particularly Southern Group of Islands. This consideration is to enhance the capacity to handle more tourists and to maintain supply chain of essential and non - essential, petroleum products, LPG etc.

The Directorate is further making efforts to address other factors if any towards minimizing the stay of vessels in the drydock which will pave way to reduce waiting period of the vessels for drydock so that more vessels are available for service, a press release from DSS said.

## 3007 Omicron cases reported so far; Over one lakh 17 thousand new COVID cases reported in country in last 24 hrs

Union Government has said that a total of three thousand seven cases of Omicron variant of COVID-19 have been reported so far in the country. Out of these thousand 199 patients have already recovered and

migrated.

Maximum number of 876 cases have been reported from Maharashtra followed by Delhi wherein 465 cases have been reported so far. Omicron cases have been reported in 27 States and Union Territories.

more than 94 lakh 47 thousand COVID vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours to the beneficiaries.

Thirty thousand 836 COVID patients have recovered during the last 24 hours and the national recovery rate stands at 97.57 percent.

## COVID-19 status in A&N Islands Twenty positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Jan. 7

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 343 passengers who arrived here yesterday, 20 positive cases have been detected. Today, 14 flights with 1968 passengers arrived, out of which, RT-PCR test was conducted on 446 passengers (includes 17 foreign travellers) and the reports are

awaited. About 41 positive cases were found during the test conducted yesterday and few needs repeat test.

During RAT conducted on 83 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was

conducted on 45 passengers and all were found negative.

At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 105 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. At Helipad, 12 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.
