Health Minister unveils 5th State Food Safety Index on World Food Safety Day

25 lakh Food Business Operators will be trained by FSSAI in the next 3 years

Food quality is a part of wellness: Minister

New Delhi, June 7 (PIB)

The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) reaffirmed its dedication to food safety and innovation by organizing an interactive session today at Vigyan Bhavan, in honor of World Food Safety Day. The event witnessed the participation of Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, the Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare.

At the event, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya unveiled the 5th State Food Safety Index (SFSI), which evaluates the



performance of States and Union Territories across six different aspects of food safety. The release of this index coincided with the interactive session. Launched in 2018-19, the SFSI aims to foster healthy competition and catalyze positive

change in the food safety ecosystem throughout the country, ultimately ensuring the provision of safe and wholesome food to all residents.

Recognizing the achievements of various States and Union Territories,

Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya felicitated the winners based on their rankings for the year 2022-23. Among the larger States, Kerala secured the top ranking, followed by Punjab and Tamil Nadu. Among the smaller

States, Goa emerged as the leader, followed by Manipur and Sikkim. Additionally, Jammu and Kashmir, Delhi and Chandigarh secured the first, second, and third ranks respectively among the Union Territories.

Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya also commended States that demonstrated significant improvement in their State Food Safety Index scores.

Furthermore, the Union Health Minister honored the winners of the Eat Right Challenge for Districts - Phase II. These districts

Cabinet approves increase in MSP for all mandated Kharif Crops for 2023-24 season

New Delhi, June 7

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) today approved an increase in Minimum Support Price (MSP), for all mandated Kharif Crops for Marketing Season 2023-24. The Cabinet has taken this decision to ensure remunerative prices to growers for their produce and to encourage crop

diversification. Briefing media in New Delhi this afternoon, Union Minister, Shri Piyush Goyal said this year's increased MSP is the biggest in the last several years. The increase in MSP for Kharif Crops for Marketing Season 2023-24 is in line with the Union Budget 2023-24.

The announcement of fixing the MSP at a

level of at least 1.5 times the All-India weighted average Cost of Production, aiming at reasonably fair remuneration for the farmers.

The expected margin to farmers over their cost of production is estimated to be highest in the case of Bajra at 82 percent followed by tur at 58 percent, soybean at 52

Interview of Secretary (AH&VS) broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair

Secretary (AH&VS) shares insight on steps initiated to ensure sufficient quantity of animal products & improving socio economic condition of farmers

Port Blair, June 7

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (AH&VS), Shri G Sudhakar, IAS was broadcast today through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.



Interviewer: Tell us about the mission, vision & aim of AH&VS Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): The main aim, mission, vision and objective of the AH&VS Department is to ensure availability of sufficient quantity of animal derived products such as meat, milk and eggs to the local population and also improve the socio economic condition of the local population, especially farmers through animal husbandry activities such as rearing of poultry, pig, goat and broiler chicken. Further, the Department ensures a comprehensive health care system, be it vaccination, treatment of diseases and also to maintain a disease free status in A&N Islands.

Interviewer: To achieve the vision & mission of the Department, how many Veterinary Dispensaries, Hospitals and Polyclinics & manpower are available with the AH&VS Deptt.?

Secretary (AH&VS): We have one Veterinary Polyclinic, 9 Veterinary Hospitals and 12 Vet Dispensaries, 48 Sub-Dispensaries and 17 Mobile Veterinary Dispensaries at present. The Department is having 398 manpower in different categories as against the sanctioned strength of 581.

Interviewer: Is there any plan to increase the staff strength of AH&VS Department during this recruitment drive?

Secretary (AH&VS): During this recruitment drive, 139 posts will be filled, out of which, 77 posts will be filled Departmentally and 62 posts through the Personnel Department.

Interviewer: What are the different types of facilities available in all the 3 Districts in AH&VS sector?

Secretary (AH&VS): The Department has vaccinations, injection & medicines for diseases and protein based derivatives for growth in all the Districts through this network of Dispensaries & Sub-Dispensaries. We have

17 Mobile Veterinary Ambulances services in Hospitals and Dispensaries.

Interviewer: How many OT and X-ray machines are there with the Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): The Department is having 9 Veterinary Operation Theaters (OTs) and the X-Ray machine is available in the main Hospital at Junglighat.

Interviewer: What is being done to contain communicable diseases in birds and animals?

Secretary (AH&VS): Veterinary health care and prophylactic vaccination programmes are being conducted on a regular basis. Generally, because of the geographical isolations of the Islands, most of the birds and animals are free from contagious diseases. For example, these Islands are free from contagious diseases like viz. Rabies, Anthrax, H.S. Rinderpest, BQPPR, CBPP etc. Lumpy Skin Disease was reported from a very limited area of Campbell Bay in Great Nicobar in 2022 where 566 cattle were affected, out of which, 28 died and all other animals were vaccinated. Outbreak of Swine fever was reported in Nicobar District way back in 2000 & 2005. Similarly, parasitic incidence such as fascioliasis, amphiostomiasis and ascariasis which are common in livestock and minor diseases. In poultry, we don't have pandemic outbreaks but occasional outbreaks of ranikhet disease and IBDR are noticed. Similarly, in livestock and pets, ascariasis is noticed but there is no rabies noticed in A&N Islands.

Interviewer: What is the role of the State Animal Disease Emergency Committee?

Secretary (AH&VS): The role of the State Animal Disease Emergency Committee is to take decisions in emergency and to deal when highly contagious diseases

that are reported or serious plague in Bovine population or cattle population outbreak are reported.

