families Abdul Jabbar was honoured with Padma Shri posthumously.

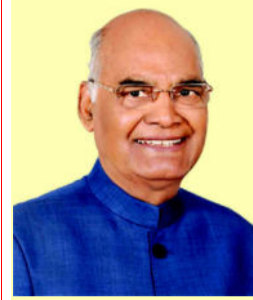

First ever Geophysical Survey of Barren Island conducted by team of Research scholars from IIRS Dehradun

Survey undertaken to identify & characterize magma chamber and its geological features

Port Blair, Nov. 8

A team from Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS), Dehradun, a unit of ISRO visited Barren Island on Nov.7, 2021 and conducted the first ever Geophysical Survey on Barren Island, setting a record in history. The objective of the survey was to identify and characterize the magma chamber and its various geological features using the Magnetometer and very low frequency instruments. The Barren Island volcano is active since 2005 and erupts intermittently with moderate scale of lava and gaseous emissions.



The team was led by Shri Gunda Goutham Krishna Teja from IIRS Dehradun in coordination with Department of Science and Technology, A & N Administration and Indian Coast Guard, Port Blair (ICGS Durgabai Deshmukh and team). The team consisted of Shri Mijanur Ansary and Shri A.

Sridhar, Research Scholars of IIRS and Osmania University respectively. Shri Gunda Goutham, Research Scholar (DST-INSPIRE), Geoscience and Disaster Management Studies Group, Indian Institute of Remote Sensing-ISRO, Dehradun working on Multi Hazard Risk Assessment of Andaman Islands had visited Barren Island twice for deep understanding of volcanic activities in Barren Island for enabling the detailed study of volcanic eruptions in Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a press release from Science & Technology Deptt. said.

These guidelines provide guidance to Healthcare Facilities as well as the industry/vendors involved in utilization of bio medical wastes in collection, sending, transportation, utilization and disposal by ensuring adequate safeguards from risk of spread of infection during such handling. In this regard, all the Healthcare facilities in

A&N Islands have been informed to provide the above mentioned liquid Biomedical Waste (BMW) to authorized vendors / pharmaceutical/bio-technology industries strictly in compliance with provisions of the

Enhancing transparency & ease of doing business DPIIT G2B Portal launched for facilitating entrepreneurs for submission of IEM application for establishment of industrial units

Port Blair, Nov. 8

As part of its effort to enhance transparency and to ensure ease of doing business, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) has launched an enhanced DPIIT G2B Portal. The DPIIT in a notification has informed that the entrepreneur can now file an application for Industrial Entrepreneur Memorandum (IEM) Part 'A' for the establishment of business and Part 'B' upon commencement of commercial production online through the DPIIT's enhanced portal. Presently, the procedure to obtain Industrial Entrepreneur Memorandum is through DPIIT G2B Portal.

Industrial Entrepreneurs

Memorandum is an application for acknowledgment of the industrial unit. According to the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, all exempted industrial from the requirements of industrial licensing and having an investment of Rs 10 Crore or above in the

manufacturing sector and Rs 5 crore or above in services sector are required to file IEM. According to the MSME definition modified last year, entities with investment in plant and machinery or equipment between Rs 11 crore and Rs 50 crore are defined as medium enterprises.

Industrial

Entrepreneurs Memorandum is required for the industrial promoter under the categories such as to set up a new industrial undertaking, to effect substantial expansion of the industrial undertaking, to manufacture a new article, to carry on business of existing

Media briefed on COVID-19 One positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Director (IP&T)

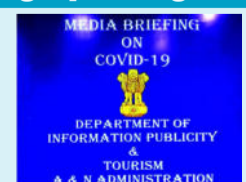
Port Blair, Nov. 8

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing media on COVID-19 status at IP&T here today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 509 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 11 flights with 1836

passengers arrived, out of which, 1297 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 539 passengers and the

reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 161 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 105 passengers and all were found negative.

Centre amends Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities) Rules 2011 for enhanced protection of Consumer Rights; to come into effect from April 1

Amendment to ensure that consumers are able to make an informed choice and reduced compliance for industries

Mandatory declaration of MRP in Indian currency inclusive of all taxes on pre packed products

New Delhi, Nov. 8 (PIB)

To safeguard interest of consumers, the Department of Consumer Affairs under Ministry of Food and Public Distribution has omitted the Rule 5 of the Legal Metrology (Packaged Commodities), Rules 2011 defining the Schedule II prescribing the pack sizes of various types of commodities. A new provision has been introduced to indicate the unit sale price on pre packed commodities, which will allow easier comparison of

the prices of the commodities at the time of purchase. Earlier, the month and year in which the commodity is manufactured or pre-packed or imported was required to be mentioned in the package. Representation from Industry and associations in this respect has been received to remove this ambiguity. For reducing compliance burden and removing the ambiguity of declaration of date on pre packed commodities for consumers, the declaration has now

been required to the month and year in which the commodity is manufactured for the pre packed commodities. The provisions of declarations of MRP has been simplified by removing illustration and providing for making the mandatory declaration of MRP in Indian currency inclusive of all taxes. This has allowed the manufacturer/packer/importer to declare the MRP on the pre packed commodities in a simplified manner. Rules for declaring the

commodities sold in pre packed commodities in numbers have been eased out for reducing the compliance burden for manufacturer/importer/packer. Earlier such declarations could be denoted as 'N' or 'U' only. Now the quantities can be expressed in terms of the number or unit or piece or pair or set or such other word which represents the quantity in the package. This will remove the ambiguity of declaration of quantity sold by number in pre packed commodities.

