## Govt. allocates Rs. 16000 crore for Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) for 2021-22

New Delhi, Feb. 7 (PIB) To boost the safety of farmers' crops and ensure maximum benefit of crop insurance reaches to farmers, the Government of India has allocated Rs 16000 crores for Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) for the fiscal year 2021-22. This is a budgetary increase of around Rs 305 crore as against the previous fiscal year 2020-21,

which reiterates the Government's commitment towards growth of agriculture sector in the country. The scheme extends coverage for the entire cropping cycle from pre-

sowing to post-harvest including coverage for losses arising out of prevented sowing and mid-season adversities. 5 years ago, on 13th January 2016, the Government of India approved this flagship crop insurance scheme. The scheme was conceived as a milestone initiative to provide a comprehensive risk solution at the lowest uniform premium across the country for farmers.

Today, PMFBY is globally the largest crop insurance scheme in terms of farmer participation and 3rd

During the visit, the Chief Secretary also held a meeting and directed all the concerned Officers to speed up the various works and ensure its timely completion. He reviewed the status of ongoing projects in Swaraj Dweep. The Chief Secretary also visited Radhanagar Beach, Kalapathar, PHC, Swaraj Dweep and other places.

# Rutland water supply project progressing well Laying of submarine pipeline from Rutland to Phongi Balu to commence shortly; targeted to be completed by May, 2021 Once commissioned 6.70 MLD of fresh water will be available for Port Blair town

Port Blair, Feb. 7

The Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) has taken up the work of transportation of water from Rutland to Phongi Balu to mitigate the scarcity of water availability of Port Blair town during peak summer months from February to May every year. The work consists of three phases viz. Phase-I: construction of CC weirs and raising of two nos. existing weirs including laying of HDPE pipeline from Badakhari to R.M Point at Rutland, Phase-II: Laying of Submarine pipeline from Rutland to Phongi Balu across McPherson Strait and Phase-III: Laying of DI pipeline from Phongi Balu to Dhanikhari Dam including construction of sump and pump house at Phongi Balu. The Phase-I and Phase-III



part of the project have already been completed.

The tender for phase-II part of submarine pipeline from Rutland to Phongi Balu has been awarded to a firm M/s



Gypsum Structural India Pvt. Ltd, New Delhi and the work has started in June 2020. The work includes laying of Sub-Marine pipelines with API 5L Grade X52 carbon steel, High Frequency

Welded, 3 Layer Poly Ethylene 323.9 mm OD coated line pipe covering a length of 1.70 km which will be laid by HDD method.

At present, the project is progressing well as per the targeted schedule. The total length of pipe line has already been mobilized to construction site and the laying of pipe lines will commence shortly and is targeted to be completed by May, 2021. Once the project is commissioned, 6.70 MLD of fresh water will be made available daily from Rutland to Port Blair which in turn will enhance the availability of water for Port Blair town in peak summer months, a press release from APWD said.

(EPFO) to recruit unemployed persons including re-employment of those who were rendered unemployed during the pandemic.

Under the ABRY, both the employees' share (12% of wages) and employer's share (12% of wages) of contribution depending on the employment strength of the establishment will be paid by the Central Government in the

The Kisan Credit Card Scheme aims at providing adequate and timely credit support from the banking system under a single window with flexible and simplified procedure to the farmers for their cultivation and other needs such as meeting short term credit requirements for cultivation of crops, post harvest expenses, produce marketing loan, consumption requirement of farmer household, working capital for maintenance of farm assets and

activities allied to agriculture, investment credit requirement for agriculture & allied activities as per the provision of the scheme.

The Govt. of India has taken special effort under Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan for the improvement of Agriculture which includes 100% saturation of PM-KISAN beneficiaries with KCC. The scheme is also now being extended to farmers exclusively dealing with Animal Husbandry and

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed for inclusion of all eligible households with PwDs/disabled persons under NFSA by conversion of their existing APL ration card to PHH ration card. To attain 100% coverage of all PwDs fulfilling the criteria for inclusion under NFSA, 2013, such eligible ration card holders have been directed to approach their respective Civil Supplies Units positively by 1st March, 2021 for further course of action. In this regard, the Department of Civil Supplies has issued a press note for sensitizing the eligible households which resulted in coverage of many household with PwDs under NFSA.

**India is now 3rd Topmost Country with Highest Doses of COVID-19 Vaccine administered**

New Delhi, Feb. 7 (PIB) India has scaled another global peak in its fight against COVID-19. India has become the third topmost country in the world in terms of the number of COVID-19 vaccine doses administered. Only the United States and the United Kingdom remain ahead of India. As on 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2021, till 8 am, total of 57.75 lakh (57,75,322) beneficiaries have received the COVID-19 vaccine under the countrywide COVID-19 vaccination exercise. The cumulative vaccination coverage includes 53,04,546 healthcare workers and 4,70,776 frontline workers. In the last 24 hours, 3,58,473 beneficiaries were vaccinated across 8,875 sessions. 1,15,178 sessions have been conducted so far. 17 States/UTs have not reported any deaths in the last 24 hours. These are Haryana, Goa, J&K (UT), Jharkhand, Puducherry, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Lakshadweep, Assam, Manipur, Sikkim, A&N Islands, Ladakh (UT), Mizoram, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura and D&D & D&N.
