Urban rainwater harvesting- catch water where it falls

PBMC launches 'Blue Pipe Project' in city to conserve rain water; initiative draws praise from citizens

Two wells in Haddo & Delanipur connected under this project

Port Blair, July 8
 Port Blair Municipal Council has launched the Blue Pipe Project for Urban Rainwater Harvesting. It is a novel community based Rainwater Harvesting initiative which utilizes existing community roofs and existing dug wells to recharge ground water. It is to mention that Port Blair witnesses over 2200 mm of rainfall every year but it is also plagued by acute



shortages due to paucity of high quality fresh water sources in the area. Detailing about the initiative, in a press release, the Secretary, PBMC mentioned that

rainwater harvesting is the need of the hour. Even though Rainwater Harvesting for new buildings is mandatory as per Municipal Bye Laws, it is difficult and expensive to construct

RWH structures for older buildings. To address this gap, Blue Pipe Project has been initiated by the Council. It connects the neighbourhood roof tops to the nearby

community wells in the area. Rainwater thus flows into the well instead of the drain. As the well fills up the water seeps slowly into the ground thus recharging the ground

water table. This allows the citizens with older buildings to participate in rainwater harvesting. PBMC's Urban Artists have also painted the wells under the Blue Pipe Project with messages to spread awareness and the message of Swachh Bharat by transforming the area around the well. Currently, 2 wells in Haddo and Delanipur have been connected under Blue Pipe Project. PBMC's Rainwater Harvesting team is

Media briefed on COVID-19

COVID Care Centres in S/Andaman free of patients; 3 undergoing treatment at GBPH: Secretary (Health)

Port Blair, July 8
 The Secretary (Health), Shri Ram Niwas Sharma while addressing a COVID-19 media briefing held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that the RTPCR test conducted on 336 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no corona positive case has been detected. Similarly, no cases were detected during test conducted on 201 persons bound for Middle & North Andaman at Ferrargunj. The mobile testing team today visited Tushnabad wherein 81 persons were tested and it is encouraging to note that all were found negative. He further disclosed that 7 persons were tested at Helipad while 8 persons were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty today and no corona positive cases

Corona positive cases are coming down and slowly, the stringent measures are being relaxed. The Administration has set markers based on increase in number of cases. If the cases go above 50, the Administration will go for restricted lockdown measures and if it touches 100, some more stringent measures will be imposed. Finally, if it crosses 150, lockdown could be considered anytime and it all depends upon all of us. The enforcement agencies have been asked to enforce strict measures to check overcrowding in shops and premises. All shops and premises where there is overcrowding will be sealed for long period with heavy penalty.

Engineering, Medical, CLAT, professional courses like Management (e.g. CAT) and any other such disciplines as Ministry may decide from time to time and eligibility tests/Examination like GMAT, SAT, TOFEL and GRE. The Scheme will be implemented through reputed coaching institutions/centres.

A press release from the Director, Social Welfare says that the eligibility criteria for applying for empanelment of coaching institute is such that the Institute should be registered body or run by an organization registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860/Companies Act 2013 or any other relevant Act of the State/UT. Further, the institute should have been registered at least for a period of 3 years as on date of notification inviting application from State/UTs/Coaching Institutions for empanelment by the Ministry. The institute should have been fully functional for a minimum period of 3 years at the time of applying under the Scheme and having a minimum enrolment of 100 students in the courses in each year for at least two years, immediately prior to the year in which selected for empanelment. The institute must have proper infrastructure to meet all requirement for providing coaching in the courses applied for.

In this connection, the authorized persons of interested coaching Centres have been advised to furnish their willingness along with details and profiles of the organization to the Director (Social Welfare), Goalghar, Port Blair.

sections of the society, contributing to social justice and harmony will be considered for the award by the jury irrespective of whether the person holds a high public office or not. The award is open to all persons regardless of nationality, race, creed or sex. Recent achievements within the last 10 years shall be considered. Older work may be considered, if its significance has become apparent only recently. A written work, in order to be eligible for consideration, should have been published.

The award carries a Citation, a Plaque and an amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh only) and the award is chosen by a Jury headed by Hon'ble Shri. M. N. Venkatachaliah, Former Chief Justice of India.

while one active case is in North & Middle Andaman. There is no corona positive case in Nicobar District, he added.

About vaccination, he said, 40.25 % population have been vaccinated with first dose of Covishield till yesterday, out of the total population of 4,00,000. He said, till yesterday, 2,06,308 doses have been administered in Isles against target beneficiaries of 2,81,603. First dose have been given to 1,60,981 beneficiaries, the percentage of which stands at 57.17 of the target population. The second dose has been given to 45,327 beneficiaries, accounting to 28.16 percent, the Secretary said adding that number of second dose beneficiaries is increasing day by day as they are taking the vaccination as per their due date.

The number of eligible person who have been inoculated with first dose in the age group of 45 plus is 1,05,170 which, he said, is moving towards saturation. He said the targeted population in the age group of 18-44 is 1,75,000 and so far, 55, 811 eligible beneficiaries of 18-44 years were vaccinated with first dose till yesterday.

The Secretary further said that the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly and till 3 pm today, 754 beneficiaries were vaccinated in JNRM vaccination centre, out of which, 286 persons were between the age group of 18-44 and the remaining were 45 plus who were administered second dose. The Secretary, on behalf of the A&N Administration, once again urged the 45 plus left out beneficiaries, if any, to come forward and get themselves vaccinated for their own safety, safety of their family members and the safety of the entire society.

The Director, ANIMS, Dr. AK Mandal, Deputy Director (IP), Shri RS Meena and Deputy Director, G.B Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De were also present during the press briefing.

followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with comorbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

As per data available, a total of 2,12,003 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 5695 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. A total of 56,287 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

Today, 3304 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 476 were in the age group of 18-44 years. In North & Middle Andaman District, 1956 beneficiaries were vaccinated. In Nicobar District, 435 beneficiaries were vaccinated, a press release from DHS said.

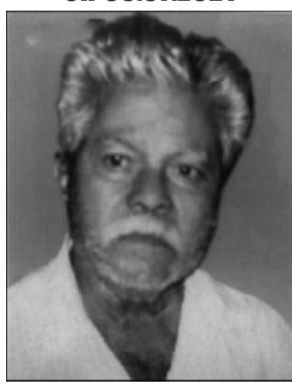

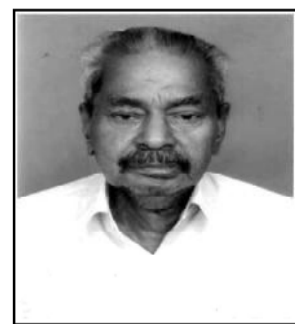
