New Delhi, Nov. 8 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi unveiled the logo, theme and website of India's G-20 Presidency via video conferencing today. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister remarked that from 1st December 2022, India will preside over the G-20 Summit and said that it is a historic opportunity for the country. The Prime Minister said G-20 is the premier forum for international economic cooperation representing around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the worldwide trade, and about two-thirds of the world population. Calling this a momentous occasion, the Prime Minister said the Presidency of G-20 during the year of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav is a matter of pride for every Indian. The Prime



Minister expressed happiness over the growing interest and activities about the G-20 and related events.

Highlighting the contributions of the citizens in the launch of the G-20 logo, the Prime Minister said that the Government received thousands of creative ideas for

the logo. The Prime Minister thanked everyone for their support and said that these suggestions are becoming the face of the global event.

Digitization of health records under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission

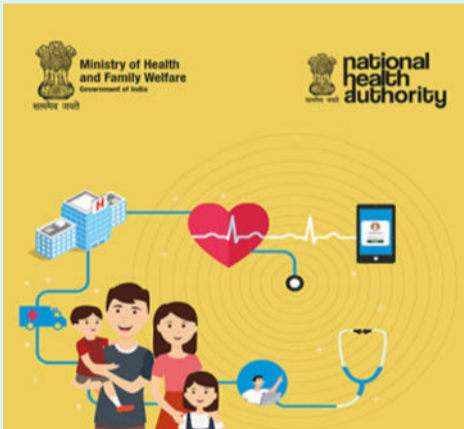
4,22,268 lakh Ayushman Bharat Health Account generated in A&N Islands so far

Port Blair, Nov. 8

The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) was launched on 15th August, 2020 across six Union Territories including A&N Islands on a pilot basis and later expanded to the entire country on 27th Sept, 2021. In A&N Islands, 4,22,268 lakh people have created Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) under this Mission, as on date.

ABHA under ABDM is free of cost, voluntary and consent based, that can be created using Aadhaar, Driving License or mobile number along with basic information. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI has formulated the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) with the aim to provide the



necessary support for integration of digital health infrastructure in the country. Creation of ABHA ID will enable people to keep a track of their health data and share it only with verified doctors or health providers when needed after an informed consent.

The ABHA ID is designed with highest standards of security and privacy and will enable inclusive access to all health services. The Islanders can create their ABHA ID online by visiting the site <https://healthid.ndhm.gov.in/>.

The Health ID can be created using Aadhaar number, Driving License Number option or Mobile number to receive their OTP and filling up basic information which includes name, sex, date of birth and mobile number. The State Health Agency is the implementing agency for ABDM in these Islands. For any technical help, general public may contact State Health Agency over phone number 03192-214763.

Twitter handles engaging in impersonation without clearly specifying parody will be suspended

New Delhi, Nov. 8
Twitter will permanently suspend any Twitter handles engaging in impersonation without clearly specifying parody. This was stated by Elon Musk in a series of tweets yesterday, just days after he took over one of the world's most influential social media platforms. He also said any name change at all will cause a temporary loss of verified checkmarks and there will be no warning before a suspension. This will be clearly identified as a condition for signing up for Twitter Blue. He further added that widespread verification will democratize journalism and empower the voice of the people. He said that Twitter needs to become by far the most accurate source of information about the world. Twitter also confirmed yesterday that it will revise its user verification process. Without giving more details, Elon Musk said the whole verification process is being revamped right now. Twitter is considering charging for the coveted blue check mark verifying the identity of its account holder, technology newsletter Platformer has reported, citing two people familiar with the matter. The CEO of Tesla Inc has not made a final decision and the project could still be scrapped but according to Platformer, it is likely that verification will become a part of Twitter Blue. messages from India. "Message of Buddha for freedom from war, Mahatma Gandhi's solutions in the face of violence, through G-20, India is giving them a new height", he said.

The Prime Minister remarked that India's G-20 presidency is coming at a time of crisis and chaos. He underlined that the world is dealing with the aftereffects of a disruptive once-in-a-century global pandemic, conflicts and lots of economic uncertainty. "The lotus in the logo of G-20 is a symbol of hope in such tough times," he said. The Prime Minister remarked that even if the world is in a deep crisis, we can still progress to make it a better place. Throwing light on the culture of India, the Prime Minister mentioned that both the Goddesses of knowledge and prosperity are seated on a lotus. The Prime Minister pointed out the Earth that is placed on a lotus in the logo of G-20 and said that shared knowledge helps us in overcoming difficult circumstances while shared prosperity enables us to reach the last mile. He further explained the significance of the seven petals of the lotus which represent the seven continents and seven universal musical notes. He added, "When the seven musical notes come together, they create perfect harmony." Shri Modi said that the G-20 aims to bring the world together in harmony while respecting diversity.

