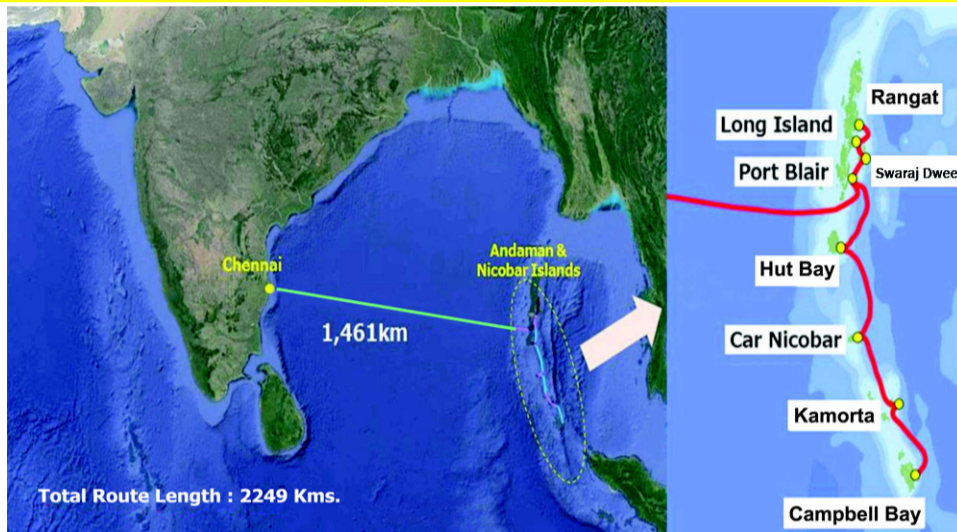
Inauguration of Cable-Laying of Chennai - Andaman & Nicobar Islands Submarine Optical Fibre System

Union Minister for Communications to inaugurate the project in the presence of Lt. Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency at Chennai today

Port Blair, Jan. 8

The Undersea Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) laying work connecting Chennai to Port Blair and 7 Islands is all set to begin on Jan 9. BSNL have organised a function for commencement of cable-laying of Chennai - Andaman & Nicobar Islands Submarine Optical Fibre Cable System at Chennai. Shri. Ravi Shankar Prasad, Hon'ble Union Minister for Communications, Electronics & IT, and Law & Justice, Government of India will inaugurate it in the august presence of Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, & Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency, at 1 pm on January 9 in Chennai. The inaugural function will be held at Hotel Le Royal Meridien, followed by the flag-off ceremony in the cable-laying ship 'KT Responder', berthed inside Chennai Port jetty.

This project of national importance will build the first ever dedicated submarine OF cable link from Chennai to A&N Islands. It will connect Port Blair to Chennai and will have further landings in seven Islands: Swaraj Dweep, Long Island, Rangat, Little Andaman, Car

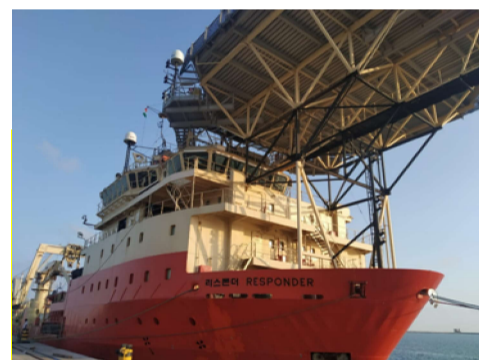


Nicobar, Kamorta and Great Nicobar. The project activity was formally launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 30th December, 2018, during his visit to Port Blair.

This system will play a pivotal role in driving the 'Digital India' vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister. The total length of submarine cable to be laid exceeds 2250 km and will have an initial bandwidth capacity of 400 Gbps for supporting voice and data connectivity. The CANI- SMC has an eventual capacity of 6.4 terabits per fibre pair. One fibre pair is earmarked for exclusive use by Defence (A&N Command). Once the project is completed, citizens of A&N Islands will experience an overall improvement in ICT services nearly on par with that of

mainland.

Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) are the project implementation agency (including operations for 5 years), nominated by DoT/USOF. The turnkey contract has been awarded to M/s NEC Technologies India Ltd. According to CGM, A&N Telecom Circle, the CANI-SMC project is being constructed at a total cost of around Rs. 1200 crores, funded by USOF, Govt. of India. The project will play a significant role in bridging the digital divide and for spreading the various e-governance programmes in the Emerald Isles.

years from the date of commencement of commercial production/operation.
 * **Central Comprehensive Insurance Incentive (CCII)** Reimbursement of 100% insurance premium on insurance of building and Plant & Machinery for maximum period of 5 years.
 * **Goods and Service Tax (GST) Reimbursement** 58% of the Central tax paid

and 29% of integrated tax paid for the period of 5 years.
 * **Income Tax (IT) Reimbursement** Central Share of income tax for first 5 years.
 * **Transport Incentive (TI)** 20% of the cost of transportation for finished goods for Shipping from the port nearest to the location of the industrial

Saying that India is a good friend of Iran, Mr Chegeni said, Iranian Foreign Minister Javad Zarif spoke to External Affairs Minister Dr Jaishankar on Sunday and they had a very good discussion. The Iranian Envoy said, Iran and India can jointly work for peace in the world.

Replying to a query on Chabahar port, Mr Chegeni said, the port is a symbol of very good friendship between India, Iran, Afghanistan, Commonwealth of Independent States, Europe and whole Persian Gulf. He said, Chabahar will go on and no one should worry about it.

Over eight cr farmer families benefited under PM Kisan Scheme

New Delhi, Jan. 8

Over eight crore farmer families have been benefitted under PM Kisan Scheme. The Scheme was launched in February, last year under which income support of six thousand rupees per year in three equal instalments of two thousand rupees is provided to each eligible farmer. Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Ministry said, more than 48 thousand 937 crore rupees has been released under the scheme till date. The Scheme initially covered only small and marginal farmer families

with landholding up to two hectares. Later the government extended the scheme to all farmer families irrespective of landholding size.

A new facility has been provided on PM-KISAN Web-portal - www.pmkisan.gov.in through Farmers' Corner link to facilitate the farmers for self-registration and edit his or her name in PM-Kisan database as per Aadhar Card.

Virat Kohli retains top spot; Marnus Labuschagne grabs career-best third place

Dubai, Jan. 8
India skipper Virat Kohli retained his top spot among batsmen while Cheteshwar Pujara and Ajinkya Rahane slipped in the latest ICC Test rankings issued on Wednesday.
With 928 points, Kohli is way ahead of second-placed Australian maestro Steve Smith (911), the ICC said in a statement. Pujara was placed sixth, down one rung, with 791 points, while Rahane occupied the ninth spot after slipping a couple of positions with 759 points.
In bowling, India's pace spearhead Jasprit Bumrah, returning from an injury layoff, remained static at sixth position with 794 points, while spinner Ravichandran Ashwin (772 points) and seamer Mohammed Shami (771) were ninth and 10th respectively.
Australia's Marnus Labuschagne grabbed a career-best third place. The 25-year-old moved up one slot after scores of 215 and 59 in the final Test against New Zealand. He was the highest scorer in the recently-concluded series with 549 runs, while his five previous Tests that include two at home against Pakistan, have seen him amass 896 runs.

Mane crowned Africa's 2019 Player of the Year

Hurghada (Egypt), Jan. 8
Liverpool star Sadio Mane was crowned on Tuesday as Africa's 2019 Player of the Year for the first time at an awards gala in Egypt.
The 27-year old Senegalese striker was up against his Liverpool teammate Mohamed Salah, the Egyptian who won the award the last two years, and Algerian Riyad Mahrez of Manchester City.
"I am really happy and at the same time I am really proud to win this award," said Mane at the ceremony organised by the Confederation of African Football in the Egyptian Red Sea city of Hurghada.
"It's a big day for me."
Mane became the second star from Senegal to be named African Player of the Year after El Hadji Diouf, who was the continent's best player in 2001 and 2002.
He scored 34 goals and produced 12 assists in 61 appearances in 2019, according to CAF statistics.
Salah's tally stood at 26 goals and 10 assists in 55 matches while Mahrez accounted for 14 goals and 18 assists in 48 games last year.
