18th G20 Summit to begin in New Delhi today

Global leaders arrive to attend the Summit

New Delhi, Sept. 8

India is all set to host the 18th G-20 Summit in New Delhi beginning tomorrow (Sept. 9). Global leaders arrived in the city to attend the Summit. US President, Mr Joe Biden, UK Prime Minister, Mr. Rishi Sunak, Japanese Prime Minister, Mr. Fumio Kishida, President of Argentina, Mr. Alberto Fernandez, Prime Minister of Canada, Mr. Justin Trudeau, Prime Minister of Australia, Mr. Anthony Albanese, President of Egypt, Mr Abdel Fattah Al-Ccisi, Sultan of Oman, Mr. Haitham Bin Tarik, President of South Africa, Mr. Cyril Ramaphosa, UN Secretary - General, Mr. Antonio Guterres, President of Nigeria, Mr. Bola Ahmed Tinubu, Prime Minister of

Mauritius, Mr. Pravind Jugnauth, Italian Prime Minister, Ms Giorgia Meloni, and Bangladesh Prime Minister, Ms. Sheikh Hasina, Russian Foreign Minister, Mr. Sergey Lavrov are among those who have arrived in the national capital for the G-20 Summit. Minister of Economy of Mexico, Mr Raquel Buenrostro Sánchez, President of European Commission, Ms Ursula Von Der Leyen, European Council President, Mr. Charles Michel, Secretary General of Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development OECD, Mr Mathias Cormann, Managing Director of International Monetary Fund IMF, Ms Kristalina Georgieva, Director General

of World Trade Organization, Ms Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala have also arrived in New Delhi to attend the Summit. They were given a rousing welcome on their arrival at the airport and welcomed with traditional Indian Folk Dances and Music. Several issues

ranging from food and energy security to clean energy transition and climate change are expected to be deliberated at length by the world's leading economies during the two-day G-20 Summit.

India is leveraging its G-20

Presidency to establish itself as a global powerhouse, advocating for the hopes and aspirations of many developing nations. One of the key takeaways of India's G20 Presidency is the revolutionization of Digital Payment Infrastructure. Briefing media in New Delhi today, G-20 Sherpa, Shri Amitabh Kant said very few people knew about Digital Payment Infrastructure earlier, but it has been taken forward extensively. He further said that the Digital Payment Infrastructure has been widely accepted as a way to bring financial inclusion. He also said that the New Delhi Leaders Declaration is almost ready and will be recommended to the leaders during the G-20

Summit. In the pre-summit briefing, Shri Kant said the Leaders' Declaration will be the voice of the global south and developing countries. He also spoke about the key priorities for India's G20 presidency, which included sustainable development goals and climate action.

G-20 Chief Coordinator, Shri Harsh Vardhan Shringla said, India's presidency will bring economic benefits to the country as the G20 meetings and activities included extensive participation of people from across the nation. He said, India received a total of one lakh visitors for the G20 presidency from over 125 nationalities and for many of them this has been a discovery of a new India. (Source: india.gov.in)

Counselling for admission to various UG Courses at JNRM from Sept. 11

The category-wise Final Merit List of candidates who have applied for admission to various undergraduate courses in JNRM, Port Blair for the Academic Session 2023-24 has been uploaded, duly attending all the claims and objections in the Common College Admission Portal (CCAP) website (<https://collegeadmission.andaman.gov.in>). Counselling for admission to various UG Courses at JNRM will begin from Sept. 11.

The counselling for admission to these courses shall be held in JNRM, Port Blair as per the schedule available in the website and on the same day admission shall be completed including remittance of admission fee. Candidates are advised to attend counselling as per the "All category final merit list" with their Serial Number/

Session-Wise/Subject-Wise.

It may be noted that all those candidates who have opted for reserved categories viz. ST, OBC, Divyang, EWS, Ward of Central Govt/Ex-servicemen/JNRM should attend the counselling session course-wise (subject-wise) as per the final merit list separately prepared in respect of various Categories as the admission to the reserved categories shall be filled up at the first instance during the counselling session after that only unreserved (general) candidates shall be called for admission.

Candidates who have applied online for admission have been asked to be present by 8.30 am on the respective date of counselling at the stipulated place at JNRM, Port Blair. They should bring the documents in original for verification and one set of photostat copies.

Certificates downloaded through Digilocker is valid during counselling session for taking provisional admission in JNRM. However, original marksheets of 12th is required to be submitted to JNRM within a week of time for verification and grant of final admission by the Pondicherry University.

As per the Pondicherry University norms, Physical Fitness Test will be conducted for admission to BPES and the candidate must come in proper sports dress on the day of counselling for their Fitness Test. Those who fail to attend the counselling session on specified date and time will not be considered for admission to the respective course and the next eligible candidate from the merit list will be considered for admission, a press release from JNRM said.
