156th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi- Father of the Nation to be celebrated on October 2

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28
Together with the rest of the country, the 156th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation will be celebrated on October 2 in A&N Islands too. The main function will be held at Gandhi Park at 8.15 am, during which, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency will pay floral tributes at the statue of Mahatma Gandhi. This will be followed by prayers 'Vaishnav Jan To Tene Kahiye Je' Ramdhuns by Teachers/Students of Education Department. A two minutes' silence will be observed on the occasion.

All the Govt. Departments, Institutions, Autonomous bodies, Corporation, Panchayat Pradhans, voluntary organizations and villagers have been requested to create community assets by Shramdaan and conduct special drive for cleanliness during the month under the 'Swacchta Hi Seva Campaign'.

Further, the general public have been requested to refrain from slaughtering of animals, killing of birds, fish catching and consuming liquor on this auspicious day. Oct. 2, 2025 will be observed as a 'Dry Day' in homage to the Father of the Nation, a press release from DC (SA) said.

Hon'ble MP highlights issues concerning farmers of A & N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28
Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Andaman & Nicobar Islands has raised various issues concerning the farmers of the Islands. In his communication to Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah, and Hon'ble Union Agriculture Minister, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Shri Ray, highlighted that farmers across the Islands are facing huge losses in coconut, arecanut, banana and other fruit-bearing crops due to infestation of Rugose Spiraling Whitefly and Mealybug. The MP urged the Government of India to depute a high-level scientific expert team from the mainland to study the ground situation and interact with farmers and immediately initiate preventive and scientific control measures against Rugose Spiraling Whitefly and Mealybug infestations. He also requested to provide compensation to affected farmers and tribal communities after conducting proper surveys. He further urged to arrange training and exposure visits for farmers of the islands on modern farming practices to boost productivity and income, a press release from Office of MP said.

Labour Department appeals to employers of private establishments to constitute Internal Committee (IC) under the POSH Act

Section 4 of the Act mandates constitution of Internal Committee; Non-compliance will attract penalties/ fines up to Rs.50,000

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 28
The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (POSH Act) was enacted to protect women against sexual harassment at the workplace and to ensure a safe, secure, and dignified working environment. As per Section 4 of the Act, every workplace or establishment employing 10 or more persons is mandatorily required to constitute an Internal Committee (IC) to deal with complaints of sexual harassment in a fair, effective, and confidential manner. The IC should be:

- ♦ Headed by a Presiding Officer, who shall be a woman employed at a senior level at workplace from amongst the employees. In case a senior level woman employee is not available, the Presiding Officer shall be nominated from other offices or administrative units of the workplace and in case the other offices or administrative units of the workplace do not have a senior level woman employee, the Presiding Officer shall be nominated from any other workplace of the same employer or other department or organization.
- ♦ Not less than two Members from amongst employees preferably committed to the cause of women or who have had experience in social work or have legal knowledge.
- ♦ One member from amongst Non-Governmental Organizations or associations committed to the cause of women or a person familiar with the issues relating to sexual harassment.
- ♦ Provided that at least one-half of the total Members so nominated shall be women.

The IC is empowered to receive complaints, conduct inquiries, and recommend

appropriate action. Non-compliance with Section 4 attracts penalties under Section 26 of the Act, including fines up to Rs. 50,000 for the first contravention.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide Order dated 12.08.2025 in Miscellaneous Application No. 22553/2023, has directed the Labour Departments of all States and Union Territories to ensure strict compliance with this mandate by all employers.

Accordingly, all employers of establishments in private sector in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands have been directed to immediately constitute an IC (if not already constituted) and forward a copy of the IC constitution to the Labour Department through email: lcedet@and.nic.in or WhatsApp No.: 8900901130. The same will be transmitted to the respective District Officer under the POSH Act in compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. 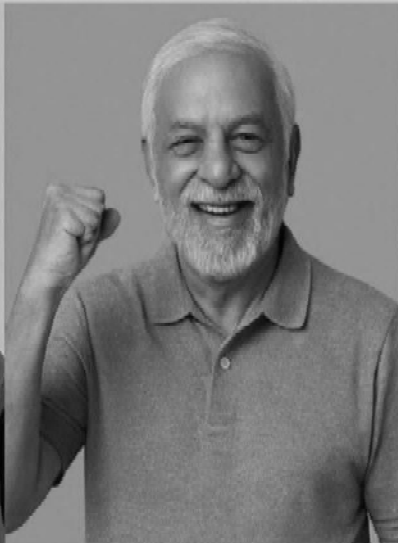