Interviewer: Can you elaborate on the different schemes being implemented by the Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): The Department is having 5 UT Plans schemes namely Animal Health Programme, Cattle Development Programme, Poultry, Piggery and Goat Development Programme, Strengthening Capacity Building by organizing conferences and Fodder Development. Fodder requirement is very important; as dry fodder availability is very less due to agro-climatic issues. However, to augment fodder production in these Islands and to meet the requirement of fodder for livestock, latest varieties of fodder seeds cuttings and seedlings are distributed to the farmers, free of cost.

Interviewer: How successful are the schemes implemented in your Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): As a results of our schemes & programmes, we have achieved self-sufficiency in meat, chicken and eggs. But our main challenge and gap is milk production. To achieve this, the Department has conceptualized and formulated a scheme which is in the advanced stages of its implementation. Under this scheme, subsidies will be provided to farmers in the form of feed and better medicines. We are working out the modalities about how it can be transferred to them. The scheme will be implemented shortly.

Interviewer: Do you have any separate livestock breeding policy?

Secretary (AH&VS): The Department is following the policy of upgrading the genetic stock of the local livestock. Over a long time, due to in-breeding and isolation, our local livestock are genetically inferior. The Department carries out upgradation by cross breeding with genetically superior germplasm procured from the mainland by performing artificial insemination in cattle and buffalo using frozen semen technology.

Interviewer: Is there any proposal for establishing a Veterinary College in A&N Islands? How are the staff of the Department trained?

Secretary (AH&VS): There is a proposal of a Veterinary College which is the vision 2030. Proposal is in nascent stage. We have Training Institute in Department of AH&VS wherein experts are called from mainland besides local doctors also impart training. The staff are also sent to Veterinary Colleges at mainland.

Interviewer: What is the status of Piggery and Goat rearing in these Islands?

Secretary (AH&VS): Many people are taking interest in Pig and Goat rearing especially the marginal & small farmers besides landless laborers. We are self-sufficient in both these products but there is scope to increase its production.

Interviewer: Is there any model village wherein all the schemes of the Department are implemented? What are the other facilities provided by the Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): There are 6 model villages in A&N Islands in which all the schemes are being implemented in an effective manner. Department and Animal Welfare Activists in association with local bodies and Panchayats carryout animal birth control programme, creates awareness, provides treatment on the request of the individual owners as well as from Forest and other Departments.

Interviewer: What are the future plans of the Department?

Secretary (AH&VS): To achieve self-sufficiency in milk, the Department is formulating a scheme viz. Fodder on Subsidy which will be implemented shortly for supporting Dairy farmers. The Department is introducing a new initiative in rural villages to boost egg production. Another scheme is introduction of sex semen for artificial insemination which will increase the chances of female calf by 90 percent. Efforts are also being made to implement embryo transfer technology for producing high quality calves. Five fully equipped Mobile Veterinary Clinics will be introduced for improving veterinary services.

Interviewer: What would you like to tell the local inhabitants of these Islands?

Secretary (AH&VS): I wish to tell the people that in A&N Islands, farmers have small land holdings and they should also take up piggery, goat rearing, poultry depending on local factors and what is suitable for them. They should contact the Department of AH&VS experts or experts from private before taking up farming, which not only increases their income but helps in inclusive growth besides increasing employment opportunities.

percent, and urad at 51 percent. For the rest of the crops, the margin to farmers over their cost of production is estimated to be at least 50 percent.

In recent years, Government has been promoting the cultivation of crops, other than cereals such as pulses, oilseeds, and Nutri-cereals or Shree Anna, by offering a higher MSP for these crops. Additionally, the Government has also launched various schemes and initiatives, such as the Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana, and National Food Security Mission to encourage farmers to diversify their crops.

As per Third Advance Estimates for 2022-23, total Foodgrain production in the country is estimated at a record 330.5 million tonnes which is higher by 14.9 million tonnes as compared to the previous year 2021-22. This is the highest increase in the last five years. (Source: india.gov.in)



India will have 200-220 more airports, heliports, and water aerodromes in next five years: Union Minister

New Delhi, June 7

Union Civil Aviation Minister, Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia today said, in the next five years, India will have 200 to 220 more airports, heliports, and water aerodromes. Addressing media in New Delhi on the nine years of Government's Seva, Sushasan, and Garib Kalyan focusing on the Aviation sector, the Minister said, the number of airports, heliports, and water

aerodromes which was only 74 till 2013-2014 in 68 years after the independence, the number in the last nine years has reached 148 registering 100 percent.

Speaking about the growth of domestic air traffic, Shri Scindia informed that the number of domestic passengers which was only 6 crore in 2013-14, has now increased to 14.50 crore registering a

growth of 130 percent in the last nine years. He said, the number of international air traffic also increased by 50 percent to 7 crore passengers. Shri Scindia said that the Indian Civil Aviation is the third-largest aviation market in the world. The Minister added that in the last nine years, the number of greenfield airports has also increased from 3 to 14. (Source: india.gov.in)

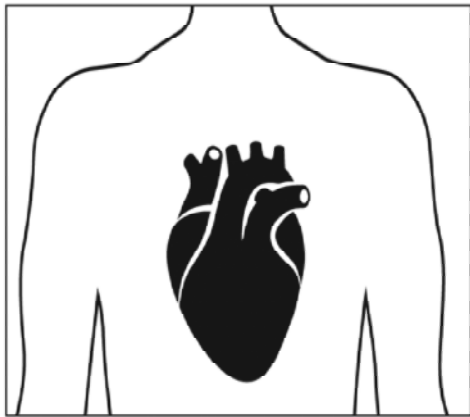
