ANCO Fest concludes at DBRAIT Youth can play a significant role in nation building: Lt. Governor

The Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Vice Chairman of Islands Development Agency, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) has called upon the youth to take up the task of national building and take the country to its rightful place. He was addressing the valediction of the ANCO Youth Festival-2019 at DBRAIT auditorium here today. The Adhyaksh, Zilla Parishad South Andaman, Shri Sanjib Kr. Mandal, Secretary (Edn.), Shri D Manikandan and senior officers of the Administration were present on the occasion.

The Lt. Governor said that India has the second largest population in the world, with 65% of its population are in the youthful age of below 35 years. This section of young population can play a significant role towards the development of the country and put it in its right place, he said.

The Lt. Governor complimented the officials, faculty and students of DBRAIT for having the Green Building and for the successful conduct of the Festival. He suggested for expanding the scope of activities in the Festival by including intellectual components, which will benefit the students to a great extent.

Interacting with the students of different colleges of the Islands, the Lt. Governor responded to the queries raised by them. On environment conservation, the Lt. Governor informed that all projects that are carried out in the Islands are being processed in conformity with the environment conservation. Steps are being taken to strike



the balance between conservation and development, he said.

On the employment opportunity to the local youth, the Lt. Governor mentioned that apart from tourism and hospitality, there are no other industries that can provide employment in the Islands. However, it is expected that once the network

connectivity is improved after the work for laying the undersea cable is completed, it will boost IT enable industries, which will generate employment to the youth of the Islands, he said.

On the strategic location of the Islands, the Lt. Governor said that every citizen, especially the youth

Expert Appraisal Committee recommends clearance of CRZ for proposed eco-tourism projects

Expert Appraisal Committee of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India while considering the proposals for development of Eco-tourism projects at Long Island and Smith Island (Andaman & Nicobar Islands) has recommended clearance from the angle of Coastal Regulation Zone in its meeting held on Feb.18, 2019 at New Delhi, subject to certain conditions to be complied by the developer/stakeholder. The above said Expert Appraisal Committee has also given positive observations for CRZ clearance to proposed eco-tourism projects of Aves Island with indicative conditions and specific remark if Integrated Islands Management Plan (IIMP) is amended in future to 20 mtrs.

The above mentioned recommendations/observations related to CRZ clearance paves the way for development of Eco tourism premium resorts in the A&N Islands. It is relevant to mention that A&N Administration has already extended the date for participating in Request For Qualification (RFQ) till 11th March 2019. These projects are expected to be developed as role model for tourism industry, where environmental jurisprudence is implemented in letter and spirit.

The vision is to leverage the potential of the Islands and to position them at par with international tourism and trade destinations. Holistic development of the Islands will develop the local economy, provide employment and infrastructure service to the local population for New Andamans, a communication from the MD, ANIIDCO said.

India vs Australia 3rd ODI preview: India eye series win in what could be Dhoni's last match at Ranchi

Ranchi, Mar 7
Mahendra Singh Dhoni's final homecoming forms a poignant subplot of an utterly dominant Indian team's quest for an unassailable 3-0 lead in the third ODI against Australia here Friday. A 3-0 lead in the five-match series will be a perfect parting gift for Ranchi's favourite son, who, in all likelihood, will be seen wearing the India Blues for the last time at his home ground. There has been a sense of déjà vu every time Dhoni has stepped on to the field in the ongoing series. It reminded many of Tendulkar's penultimate Test series against Australia in 2013, when the cheer from the stands would amplify with each passing match. Shankar's two wickets while bowling the final over will also instil confidence in his captain that in case Hardik Pandya has a breakdown, he has a fallback option in the Tamil Nadu all-rounder. However, he is still not somebody who can bowl six to seven overs consistently in each game.



Mohammed Shami and Jasprit Bumrah have been outstanding in the two games so far. If Shami was lethal during the opening spell of the first game, Bumrah set it up with another incredible effort at the death in the second.

Two-time Indian Wells champion Victoria Azarenka shook off a slow start to beat Vera Lapko 6-2, 6-3 on Wednesday and set up a second-round meeting with long-time rival Serena Williams. Azarenka, a former world number one now ranked 48th in the world, said she started a little too passive in dropping the first two games against her fellow Belarussian, but roared back to seal the win with ease. She was looking forward to taking on 10th-seeded Williams, who like all the seeds in the combined WTA and ATP Masters event has a first-round bye. The American has won 17 of



their 21 prior encounters, but Azarenka won their most recent clash - in the 2016 Indian Wells final. "Of course it's going to be a very special match for us," she said of their first clash since both became mothers. "We have such a big history, it's going to be really special. She motivates me, she inspires me, she pushes me to be better," Azarenka said of Williams. The opening day of women's main draw play saw highly touted teenagers Bianca Andreescu and Amanda Anisimova reached the second round. Canada's Andreescu, 18, rallied from a set down to beat Romanian Irina-Camelia Begu 6-7 (3/7), 6-3, 6-3.

School, Hanspuri. Many issues were raised by the villagers viz. construction of road from Hanspuri to Bajota, BSNL network connectivity, construction of community infrastructures, power supply, water supply, construction of helipad, taking up of developmental works through MGNREGA, and shortage of staff in various government institutions like sub-centre, school and veterinary etc.

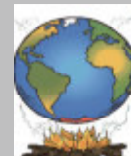