The Prime Minister said that this summit is not merely a diplomatic meeting, India takes it as a new responsibility and as the world's trust in it. "Today, there is an unprecedented curiosity in the world to know and understand India. Today India is being studied in a new light. Our current successes are being assessed and unprecedented hopes are being expressed about our future", he continued, "In such an atmosphere it is the responsibility of the citizens to go beyond these expectations and acquaint the world with India's capabilities, philosophy, social and intellectual strength." "We have to unite everyone and energise them for their responsibility towards the world", he added.

Shri Modi said there is a journey of thousands of years for India to reach this stage today. "We have seen highs of prosperity and also the darkest phase in global history. India has reached here along with the history of many invaders and their tyranny. Those experiences are the biggest strength in India's development journey today. After independence we started a big journey starting from zero, aiming for the top.

The Prime Minister pointed out that the world is looking with hope towards collective leadership whether it is G7, G77 or UNGA. In such a situation, India's presidency of G20 assumes a new significance. He elaborated that India maintains close relations with developed countries on the one hand, and at the same time understands and expresses the views of developing countries very well. "It is on this basis that we will build the blueprint of our G-20 Presidency together with all the friends of the 'Global South' who have been India's co-travellers on the path of development for decades", he added. The Prime Minister highlighted India's endeavour that there should be no first world or third world in the world, but only one world. Furthering India's vision and the common objective of bringing the whole world together for a better future, the Prime Minister gave examples of One Sun, One World, One Grid which has been India's clarion call for a revolution in the world of renewable energy, and the global health campaign of One Earth, One Health. He further added that the G-20 mantra is - One Earth, One Family, One Future. "It is these thoughts and values of India that pave the way for the welfare of the world", he continued, "I am sure, this event will not only be a memorable one for India, but the future will also assess it as a momentous occasion in the history of the world."

In supersession of all previous appointment orders of Booth Level Officers(BLOs) and BLO-Supervisors under Section 13B(2) of Representation of People Act, 1950, the following officials attached to various departments functioning under A & N Administration are hereby appointed as Booth Level Officer and BLO-Supervisor for the Part(s)/Polling Station(s) mentioned against their name with immediate effect.
The BLOs shall attend to the Electoral Roll related duties in the polling area as indicated against their name. They would be considered as on deputation to the Election Commission of India for this purpose and would be subject to the disciplinary control of the Election Commission of India under Section 32 of Representation of People Act, 1950. BLOs & BLO-Supervisors shall not proceed on leave without obtaining permission and making over his election related charge. Even in case of their transfer, they should ensure to hand over all election related papers, records and registers to their successor within the prescribed time.
The Booth Level Officers shall be required to carry out door-to-door verification of electors in their respective polling area which they have been assigned. They shall be provided with a copy of the latest Photo Electoral Rolls pertaining to their polling area and shall make necessary correction and updation of the electoral data as prescribed. The BLOs/BLO-Supervisors shall have to perform their duties in addition to their official work in such manner that it does not affect their normal duties. The BLOs are backbone of democracy and their objective shall be to prepare an error-free Electoral Roll and to achieve cent percent enrolment of eligible.
During the course of Special Summary Revision of Electoral Rolls, ordered by the Election Commission of India, the BLOs shall be required to be present in their respective jurisdiction. Duties and Responsibilities of BLO is annexed herewith as ANNEXURE-1.
The work of each BLOs shall be supervised by BLO-Supervisors appointed herewith. The BLO-Supervisor shall maintain check on the quality of work done by the Booth Level Officers and closely monitor their functioning. They shall work as a link between Booth Level Officers and Electoral Registration Officer/Assistant Electoral Registration Officers. They shall also be deemed to be on deputation to the Election Commission and therefore will be under the disciplinary control of the Election Commission of India under the provisions of Section 13C of the Representation of the People Act, 1950.
All the BLOs are also hereby directed to carry out collection/updation of Aadhaar data from the electors on voluntary basis for linking and authentication of entries in electoral roll during forthcoming Special Summary Revision-2023 which will commence from 09.11.2022.
All the Heads of Department/Officer are requested to spare the services of the staff under their control during the Summary Revision period.
All BLOs are also hereby appointed as Designated Officer to receive claims & objections at their respective Polling Stations on all working days during the period of filing claims & objections for Summary Revision.
