Administration committed for protection & wellbeing of tribes of A&N Islands

All COVID-19 positive Great Andamanese tribals fully recovered; other Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups also safe

Port Blair, Sept. 8 The A&N Administration is fully committed for the wellbeing of its tribes and the safety of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups. It is to inform that all the 11 Great Andamanese tribals who tested COVID-19 positive earlier, have now fully recovered. It may be recalled that as a precautionary measure, the Administration had earlier shifted Great Andamanese to Strait Island in April, 2020, after testing them for COVID-19. Since many of them are government jobs and have accommodation in Port Blair, many families have returned back to Port Blair after the declaration of Unlock 2 & 3. Meanwhile, in view of surge in COVID-19 cases in August, 2020, they were again advised to shift to their settlement at Strait Island. During the course of shifting and testing at the settlement, 11 Great Andamanese tribals were tested positive for COVID-19 with asymptomatic or mild symptoms and they were kept in GB Pant Hospital as an abundant precaution/ or in home isolation. After undergoing mandatory isolation period, all of them had tested negative for COVID-19, at different point of time. Now, it is to inform that all these tribals are in good state of health and the remaining few will be shifted to their settlement at Strait Island shortly by the Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti (AAJVS). The Tribal Welfare Officer of AAJVS and ANM of Medical Sub-centre at Strait Island have been provided with Thermal Scanner & Oximeter to monitor

Piling work for construction of Major Bridge on Middle Strait Creek by NHIDCL progressing rapidly

Construction of 23 piles completed; offshore piling likely to commence by month end

Completion of bridge will change the dynamics of these Islands



Port Blair, Sept. 8 The construction work of 1.94 km long Major Bridge on the Middle Strait which commenced on the Baratang side of the bridge in June 2020 is progressing rapidly. For the construction, a total of 109 piles have to be driven including the offshore and the piles in the creek. As on date, a total of 23 piles have been constructed. Taking into account the start date of the work being 30th June, 2020, it translates into two and a half days per pile, which is a very good pace, said the Executive Director, NHIDCL in a press release. Registration under Udyam mandatory for MSM Enterprises Existing enterprises registered with DIC under various registration schemes advised to re-register their enterprise

Port Blair, Sept. 8
The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises has recently enacted Udyam Registration vide its Notification No. S.O. 2119(E), dated 26th June, 2020 as a part of facilitating the Ease of Doing Business initiative and reduce the transaction time and cost for the Micro, Small and Medium enterprises.
Under this provision, all the existing enterprises registered with the District Industries Centre, Port Blair, Department of Industries under various registration schemes such as SSI Act, Entrepreneurs Memorandums, Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum etc are required to re-register under Udyam Registration.
The Udyam Registrations can be obtained without GST Number and Permanent Account Number (PAN) till 31st March, 2021. After that the exemption on Udyam Registration without GSTN and PAN will end. From 1st April, 2021 onwards all Udyam Registration who have obtained Udyam Registration without quoting GST & PAN have to provide the same and for new

registration, GSTN and PAN will be mandatory. Those registered on or after 1st July, 2020 till 31st March, 2021 without GSTN and PAN have to upload and link their GSTN and PAN mandatorily by 31st March, 2021 to extend validity and avoid cancellation.
The Udyam Registration is not applicable for entrepreneurs who are planning to setup a new venture or are in the process of grounding a new venture. Udyam Registration is only applicable for re-registration of existing enterprises and those new ventures/activities which have commenced commercial production.
Further, it is clarified that except the Governmental Udyam Registration Portal (<https://udyamregistration.gov.in>) no other private portal is authorized to provide Udyam Registration. This is a free service provided by the Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India. No private agency or person has been authorized to do MSME registration. 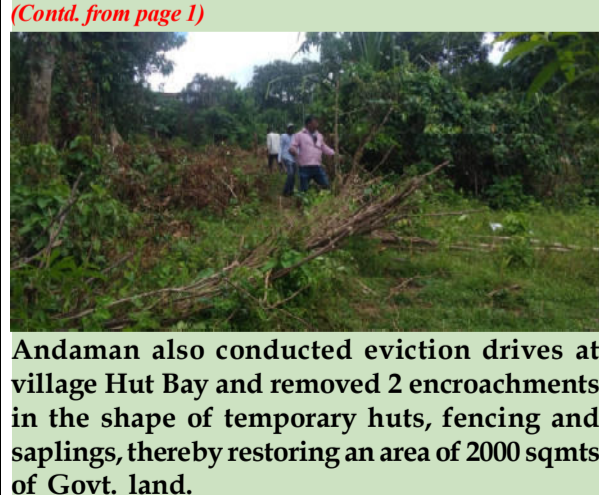