17 scientists from across India awarded Swarnajayanti Fellowships

Seventeen scientists from scientific institutions across India have been awarded the Swarnajayanti Fellowships for their innovative research ideas and the potential of creating impact on R&D in different disciplines. Scientists selected for the award will be allowed to pursue unfettered research with a freedom and flexibility in terms of expenditure as approved in the research plan. The track record and

selected through a rigorous three layered screening process will pursue basic research in frontier areas of science and technology. The Swarnajayanti Fellowship scheme was instituted by Govt. of India in the year 1997 to commemorate India's fiftieth year of Independence. Under the scheme the awardees are facilitated by the Department of Science & Technology, GOI with support for all the requirements for performing the research including a

fellowship of Rs. 25,000/- per month for five years. In addition, DST supports the awardees by giving them a research grant of 5 lakh Rupees for 5 years. The fellowship is provided in addition to the salary they draw from their parent Institution. In addition to fellowship, grants for equipment, computational facilities, consumables, contingencies, national and international travel and other special requirements, are covered based on merit.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

FAMACHA to control blood sucking helminths and anthelmintic resistance in goats

FaffaMalanCHART (FAMACHA) has been coined from the name of Dr. Faffa Malan, a South African Veterinarian who evolved the technique for treating the animals infected with Haemonchus using clinical anaemia as the determinant. The test is based on the assessment of colour variation of the conjunctival mucous membrane. The standard chart colour varies from pink red (normal) to white (anaemic), for which scores are allotted as 1 (normal) to 5 (Anaemic). The Scientists of Animal Science Division have standardized this chart to be used in the goat. On the basis of FAMACHA score card and correlation with the faecal egg count, it is easy to take a correct decision to go for deworming of the animals. Selective deworming minimizes the use of unwanted anthelmintic in small ruminants and thereby reduces the development of anthelmintic resistance. Care should be taken while interpreting the results that the anaemia cannot be always considered as the gold standard indicator for presence of worm infestation in the animals. Therefore for accurate diagnosis, the symptoms of gastrointestinal infestation viz. diarrhoea, lethargy, bottle jaw, oedema, poor body conditions, rough hair coat, etc. should also be considered and correlated with the FAMACHA score. Eye should be checked in normal day light. Usually during the high risk season, it is advisable to use at least once in 14 days to check the eye and correlate with faecal egg count. If more than 10% of the total flock is showing the score of more than 4 and 5, then all the animals showing more than 3 score should be dewormed and grazing area should be rotated or changed.

Benefit: FAMACHA is a very handy tool to detect anaemic status of the animals and to correlate with gastrointestinal parasitic load in the field. Thereby the risk of anthelmintic resistance and cost involved in this could easily be prevented.

Pippali (long pepper), (Piper longum)	2 gm
Cardamom	2 gm
Honey	10 ml
Ragi/arrow root powder (optional)	1 to 2 tea spoons

Total quantity: 400 gm

Method of preparation
Steam cook seedless dates and banana, then grind it into thick paste, sauté it in ghee, add sugar candy syrup into it and stirwell. When it becomes thick, add cardamom powder etc. into it. Add honey when it becomes cool. It can be dried and powdered with ragi (pearl millet)/ arrow root powder.

Health benefits
It is a good pediatric food comprised of carbohydrates, easily digestible proteins and minerals, but to be given in small quantities only. Mahua flowers have been traditionally used as cooling agent, tonic, aphrodisiac and analgesic. Mahua flower helps in augmentation of breast milk. It has antihelmintic properties and also beneficial in acute and chronic tonsillitis, pharyngitis as well as bronchitis.

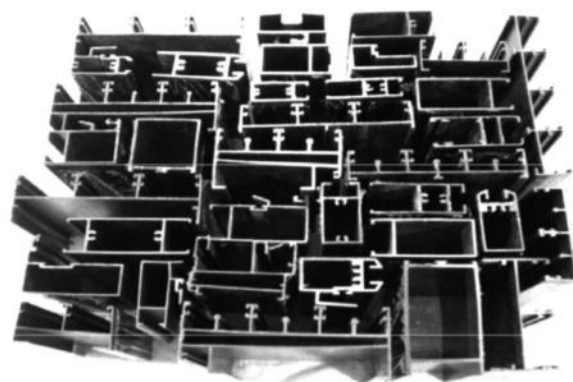
